### Palestinian Consumer Price Index (CPI) during May, 05/2018

#### Decrease in the CPI during May 2018

The overall CPI for Palestine during May 2018 decreased by 0.41% compared with April 2018 (by 0.94% in Gaza Strip, while it increased by 0.31% in Jerusalem J1\*, and by 0.22% in the West Bank\*\*).

The changes in Palestinian CPI for May 2018 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Sub Groups	Percent Change
Dried Vegetables	- 10.41%
Fresh Fruit	- 6.09%
Gas	- 2.91%
Flour	- 1.81%
Fresh Poultry	+ 5.03%
Eggs	+ 4.21%
Liquid Fuel for House	+ 2.94%
Fresh Fish	+ 2.44%
Liquid Fuel for Cars	+ 1.72%

The Palestinian CPI during May 2018 decreased by 0.87% compared with May 2017 (by 2.89% in Gaza Strip, while it increased by 0.76% in Jerusalem J1\*, and by 0.40% in the West Bank\*\*).

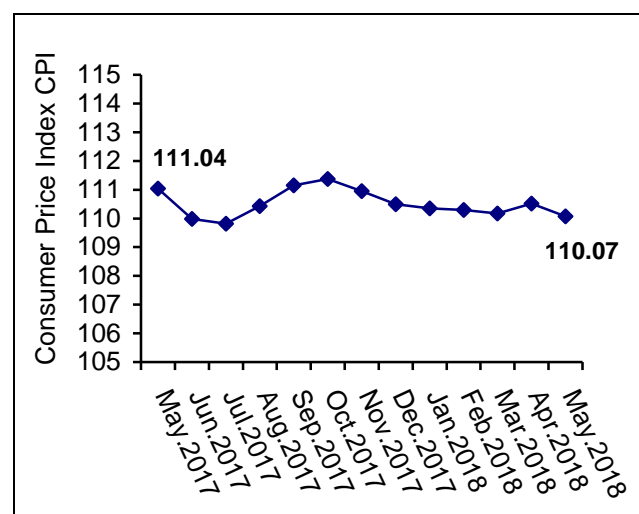
The Palestinian CPI during the first five months of 2018 decreased by 1.11% compared with the same period of the previous year (by 1.95% in

Gaza Strip, and by 0.86% in the West Bank\*\*, while it increased by 0.18% in Jerusalem J1\*).

The table shows monthly percent changes in CPI by Palestinian regions for the period January – May 2018:
