**Decrease in the Consumer Price Index  
during May, 05/2017**

The overall **CPI for Palestine during May 2017 decreased by 0.84%** compared with April 2017 (by 1.62% in Gaza Strip, by 0.50% in the West Bank\*\*, and by 0.17% in Jerusalem J1\*).

The changes in Palestinian CPI for May 2017 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Sub Groups	Percent Change
Potatoes and other Tubers	- 11.04%
Dried Vegetables	- 10.61%
Fresh Vegetables	- 7.53%
Eggs	- 7.26%
Fresh Fruit	- 6.13%
Gas	- 4.11%
Fresh Meat	- 1.31%
Liquid Fuel for House	+ 1.41%
Liquid Fuel for Cars	+ 1.02%

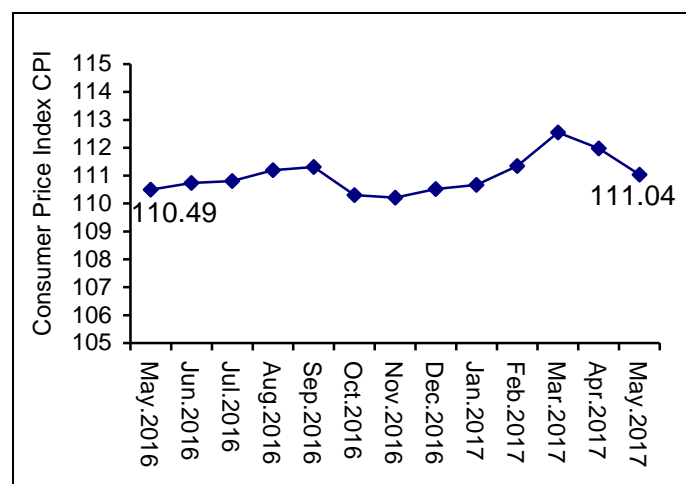
The Palestinian CPI during May 2017 increased by 0.50% compared with May 2016 (by 3.45% in Jerusalem J1\*, by 1.04% in the West Bank\*\*, while it decreased by 0.38% in Gaza Strip).

The Palestinian CPI during the first five months of 2017 increased by 0.67% compared with the same period of the previous year (by 3.33% in Jerusalem J1\*, by 0.96% in the West Bank\*\*, and by 0.20% in Gaza Strip).

The table below shows monthly percent change in CPI by region for the period **January – May 2017:**
