







Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008










Figure 5: Number of Schools in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008


Figure 6: Numbers of Students in Schools in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008



Figure 7: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008








Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate, 2006/2007

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007



Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate 1997,2007











Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Jericho & Al Aghwar Governorate by Quarter, 2008





Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 44,183 by mid 2009 including 22,136 males and 22,047 females. The percentage of refugees living in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 51.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 306. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 56.
- The registered live births in 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 1,871. The registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 129.
- Participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate was 48.8%. Findings showed that the percentage of the unemployed people among those participating labor force was 9.9%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2007–2008 was 26 schools and 13 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate was 1 hospital. number of hospital beds totaled 56 at 1.3 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2007 was 593 square kilometers.
- 6,461 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 3,048 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 5,653 dunums producing 8,490 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 33,493 dunums producing 83,976 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 7,262 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2008 totaled 101 for an area of 44,600 square meters.
- The number of localities in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 14 localities. Electricity network was the main source for 13 localities, and one locality were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate was 1,796.
- The number of hotels in 2008 in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate totaled 7.
- The values of imports rose in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2007 compared to 2003–2006 reaching 52.6 million US\$.
- Exports in Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2007 fall, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 2.5 million US\$
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Jericho & Al Aghwar governorate in 2007 totaling 50.1 million US\$.
