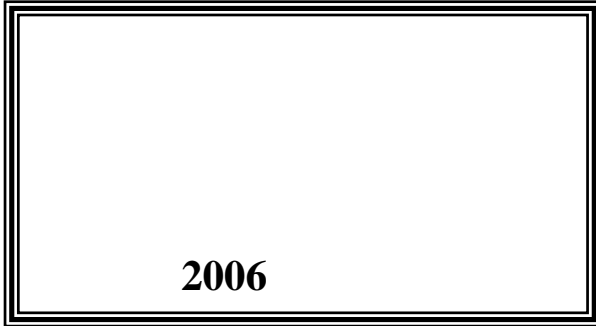

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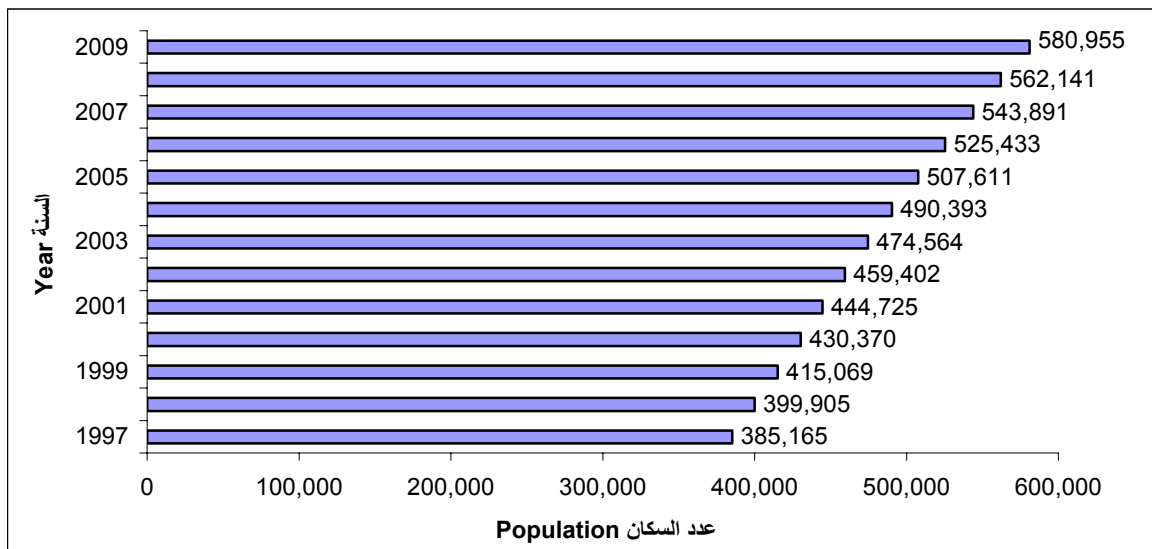

Figure 1: Population in Hebron Governorate Mid-Year, 1997-2009



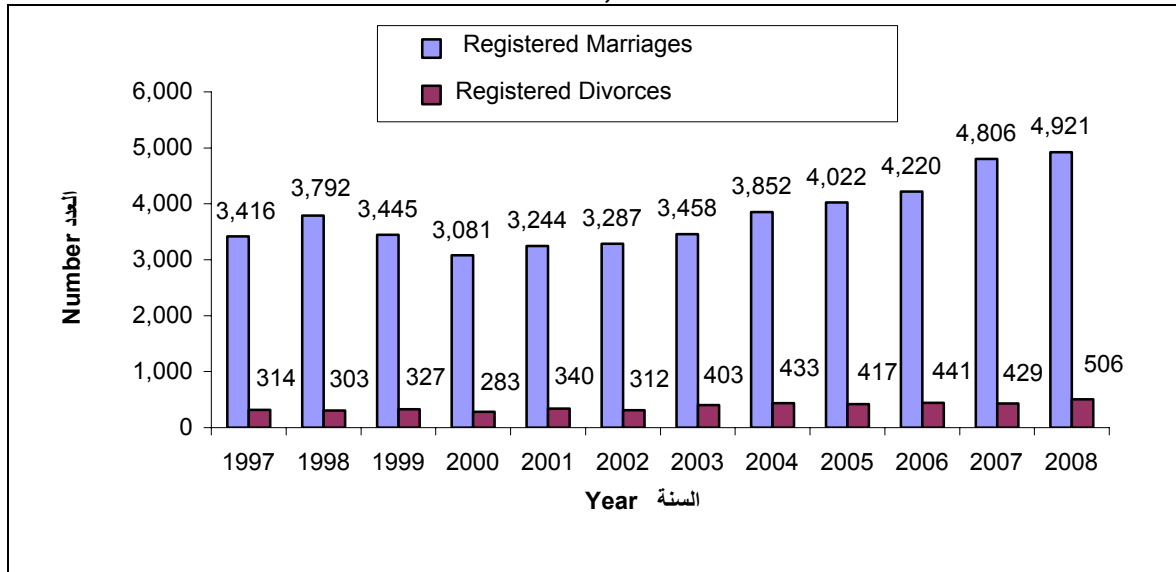

Figure 2: Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Hebron Governorate, 1997-2008



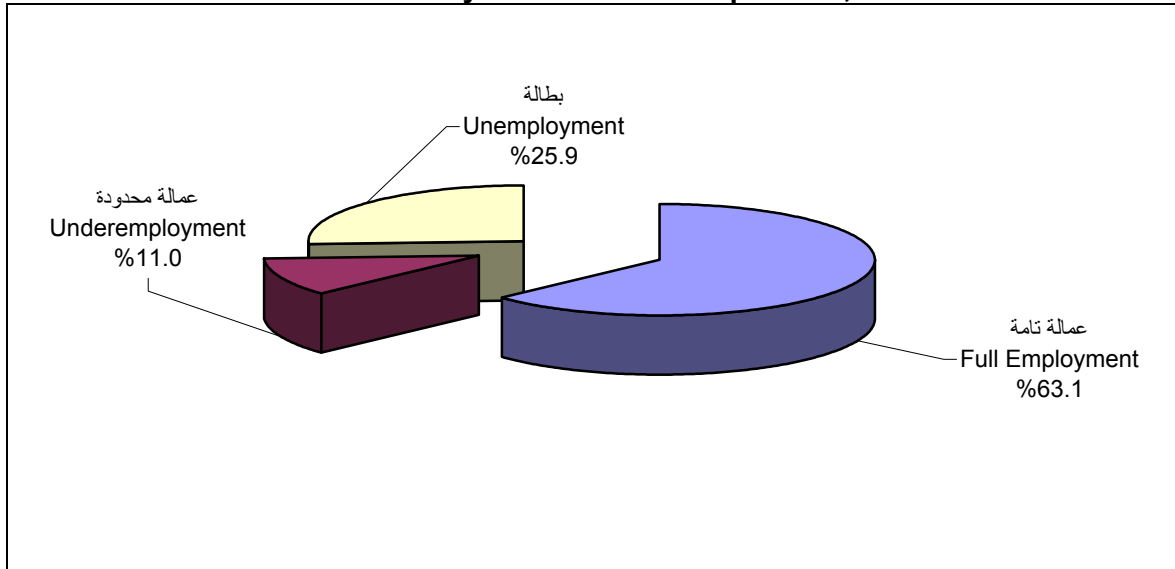

Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Hebron Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

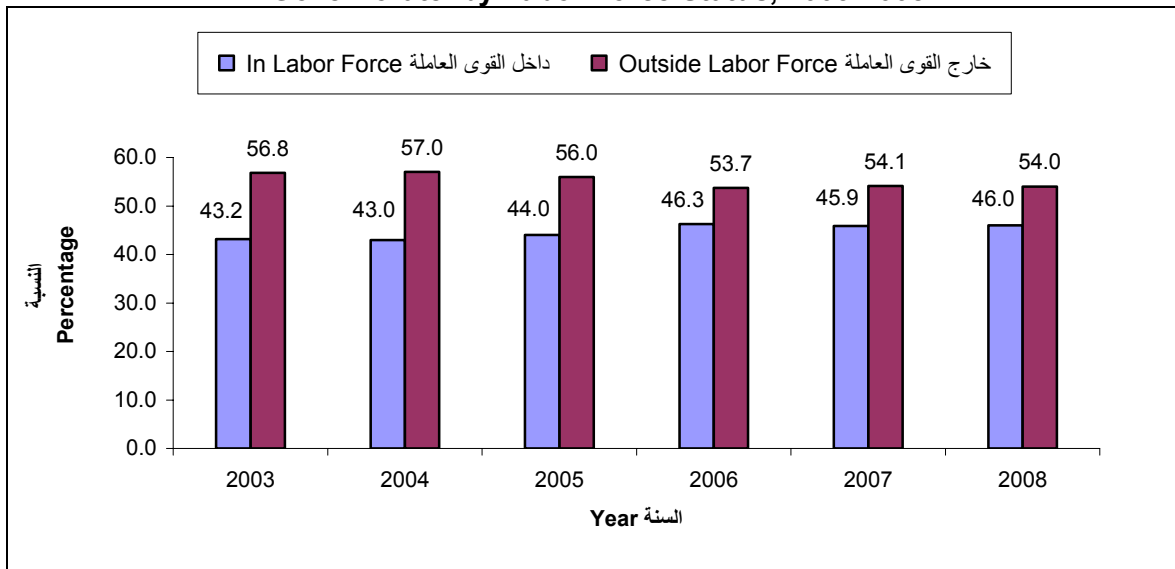

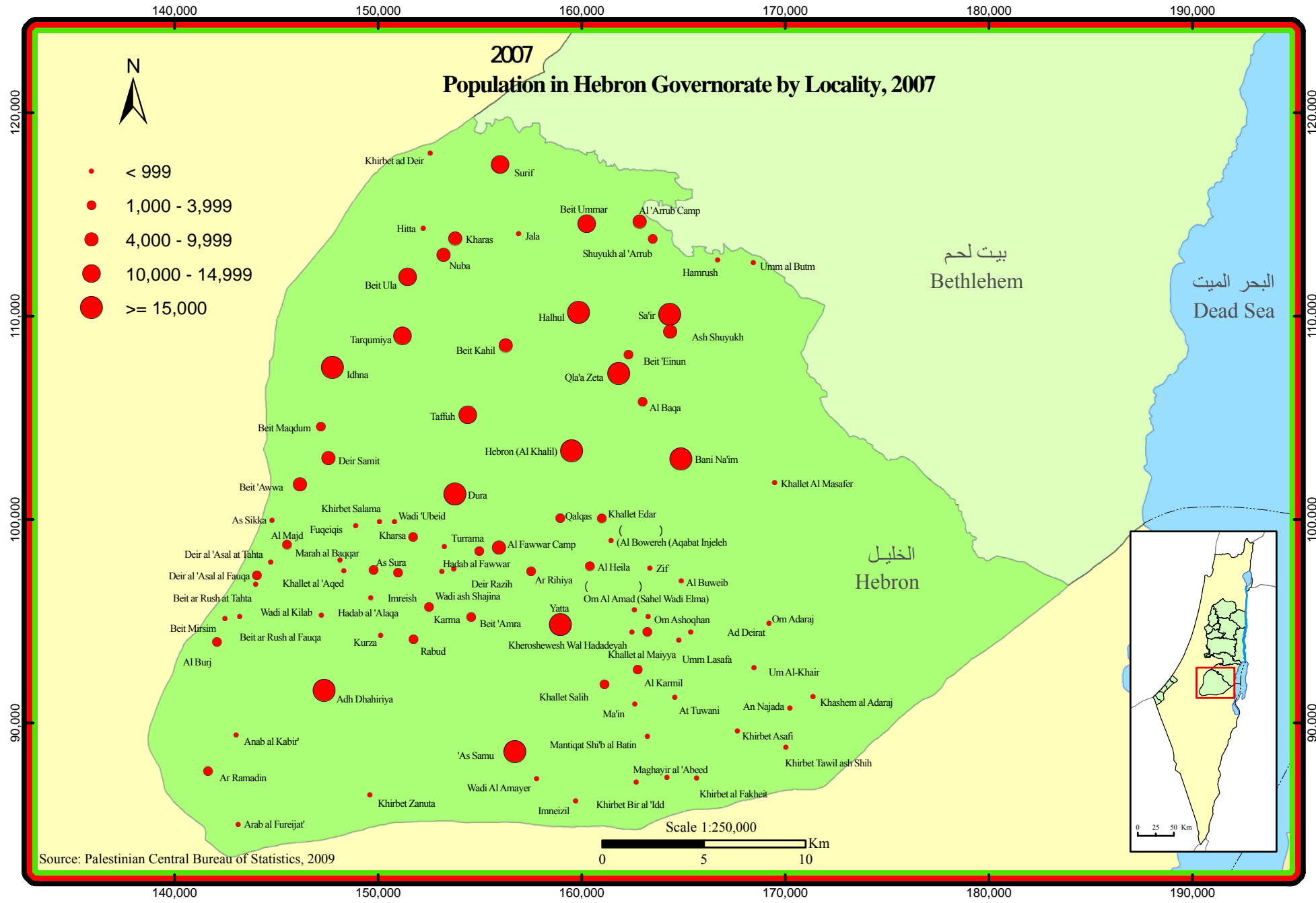

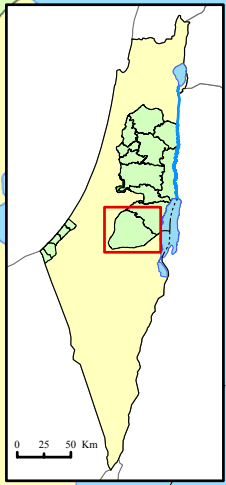
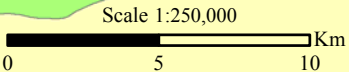
Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Hebron Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008

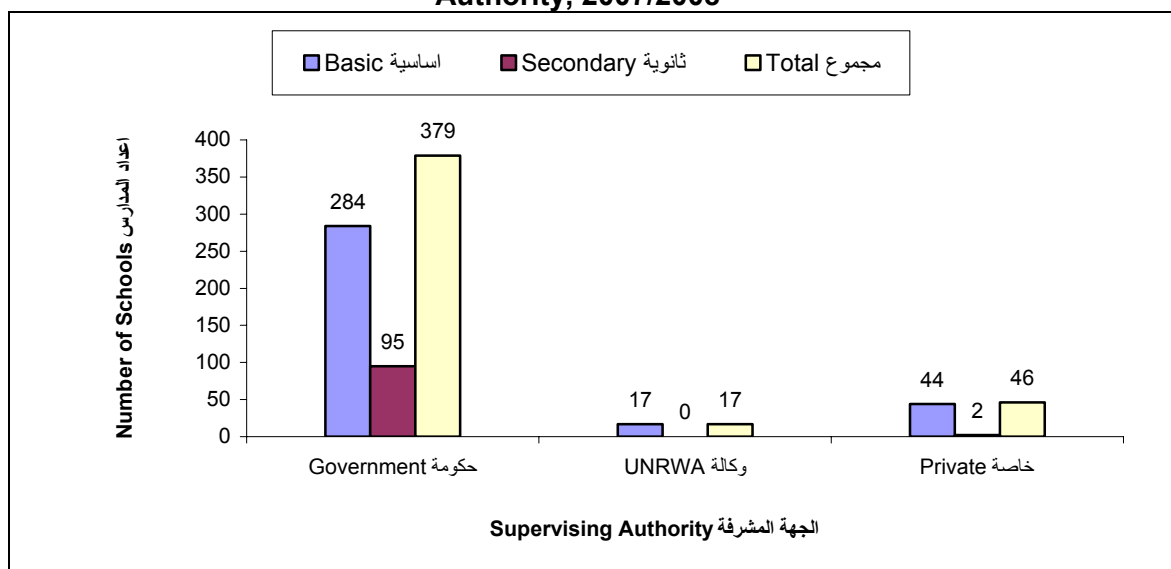

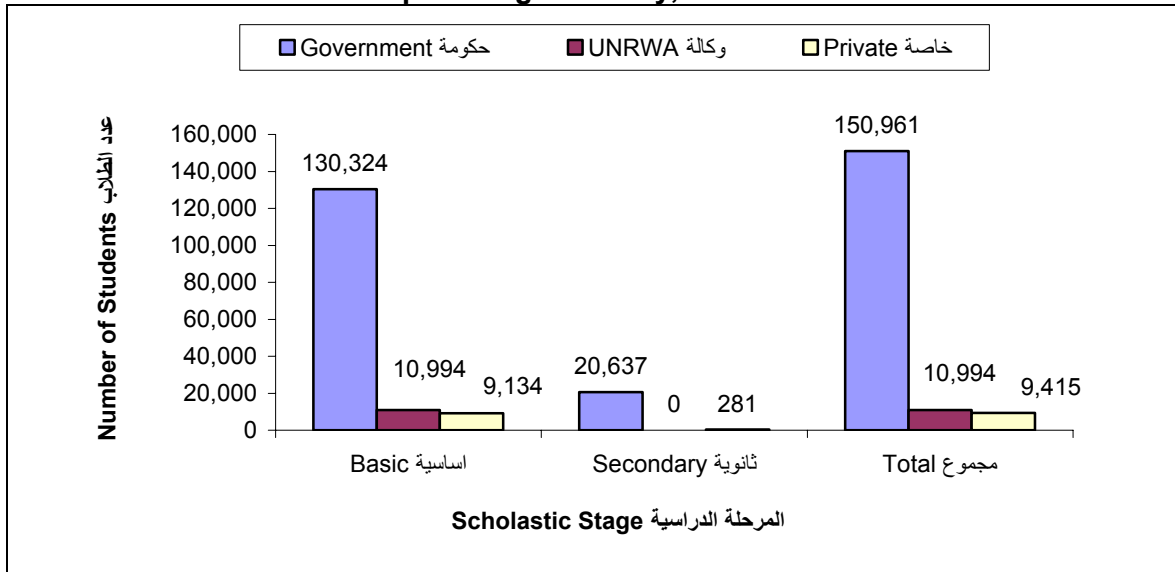
Figure 5: Number of Schools in Hebron Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008

Figure 6: Number of Students in Schools in Hebron Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008



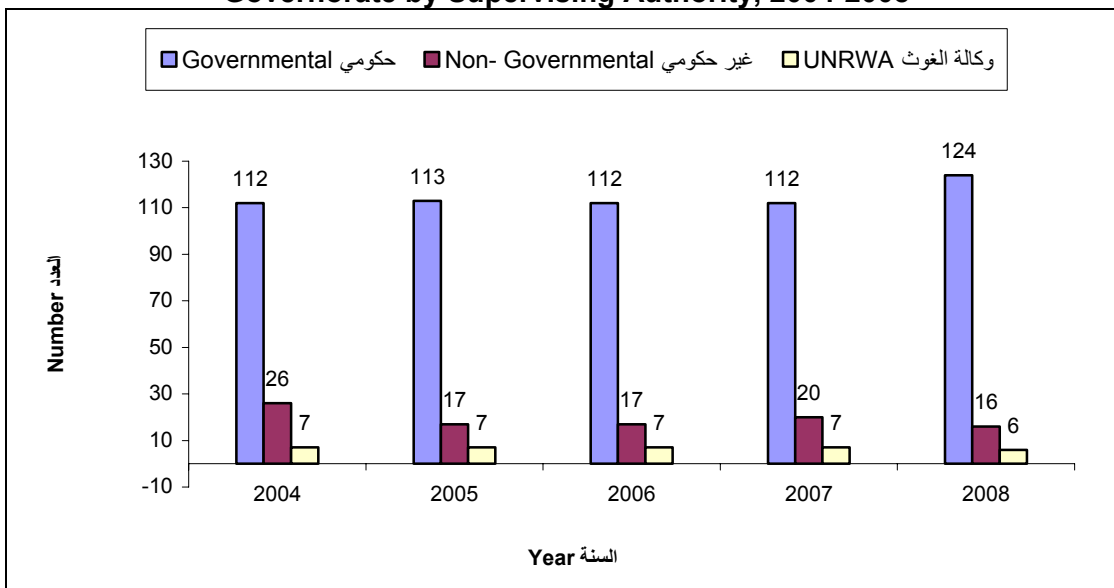

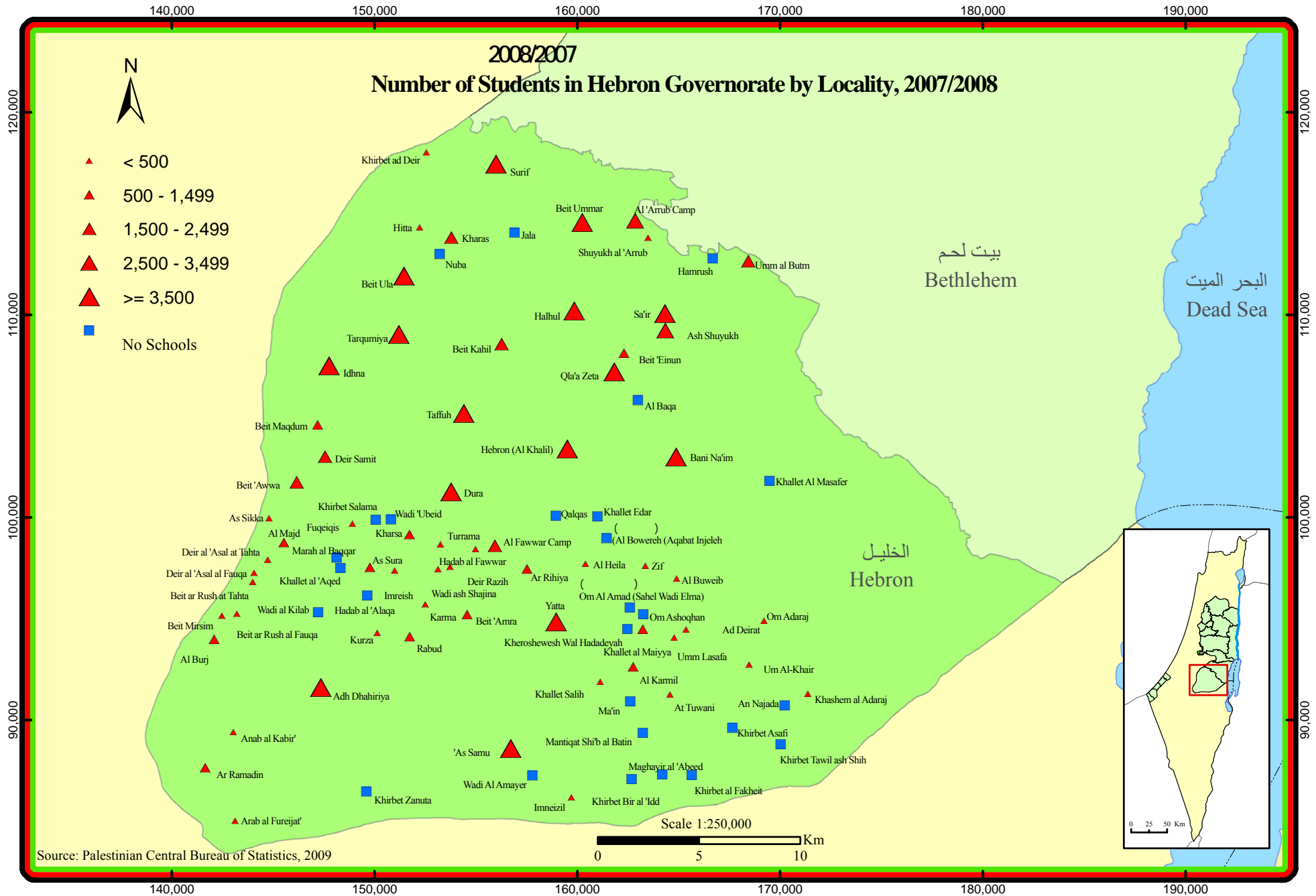

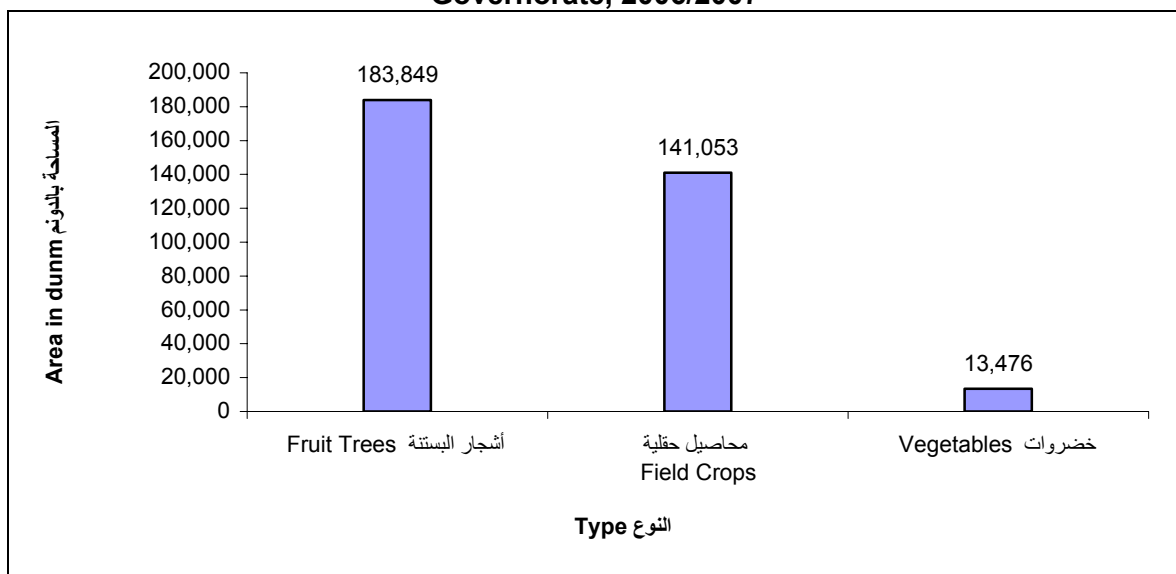

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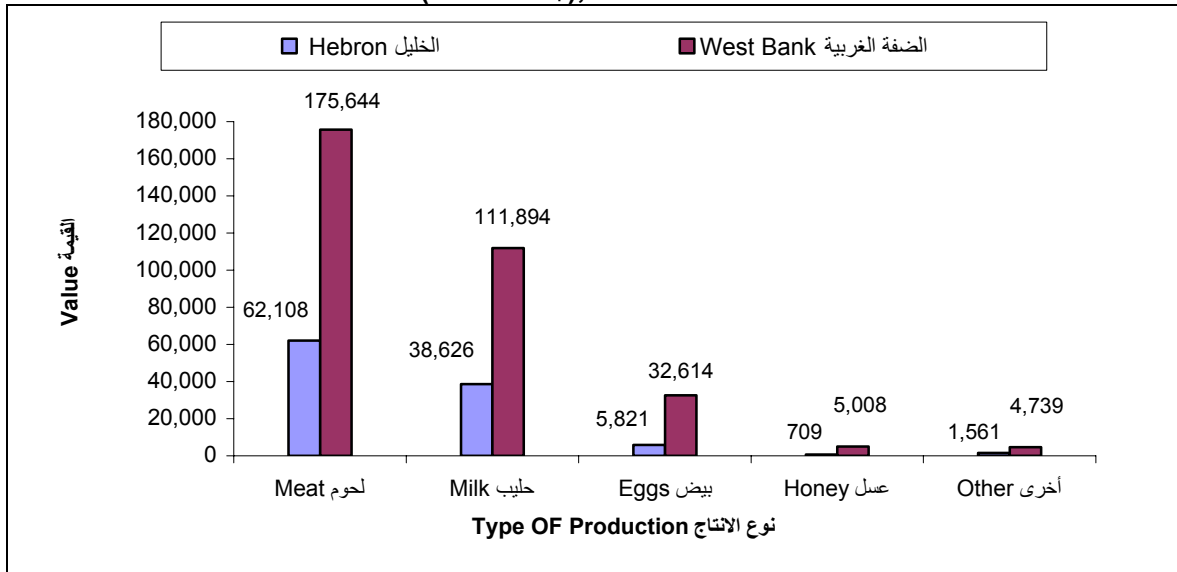

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Hebron Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007



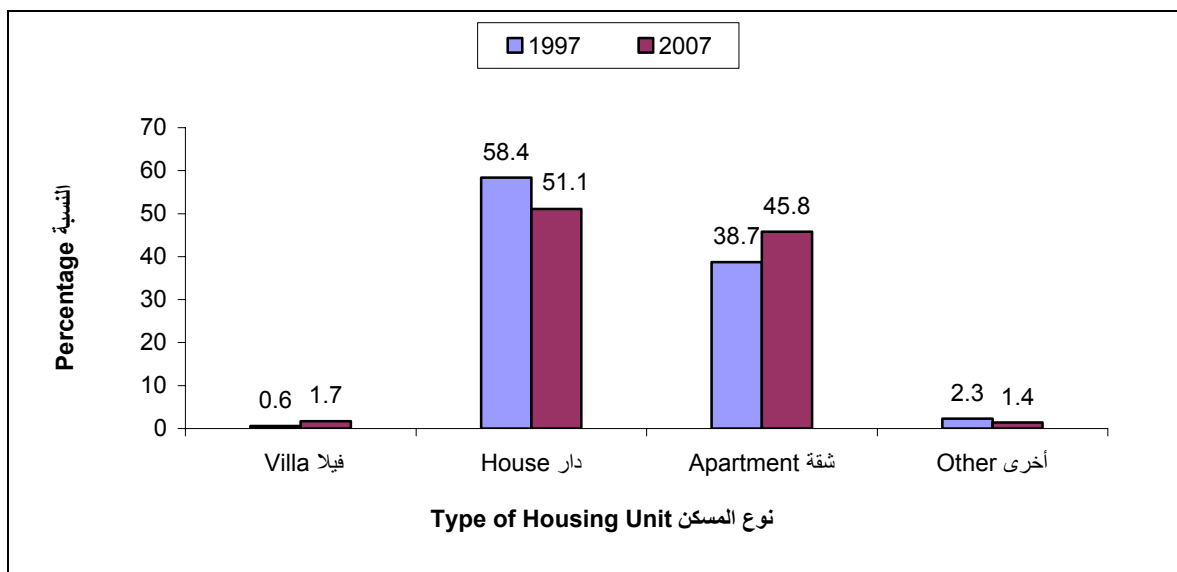

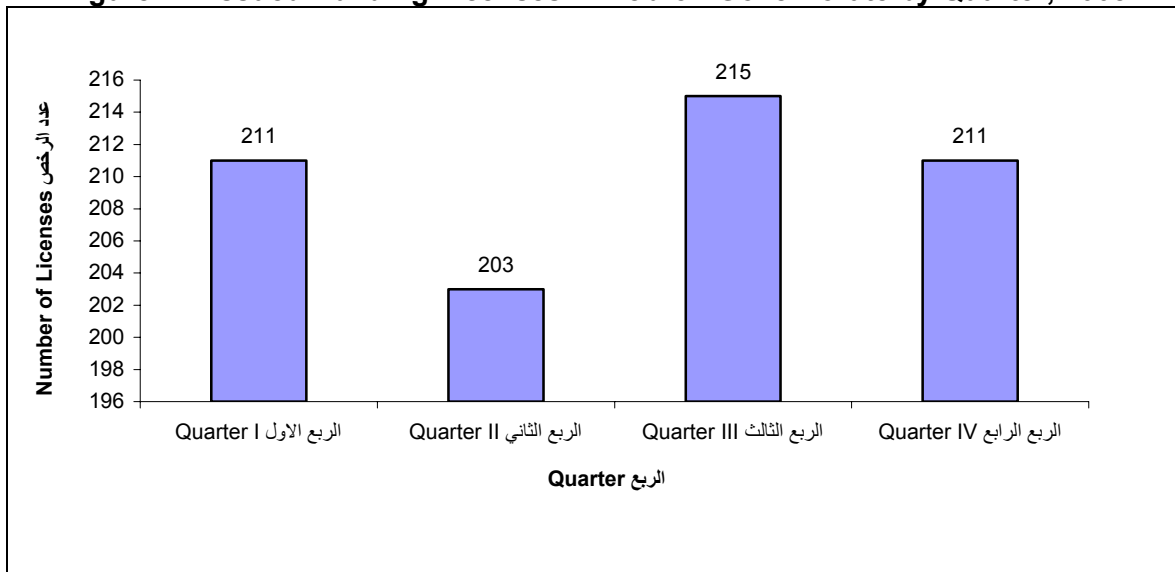
Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Hebron Governorate 1997,2007

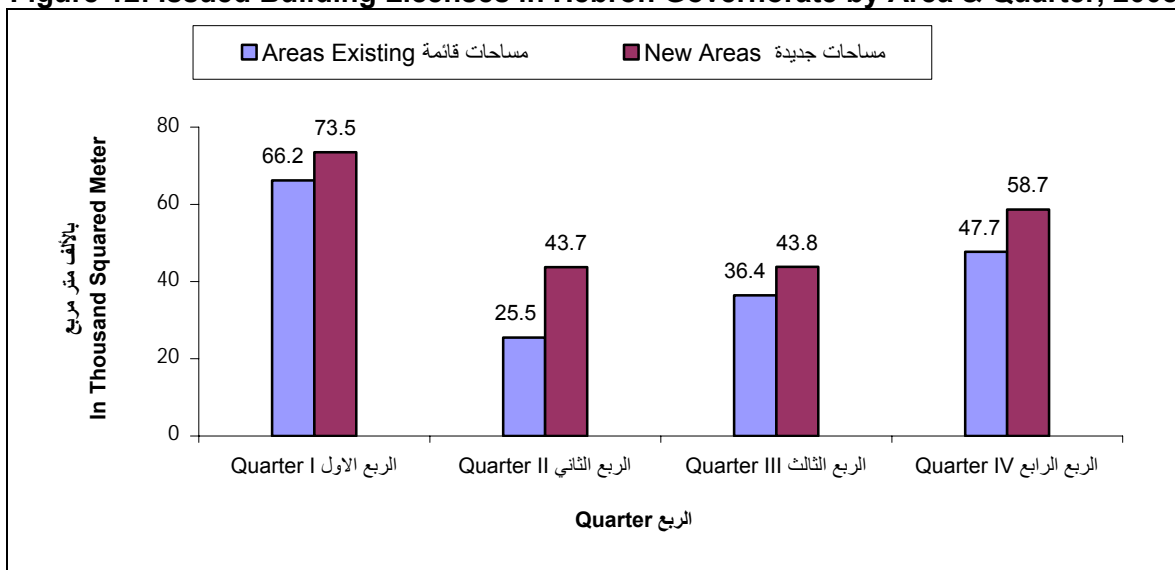

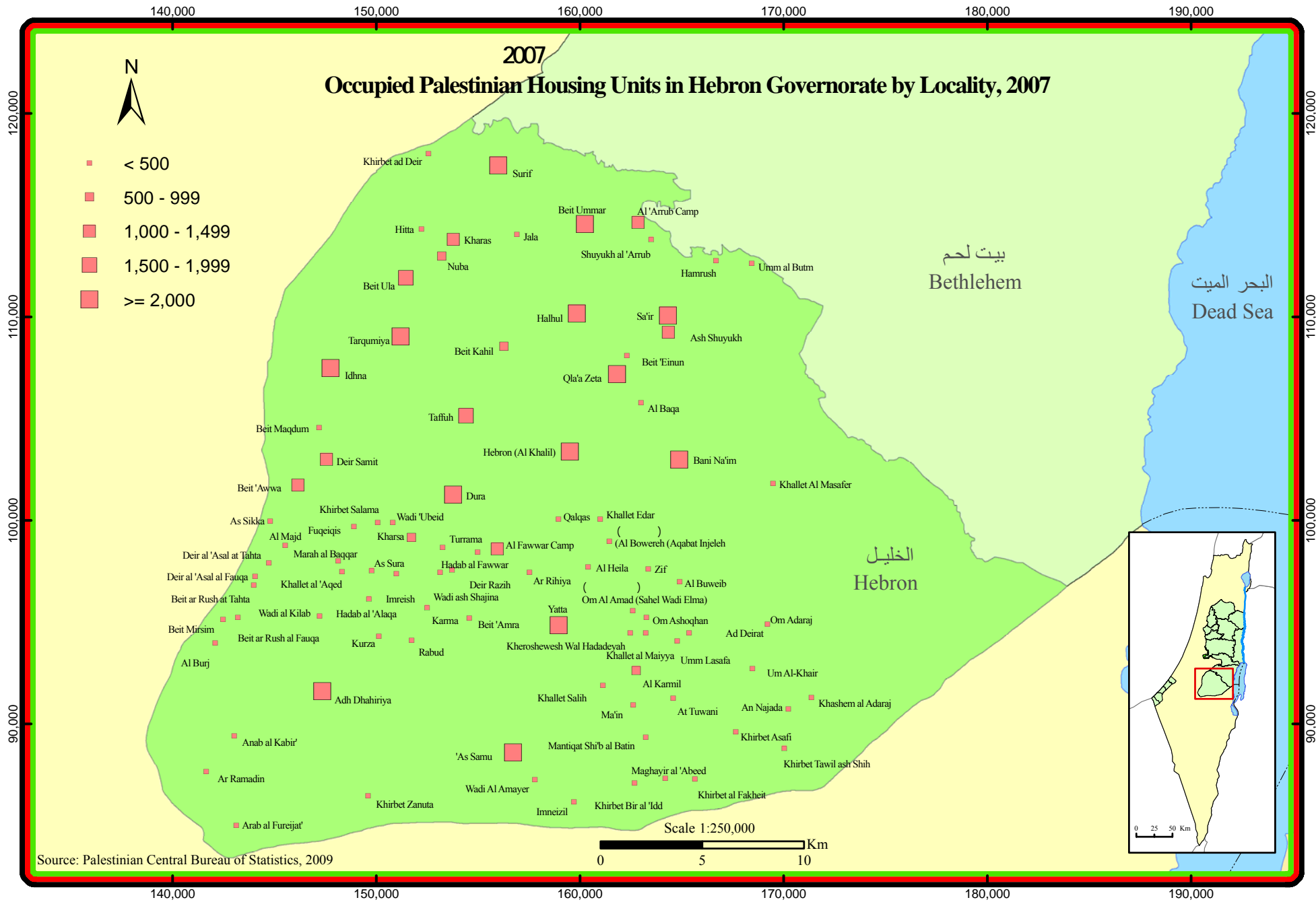
Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Hebron Governorate by Quarter, 2008

Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Hebron Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2008

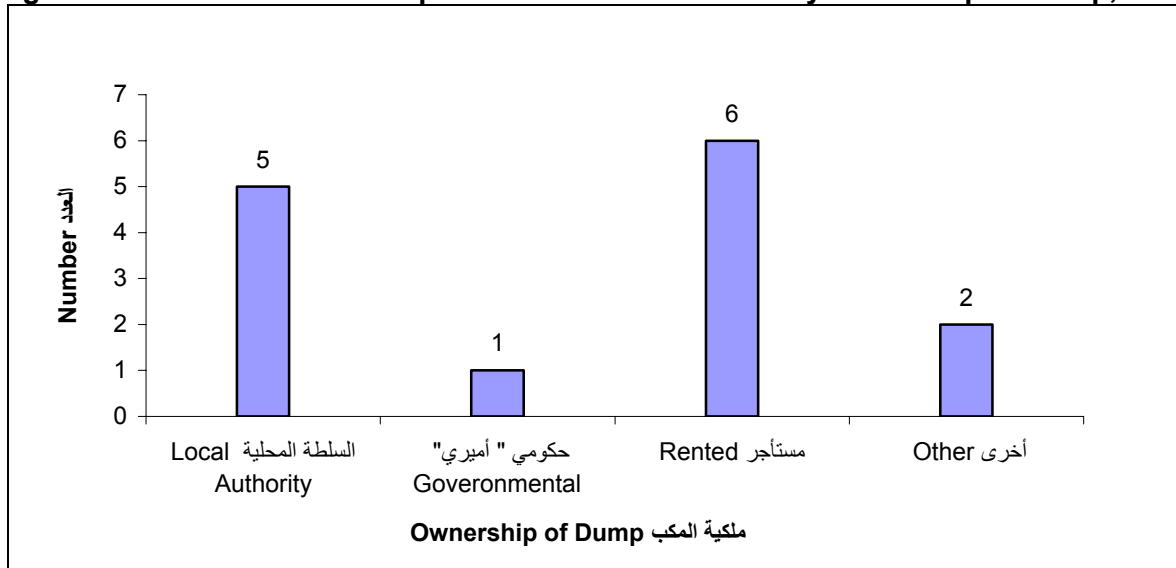

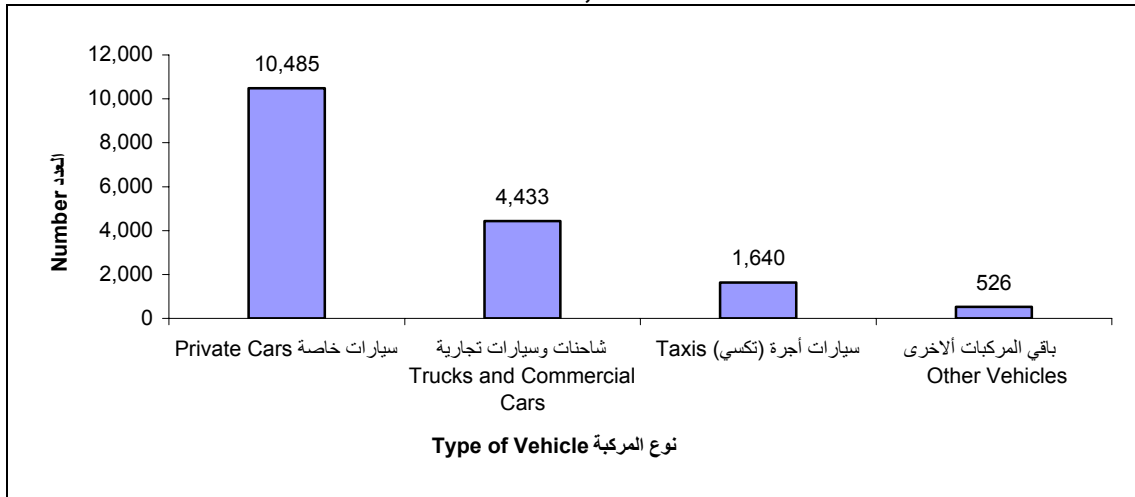

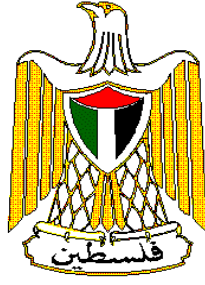

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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Hebron Governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian Governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Hebron Governorate totaled 580,955 by mid 2009 including 296,287 males and 284,668 females. The percentage of refugees living in Hebron Governorate totaled 17.9% of the total population of the Governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2008 in Hebron Governorate totaled 4,921. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 506.
- The registered live births in 2008 in Hebron Governorate totaled 18,632. The registered deaths in the Governorate for the same year totaled 1,221.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Hebron Governorate was 46%. Findings show that the percentage of the unemployed people among those participating in labor force was 25.9%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Hebron Governorate in 2007/2008 was 442 schools and 176 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Hebron Governorate was 10 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 506 at 0.9 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Hebron Governorate in 2007 was 997 square kilometers.
- 141,053 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 13,476 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 183,849 dunums producing 57,483 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 13,498 dunums producing 21,798 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Hebron Governorate totaled 87,645 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Hebron Governorate in 2008 totaled 840 for an area of 395,500 square meters.
- The number of localities in Hebron Governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 50 localities, and 42 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 74 localities, and 18 localities were without electricity.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Hebron Governorate was 17,084.
- The values of imports rose in Hebron Governorate in 2007 compared to 2003–2006 reaching 452.2 million US\$.
- Exports in Hebron Governorate in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 147.6 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Hebron Governorate in 2007 totaling 304.6 million US\$.

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
