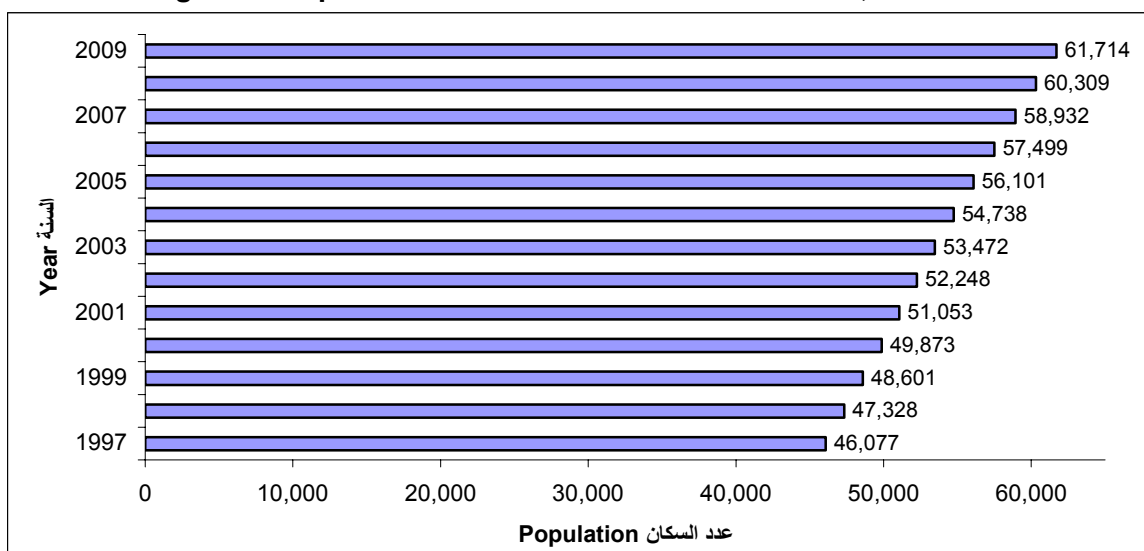

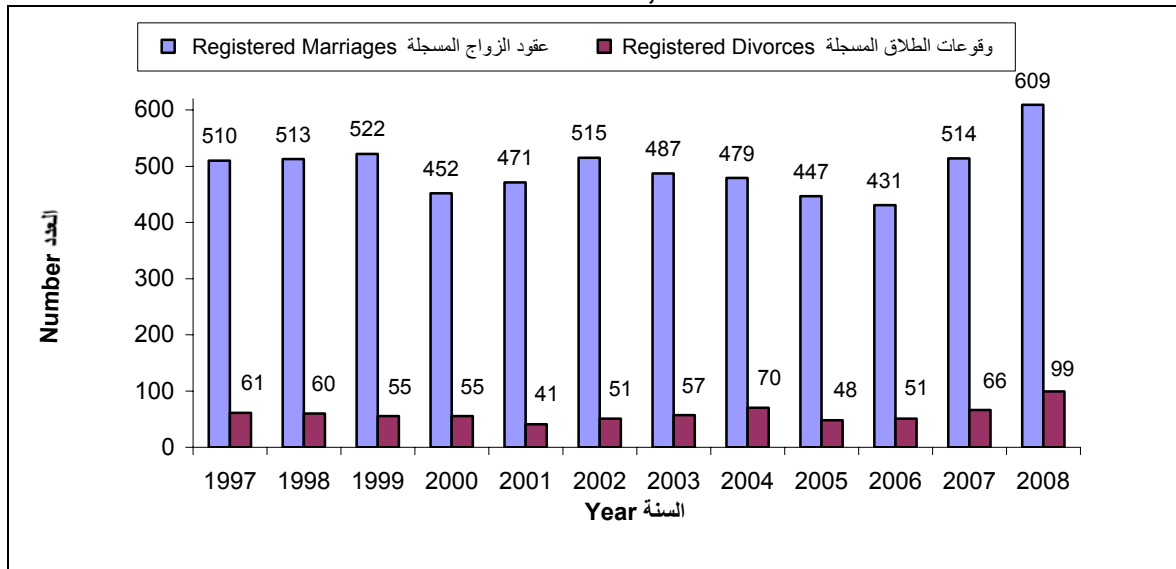

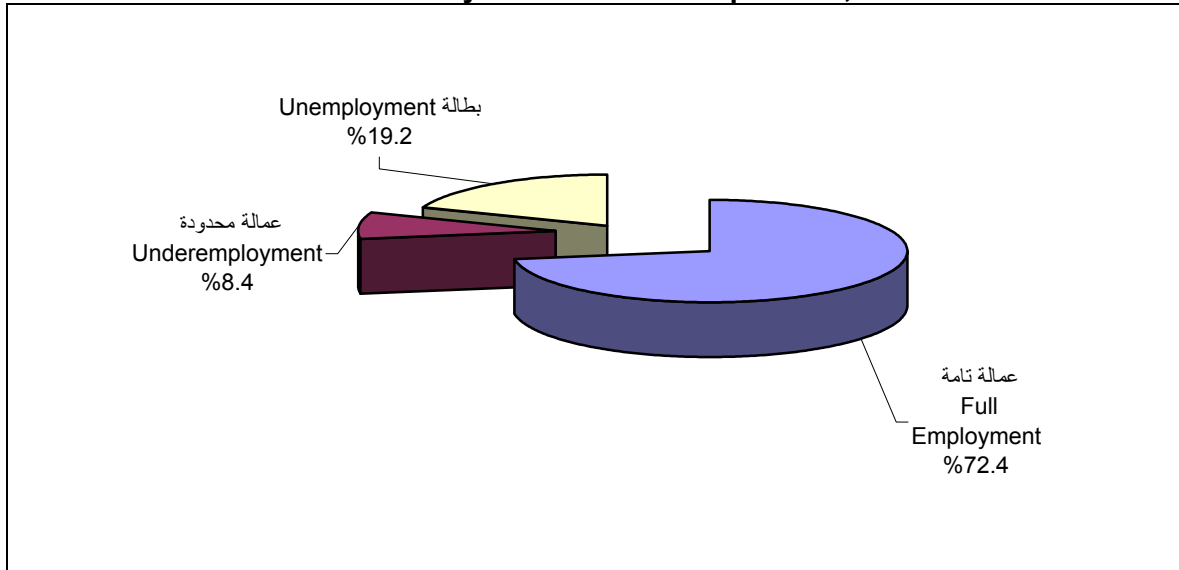

**Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Salfit Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008**

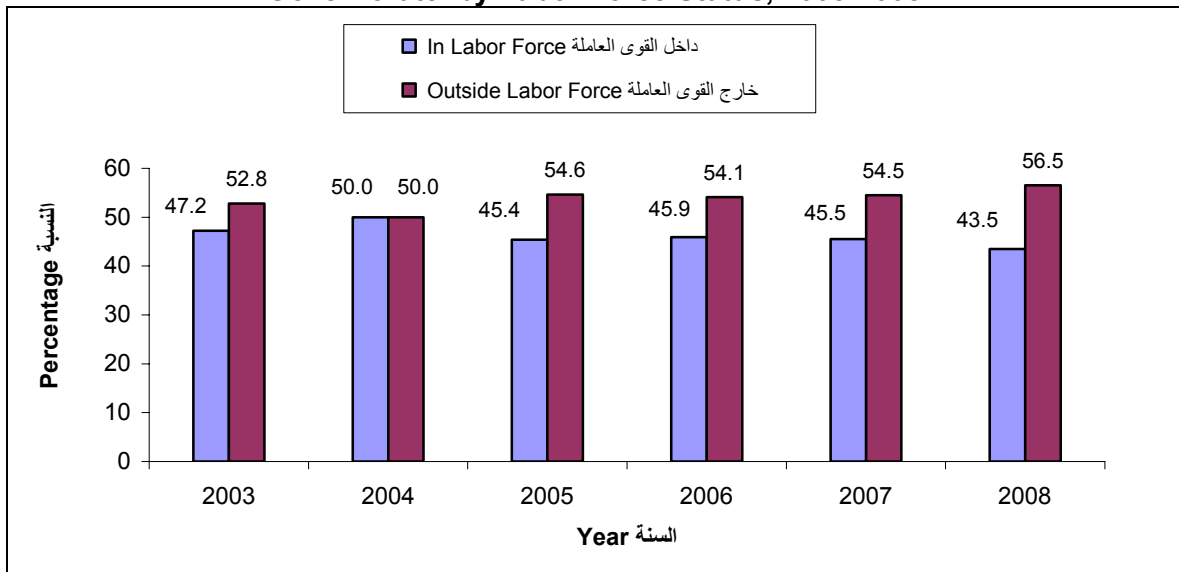

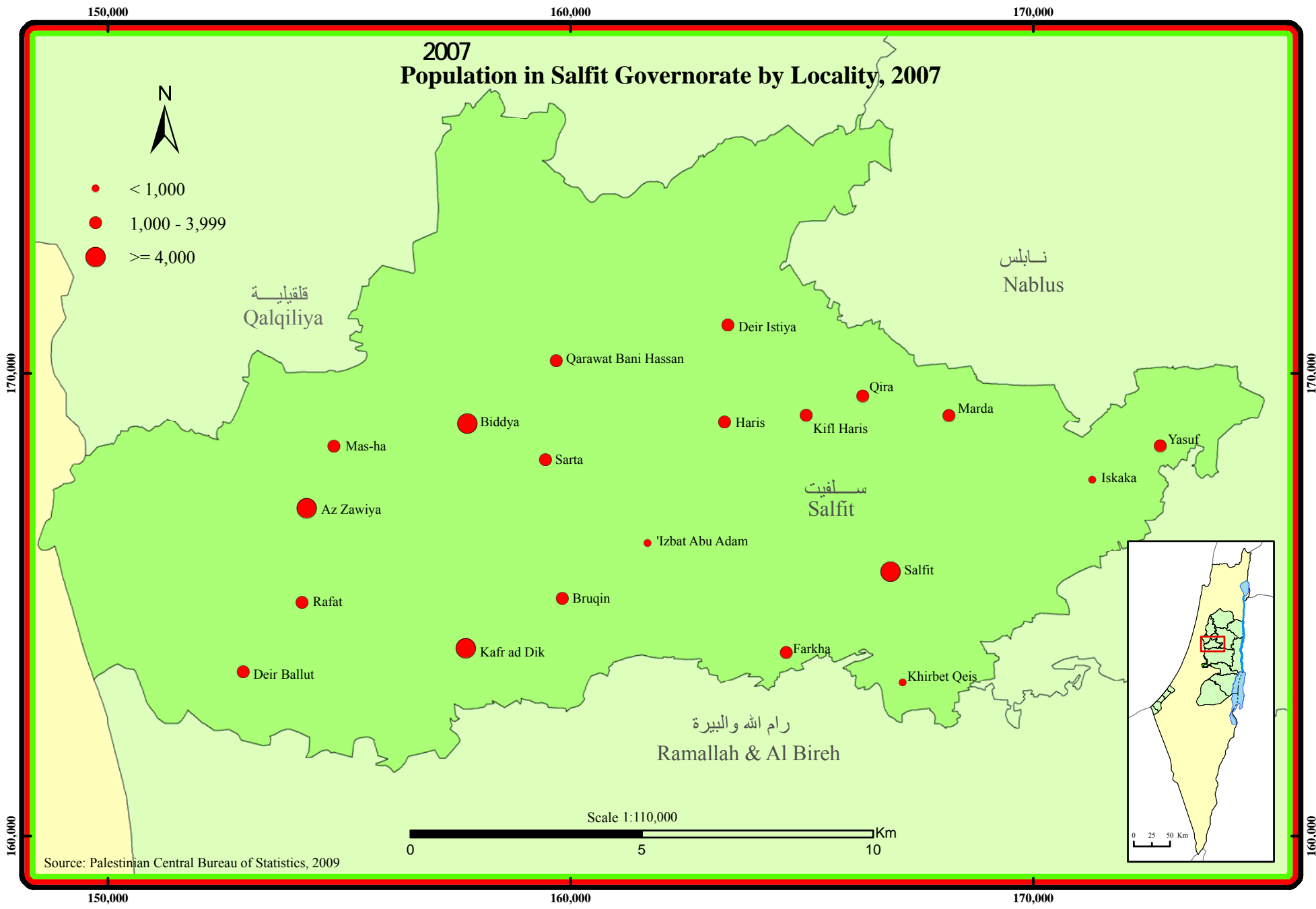

**Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Salfit Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008**









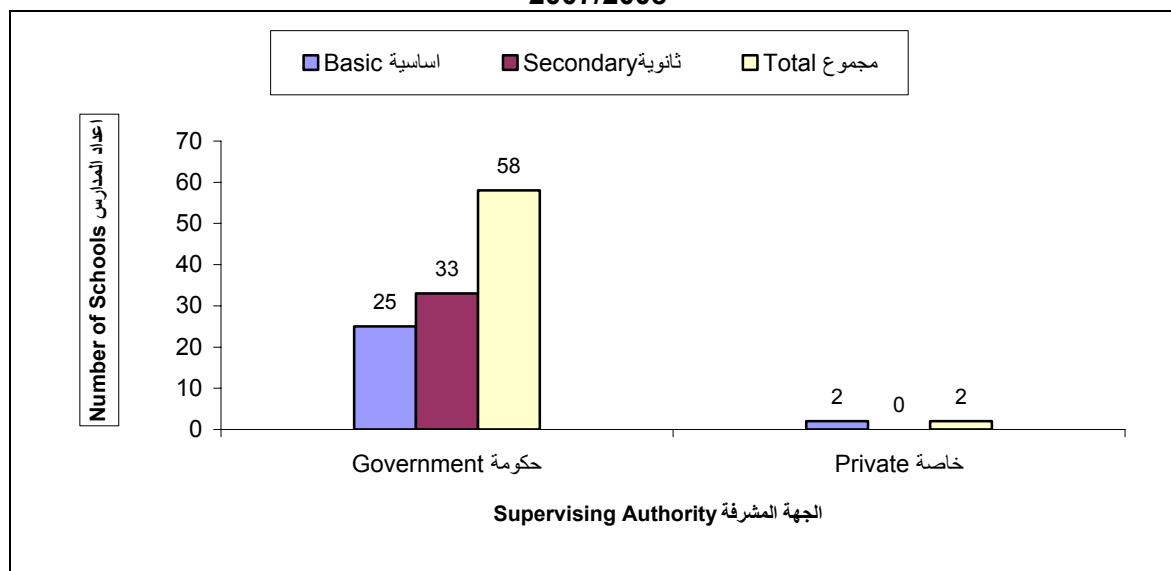

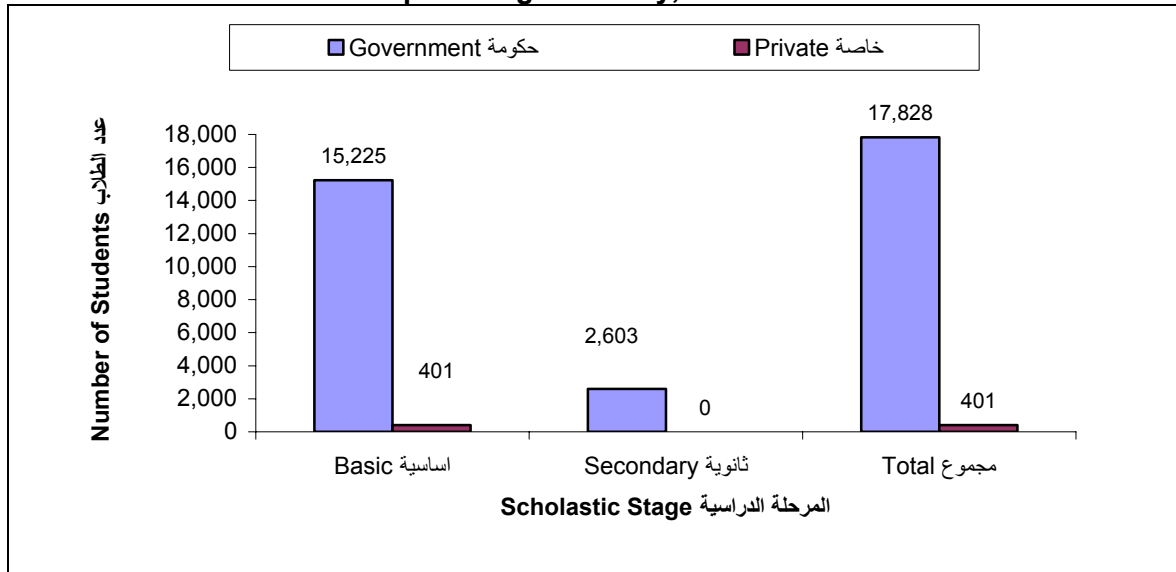
**Figure 5: Number of Schools in Salfit Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008**

**Figure 6: Numbers of Students in Schools in Salfit Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008**



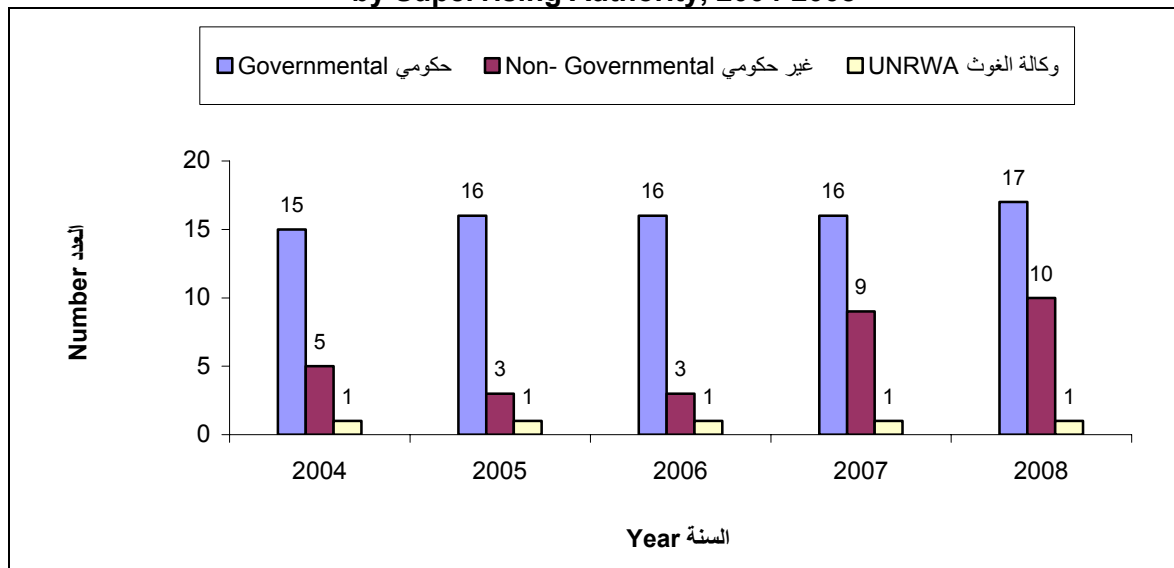

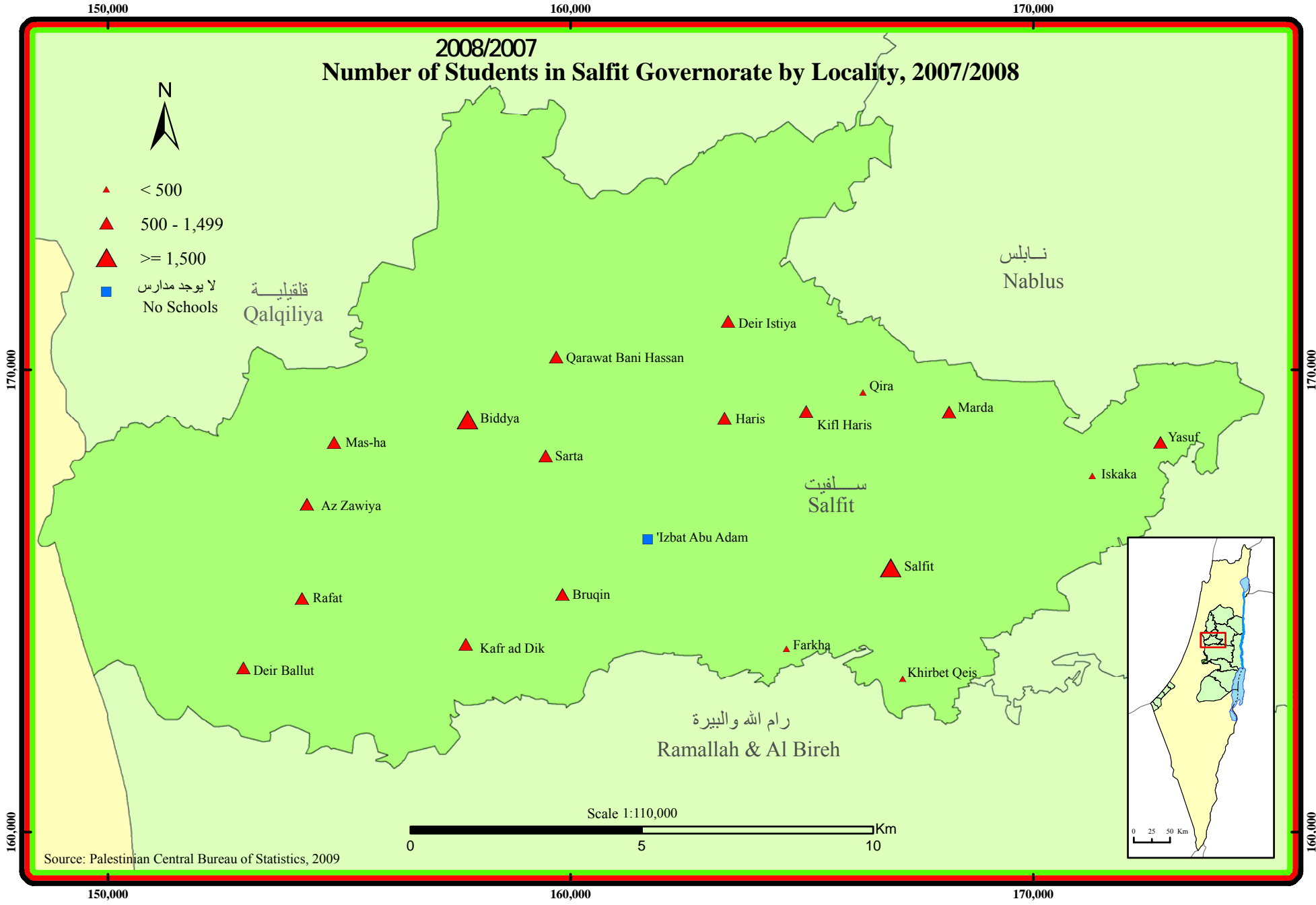

**Figure 7: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Salfit Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008**







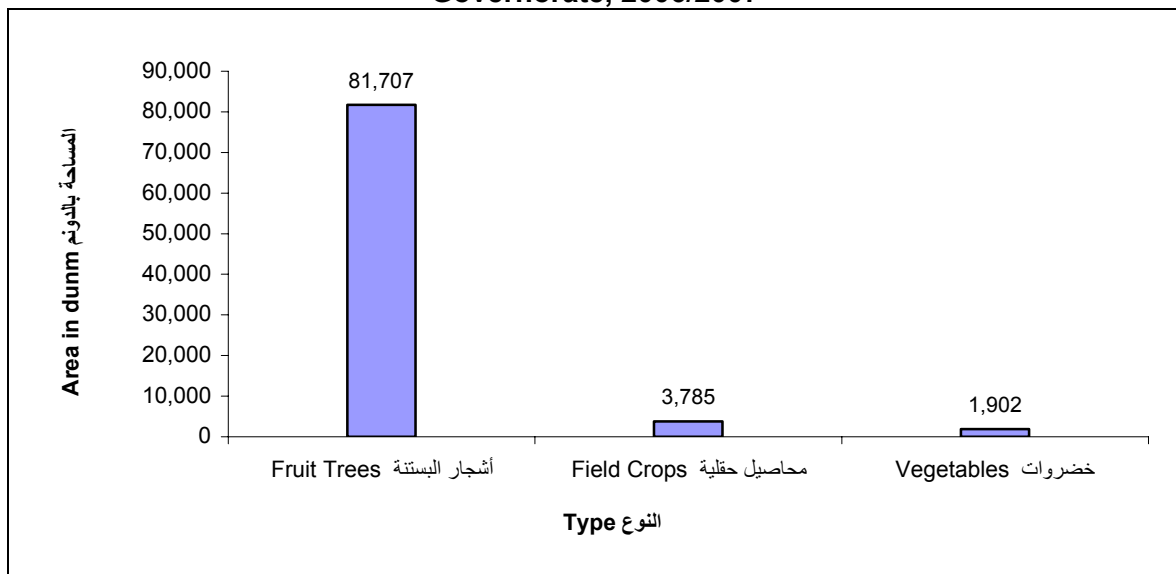

**Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Salfit Governorate, 2006/2007**

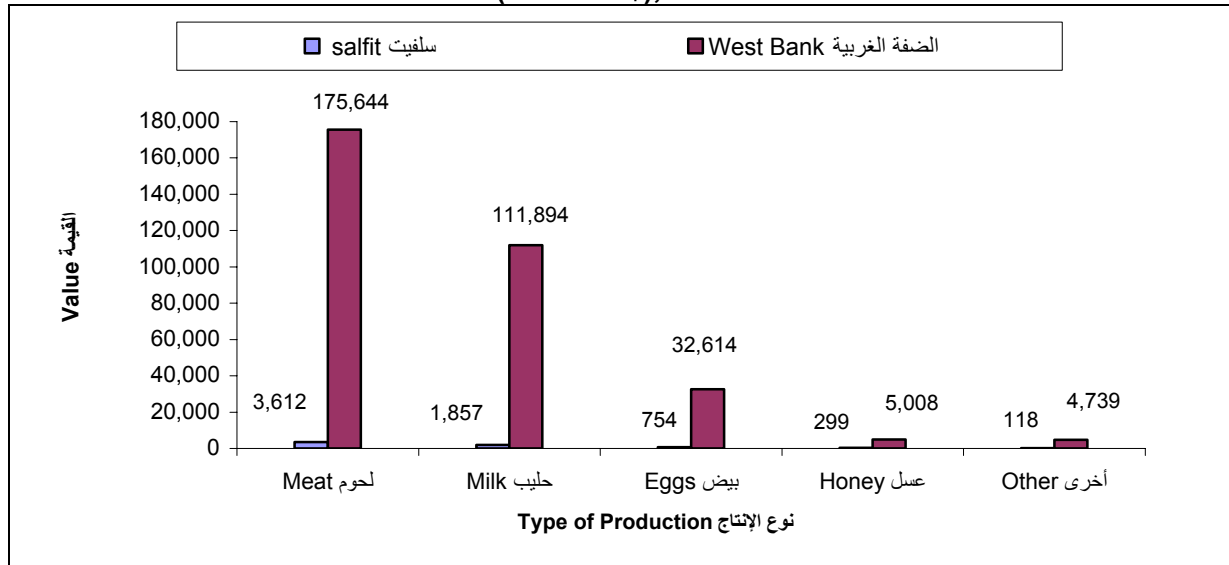

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Salfit Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007



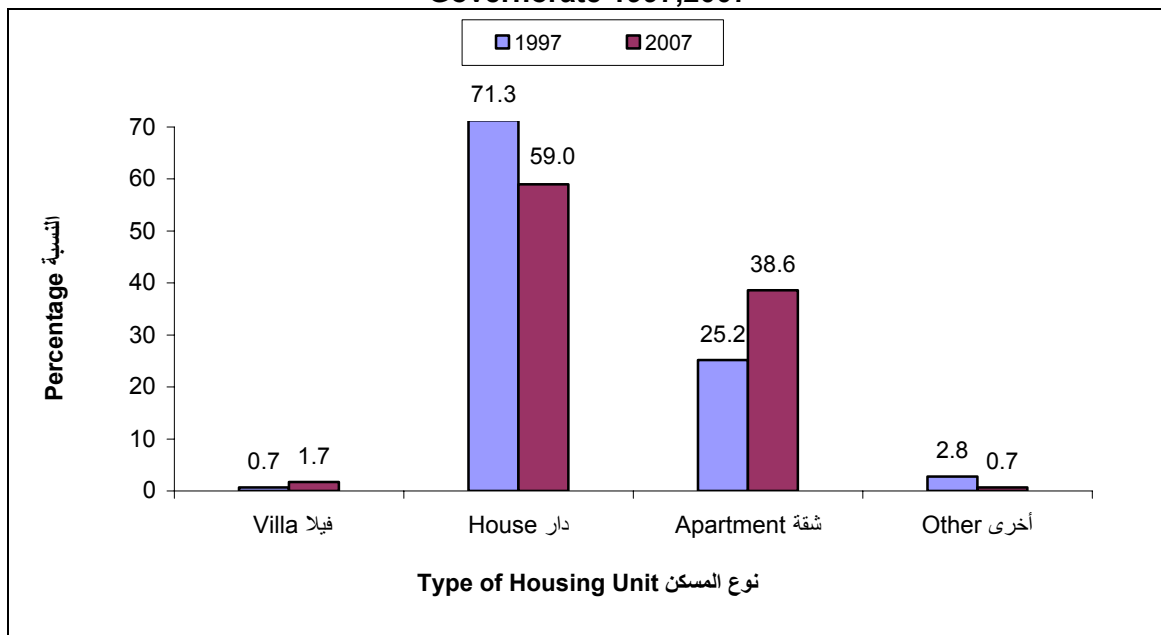

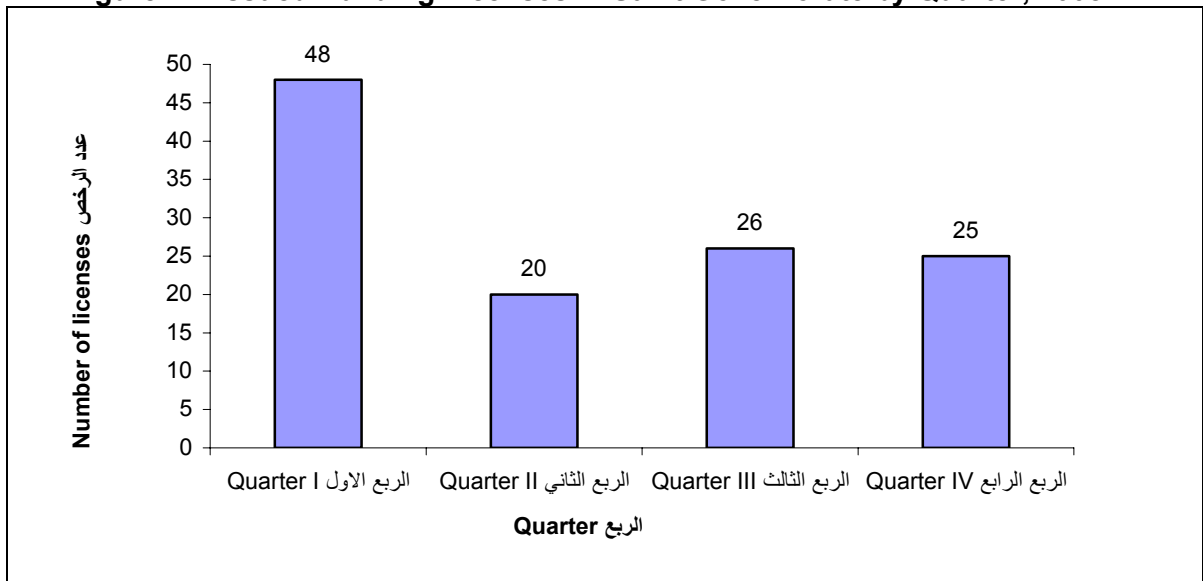
Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Salfit Governorate 1997,2007

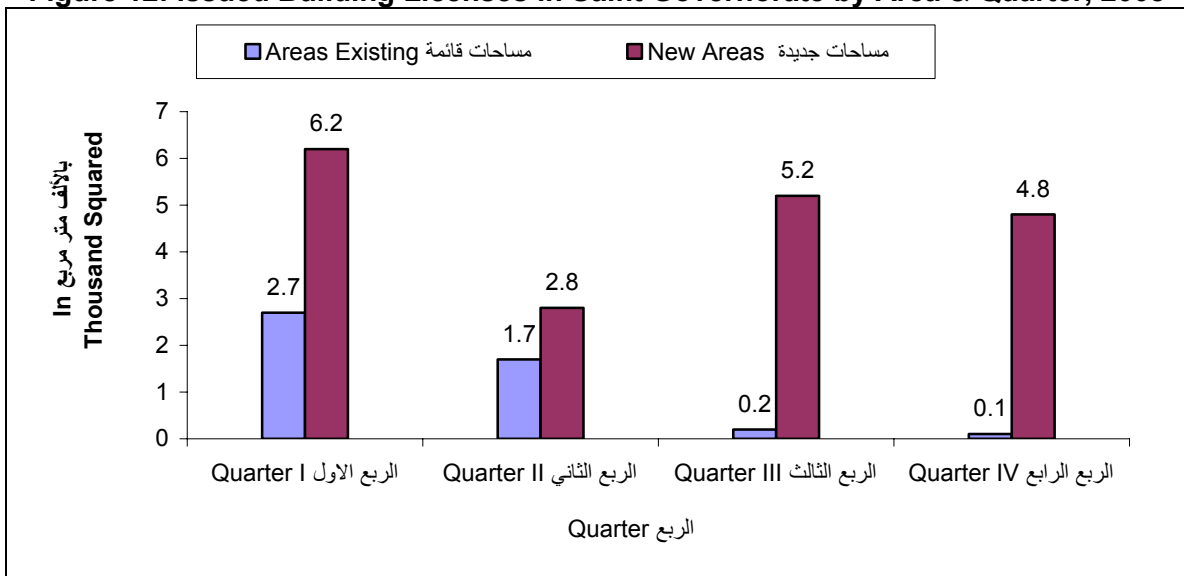

Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Quarter, 2008

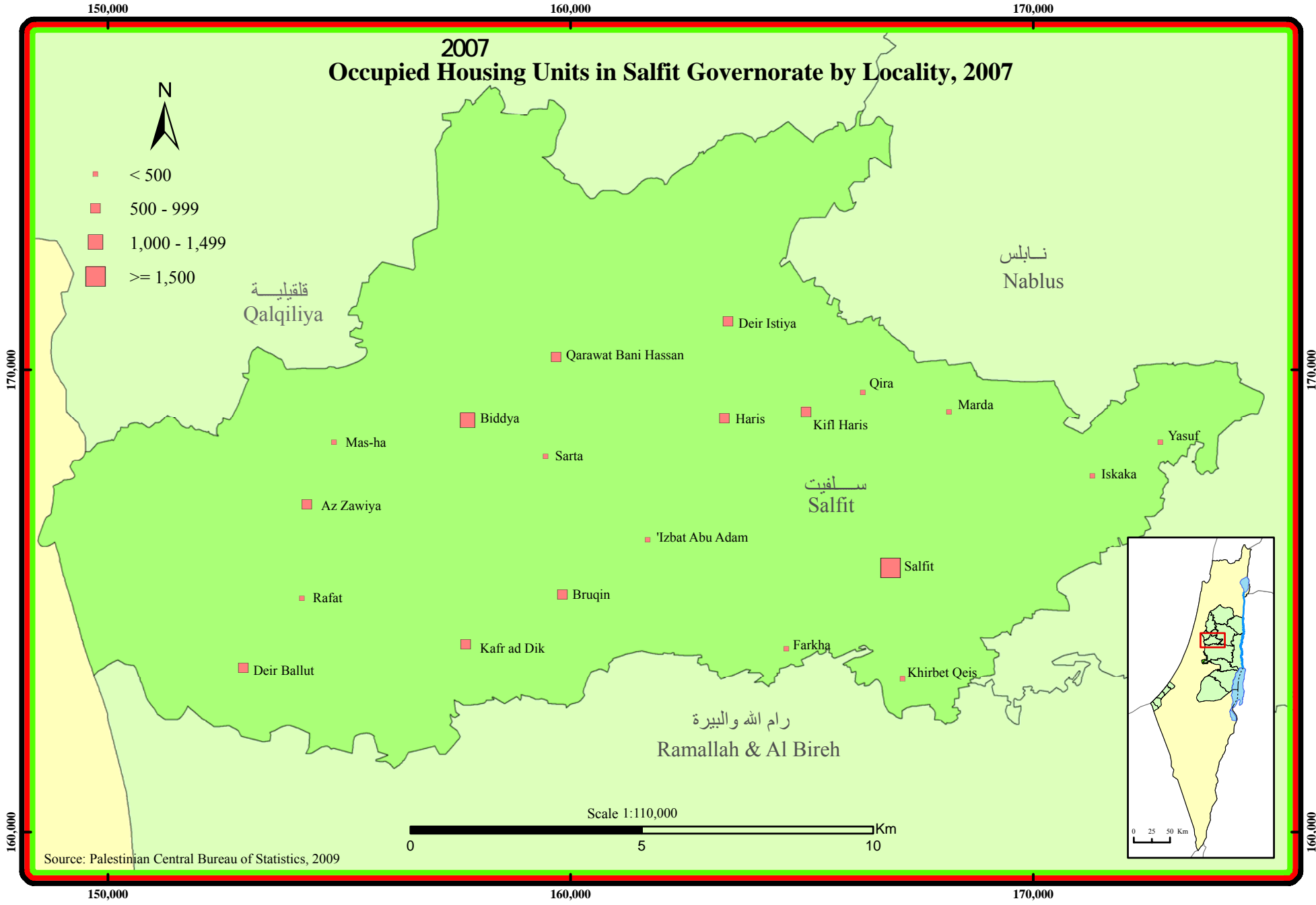

Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2008









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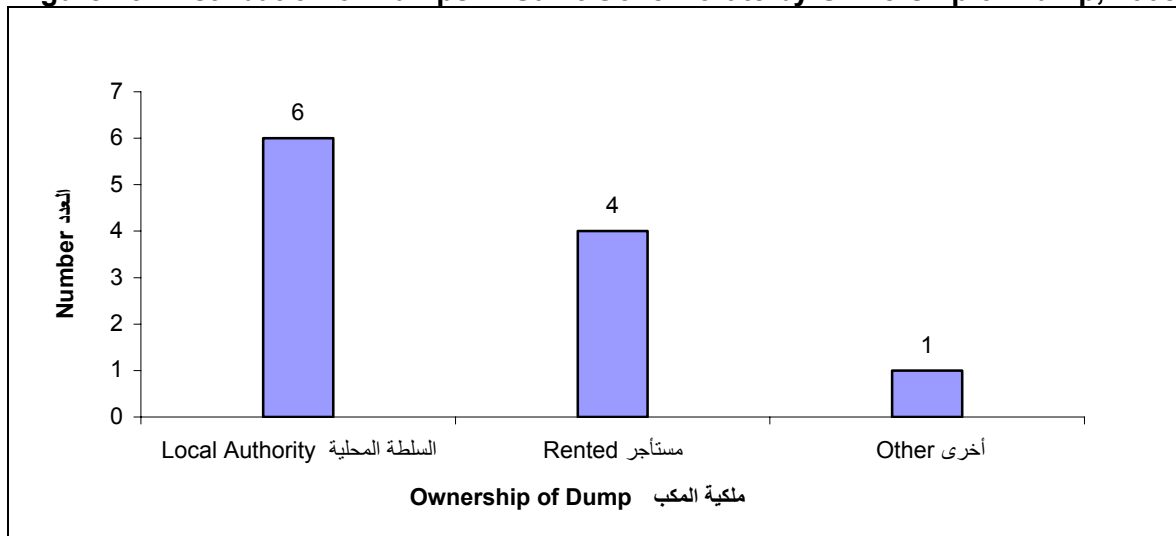

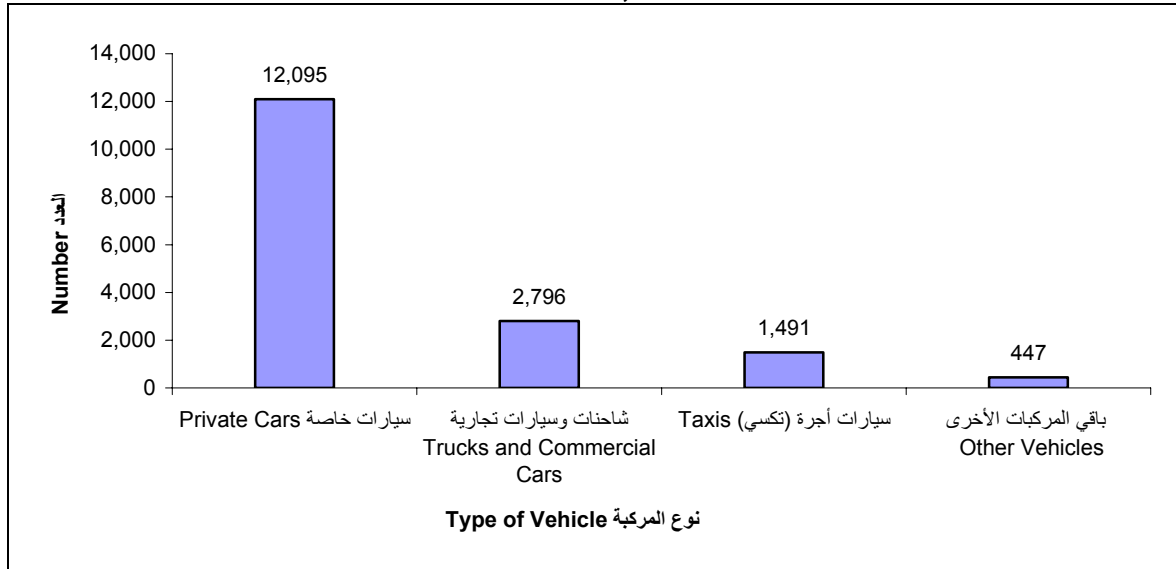

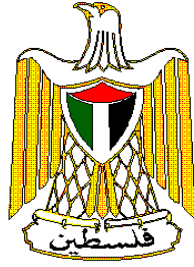

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## Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Salfit governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Salfit governorate totaled 61,714 by mid 2009 including 31,351 males and 30,363 females. The percentage of refugees living in Salfit governorate totaled 8.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2008 in Salfit governorate totaled 609. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 99.
- The registered live births in 2008 in Salfit governorate totaled 2,016. The registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 206.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Salfit governorate is 43.5%. Findings showed that the percentage of the unemployed people among those participating labor force was 19.2%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Salfit governorate in 2007/2008 was 60 schools and 26 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Salfit governorate was one hospital. number of hospital beds totaled 30 at 0.5 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Salfit governorate 2007 was 204 square kilometers.
- 3,785 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 787 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 81,707 dunums producing 3,848 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 1,902 dunums producing 3,314 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Salfit governorate totaled 10,958 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Salfit governorate in 2008 totaled 119 for an area of 23,700 square meters.
- The number of localities in Salfit governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 18 localities, and 2 localities without water network, Electricity network was the main source for 20 localities.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Nablus & Salfit governorates was 16,829.
- The values of imports rose in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 compared to 2003–2006, reaching 408.8 million US\$.
- Exports in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 65.9 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 totaling 342.9 million US\$.



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
