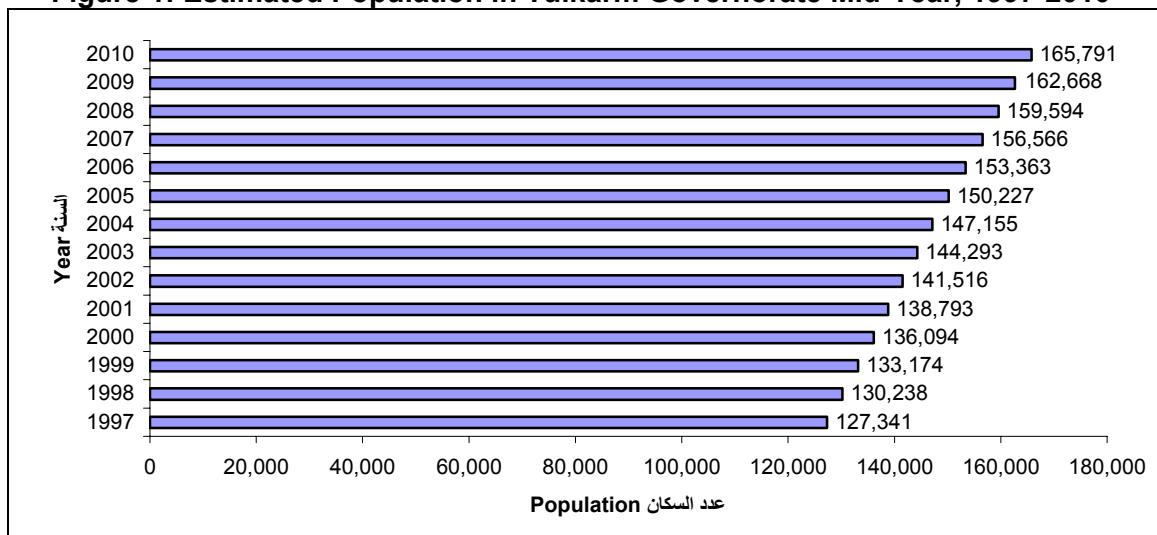

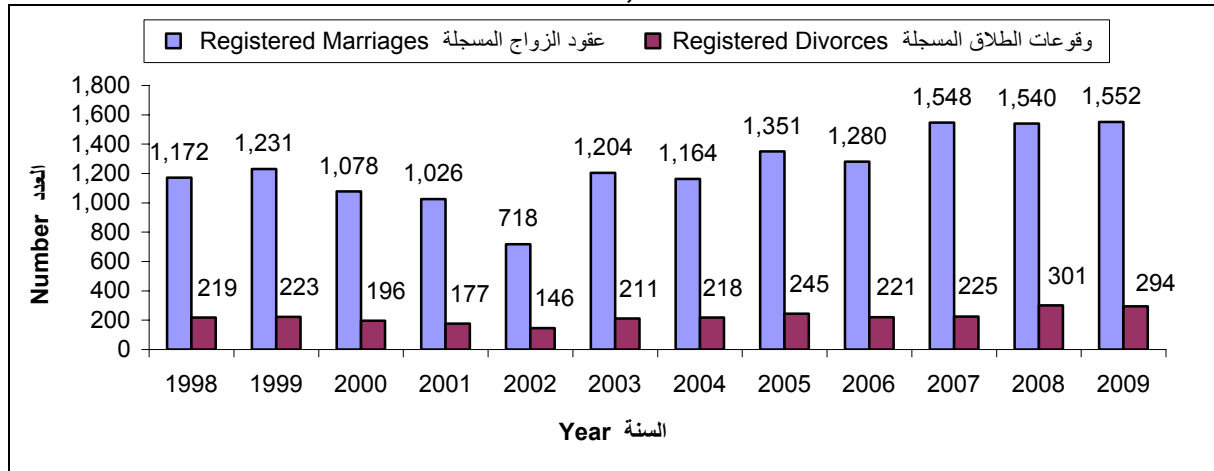

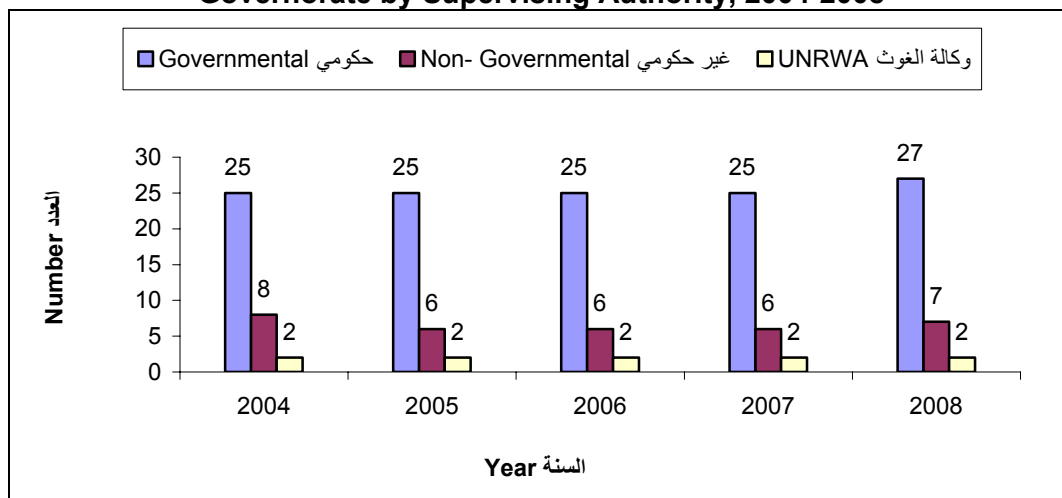

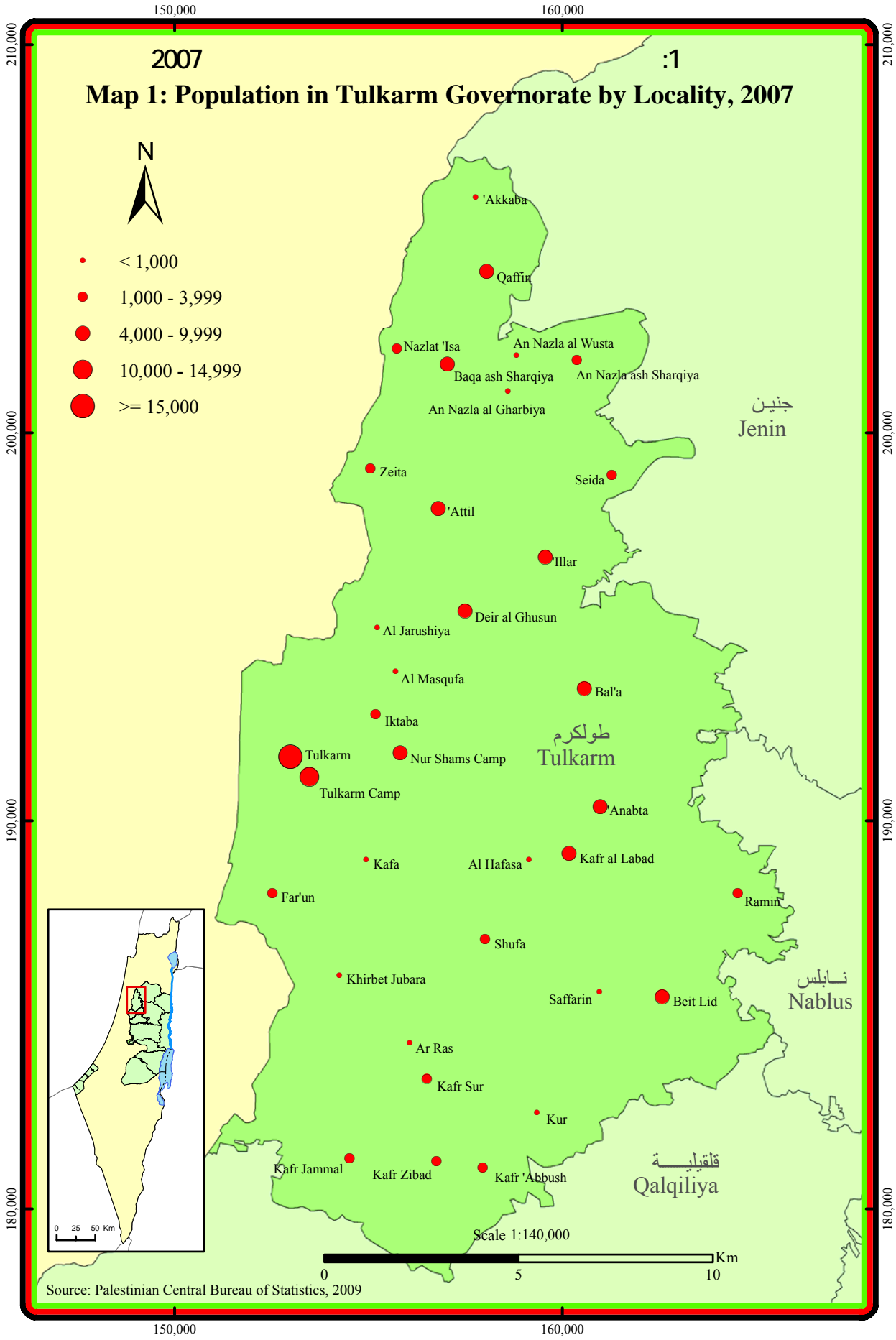

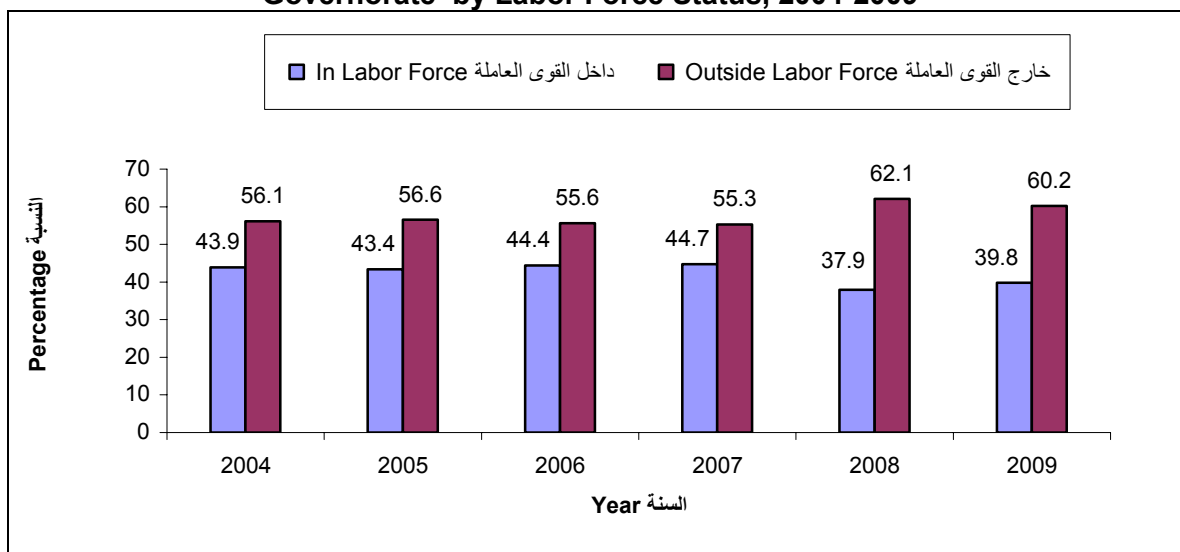

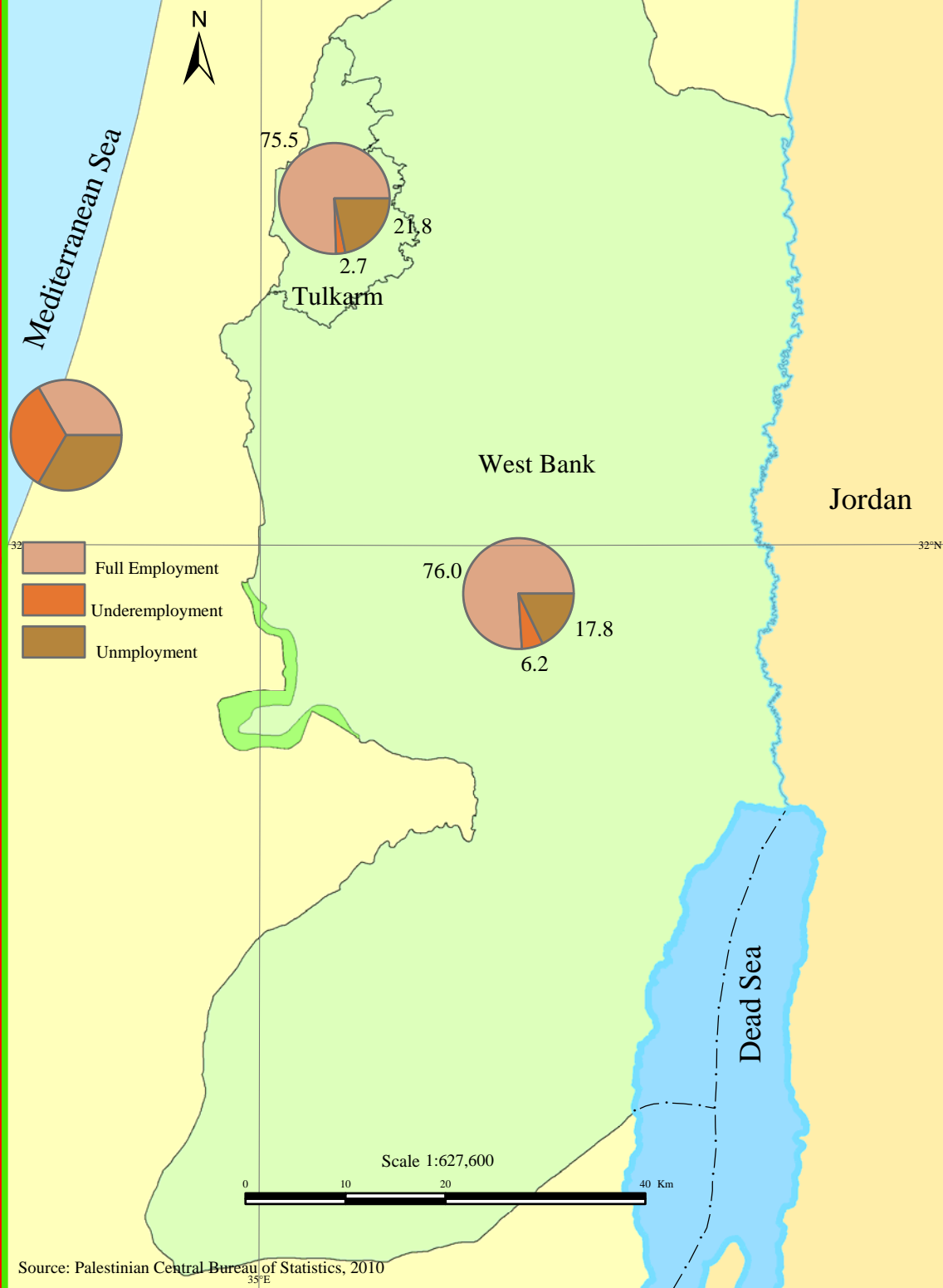
**Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Tulkarm Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009**

**Map 2: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Tulkarm Governorate and West Bank by Labor Force Components, 2009**





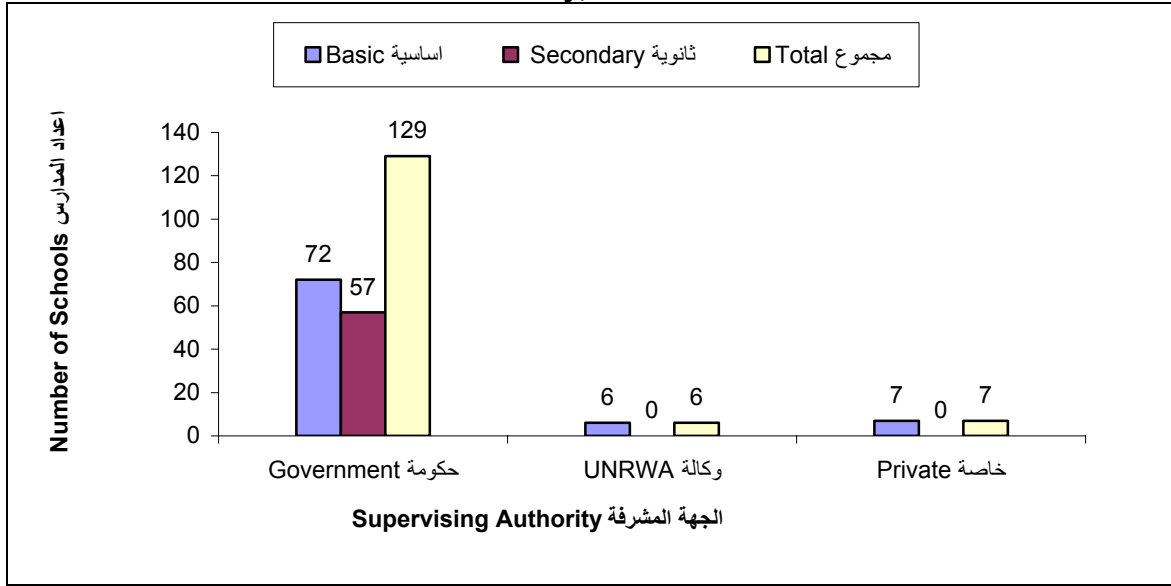

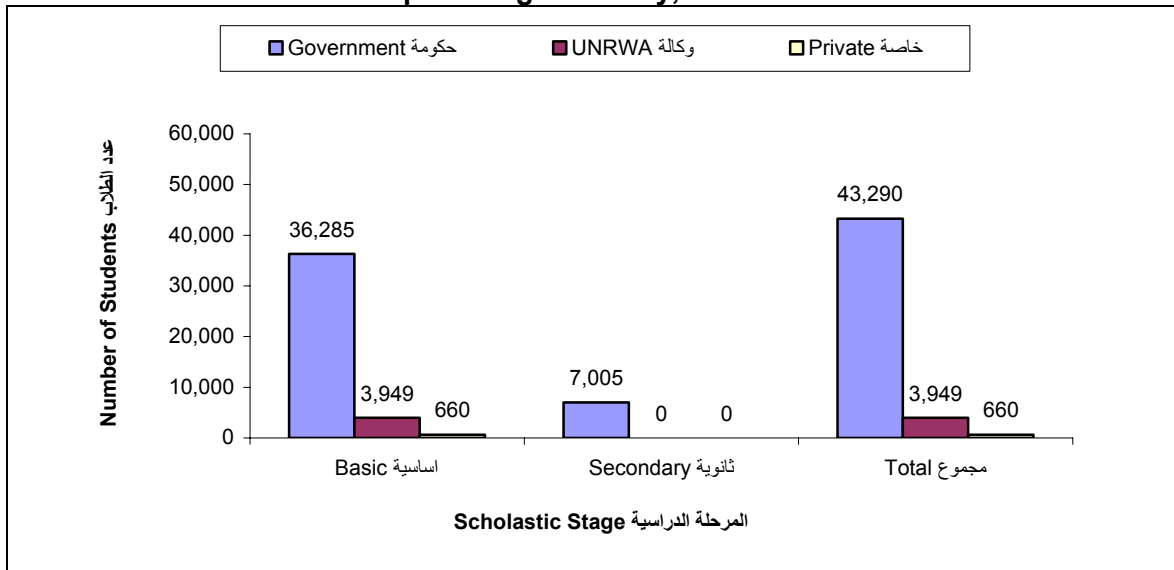
Figure 6: Number of Schools in Tulkarm Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009

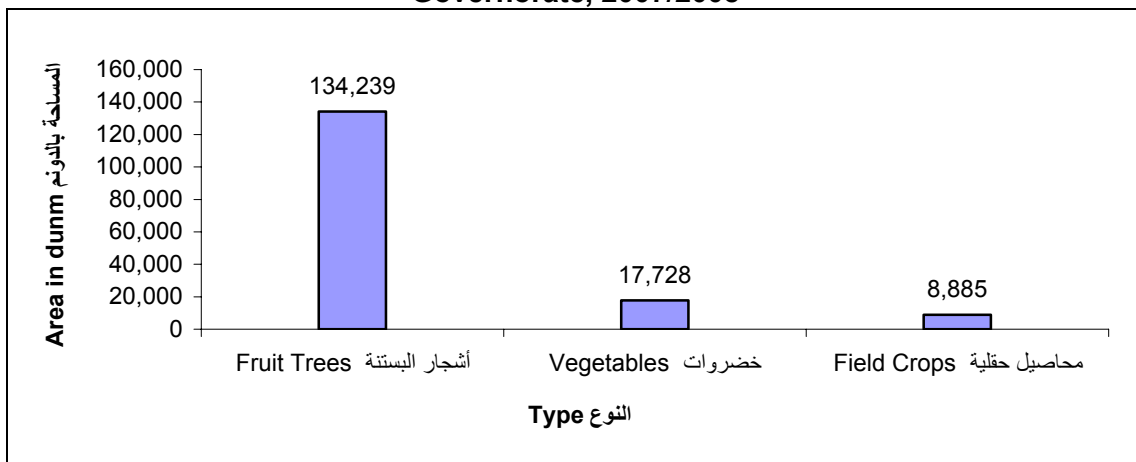
Figure 7: Number of Students in Schools in Tulkarm Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009

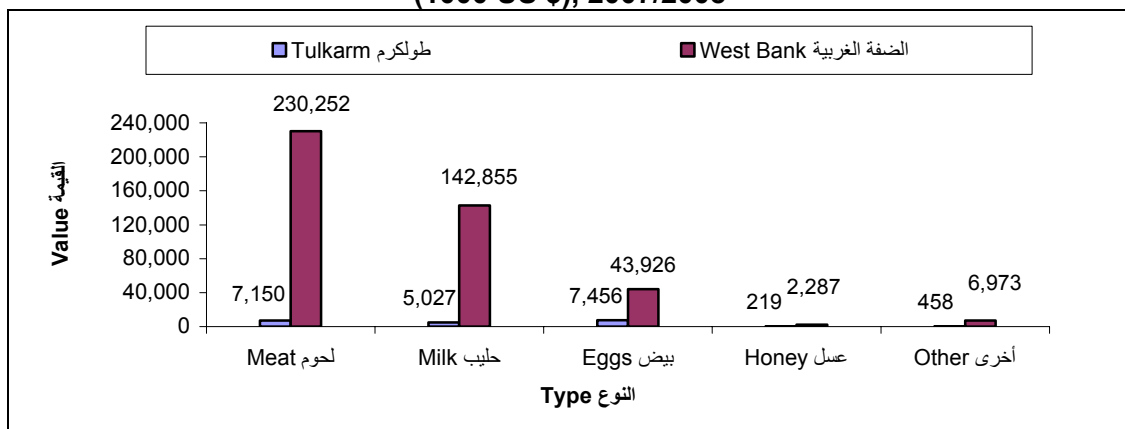
Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Tulkarm Governorate, 2007/2008

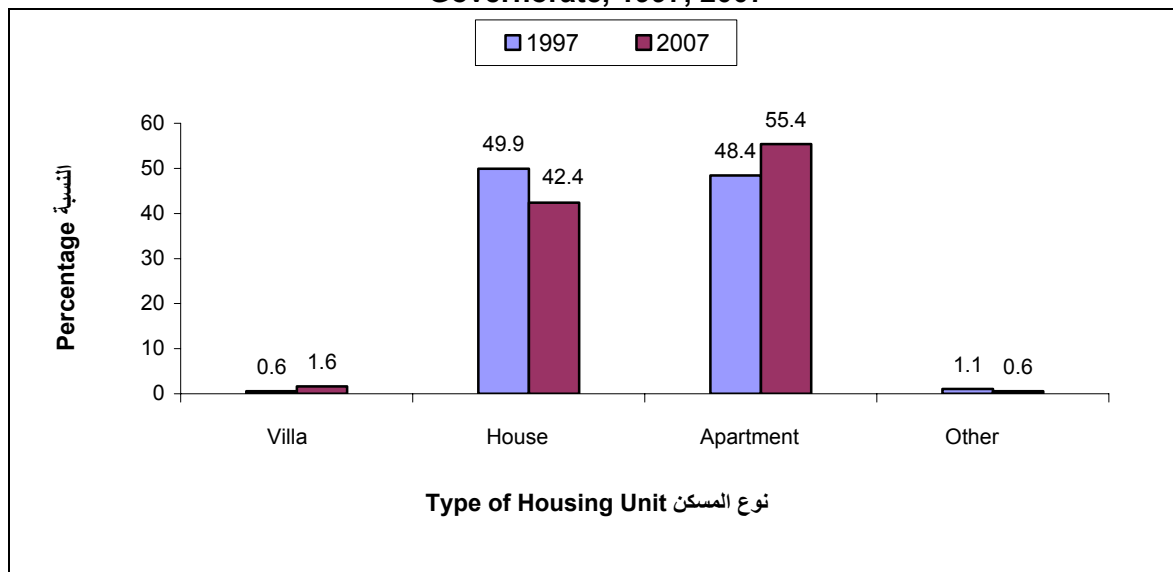
Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Tulkarm Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2007/2008

**Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Tulkarm Governorate, 1997, 2007**



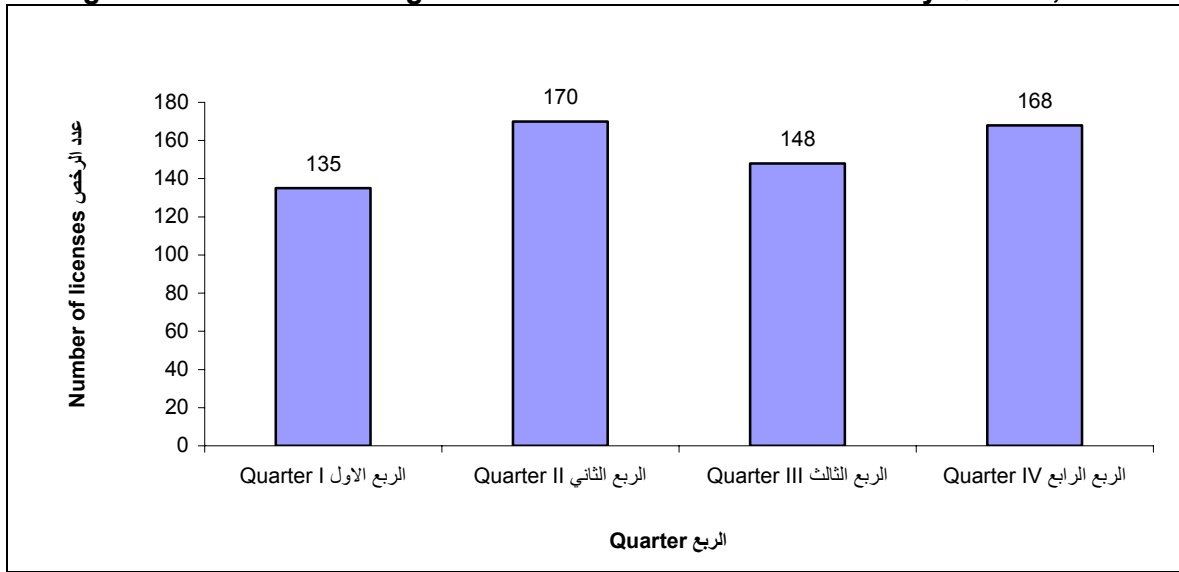

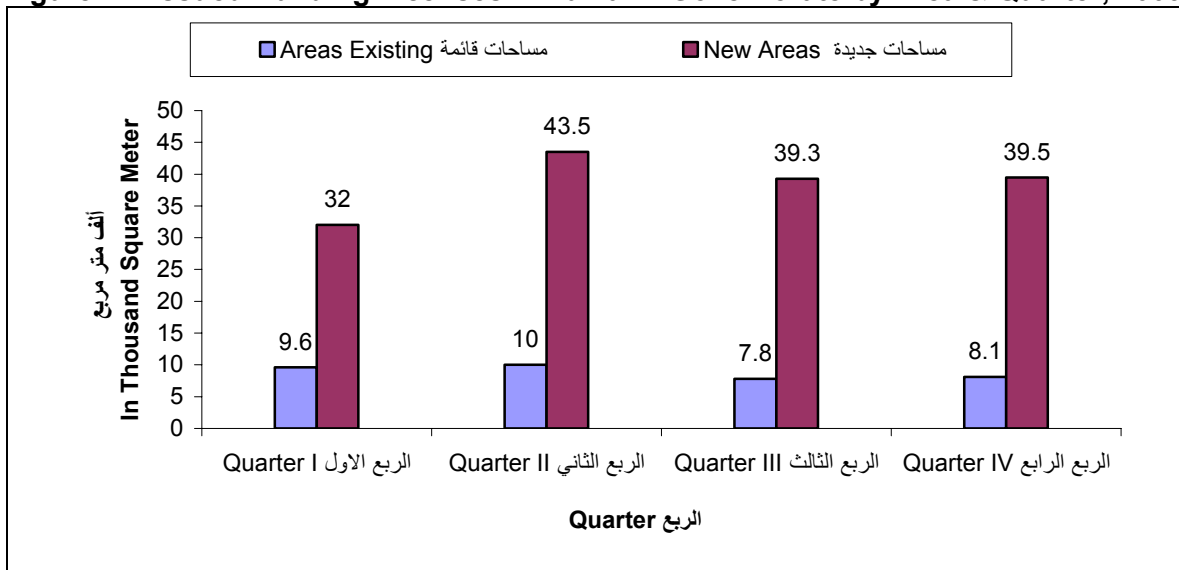
Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Tulkarm Governorate by Quarter, 2009

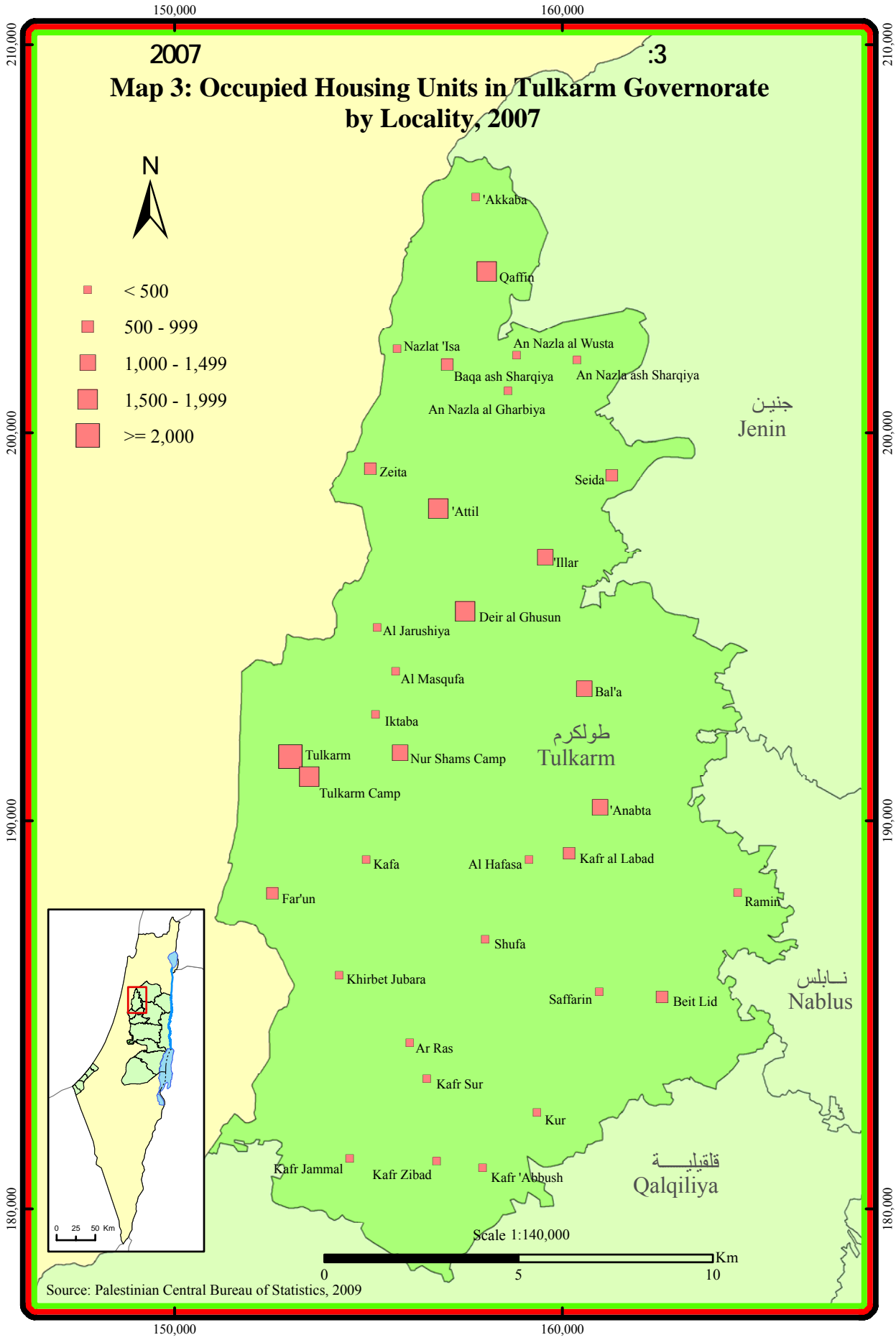

Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Tulkarm Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009





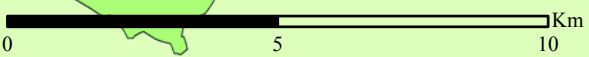
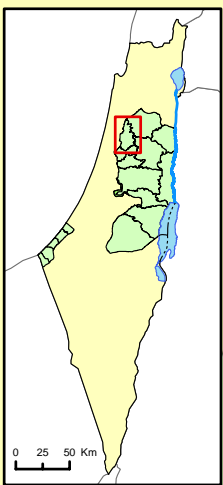

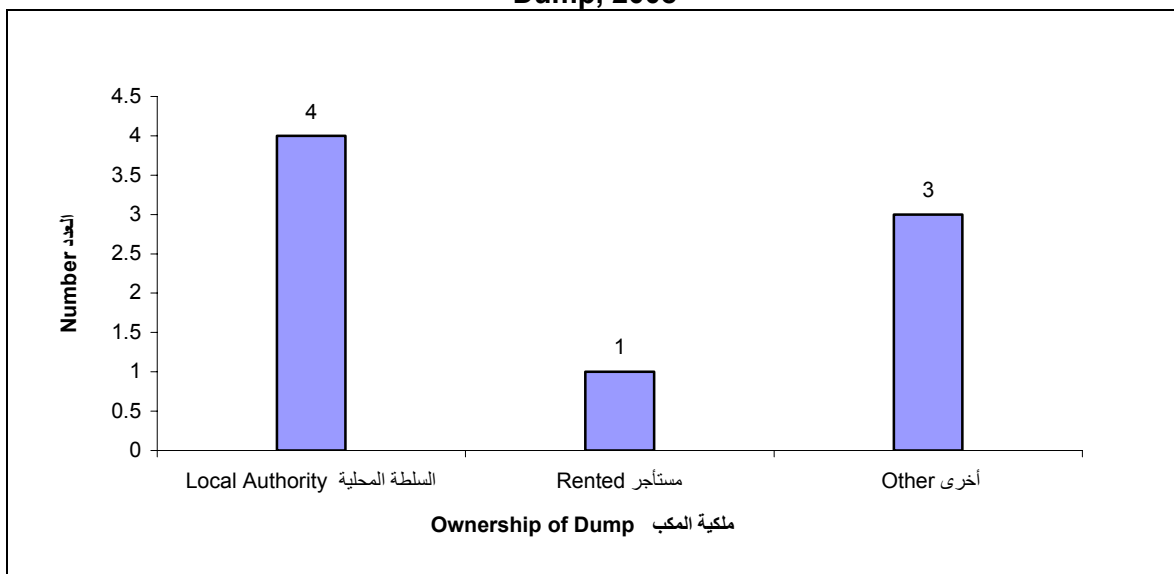

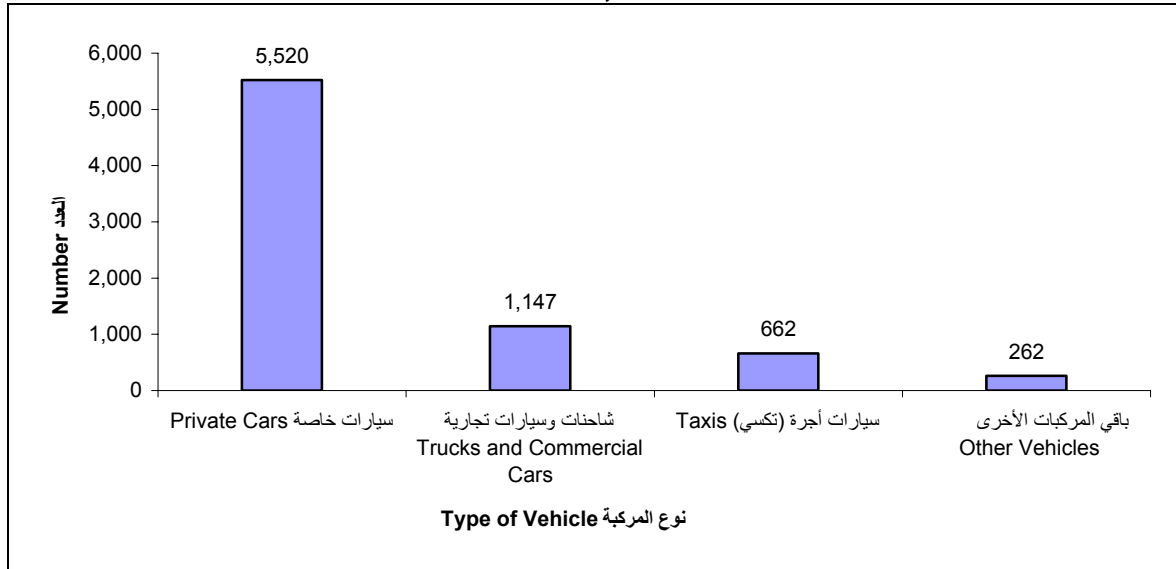

## Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in the Tulkarm governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Tulkarm governorate totaled 165,791 by mid 2010 including 83,724 males and 82,067 females. The percentage of refugees living in Tulkarm governorate totaled 33.5% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Share'a courts during 2009 in Tulkarm governorate totaled 1,552. The number of registered divorce cases at Share'a courts totaled 294.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Tulkarm governorate totaled 4,446. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 559.
- The number of hospitals in 2009 in Tulkarm governorate was 3 hospitals. The average number of hospital beds totaled 163 at 1.0 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Tulkarm governorate is 39.8%. Findings show that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating in the labor force was 21.8%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Tulkarm governorate in 2008/2009 was 142 schools and 51 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Tulkarm governorate in 2008 was 246 square kilometers.
- 8,885 dunums of field crops cultivated land at a production capacity of 5,815 tons. The area planted with trees totaled 134,239 dunums producing 31,342 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 17,728 dunums producing 97,392 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- The number of occupied houses in Tulkarm governorate totaled 29,708 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Tulkarm governorate in 2009 totaled 621 for an area of 189,700 square meters.
- The number of localities in Tulkarm governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 31 localities, and 4 localities without water network. Electricity networks was the main source for 35 localities.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Tulkarm governorate was 7,591.
- The values of imports rose in Tulkarm governorate in 2008 compared to 2004–2007 reaching 133.9 million US \$
- Exports in Tulkarm governorate in 2008 rose, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching 17.3 million US\$
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Tulkarm governorate in 2008 totaling 116.6 million US\$
