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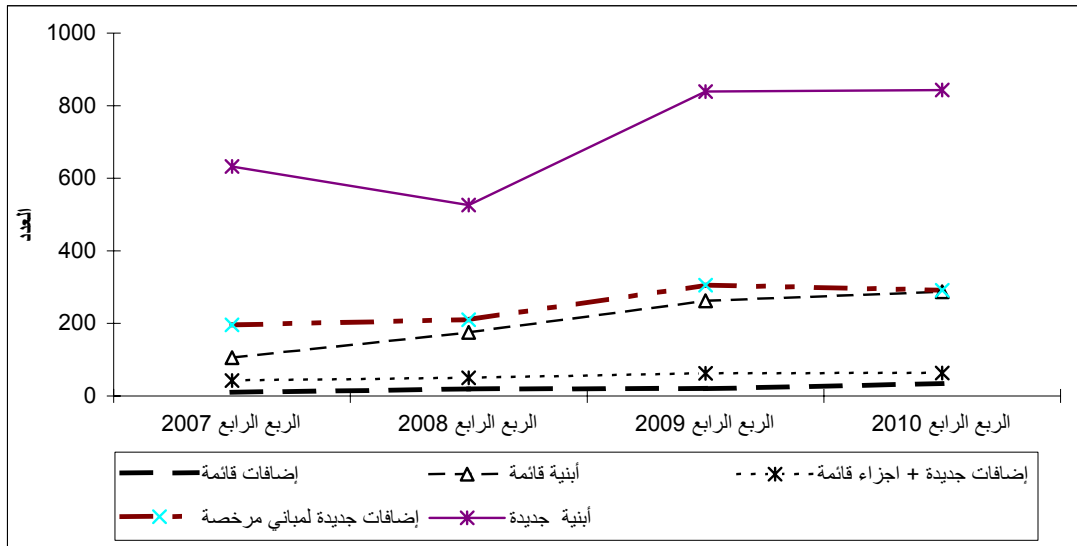

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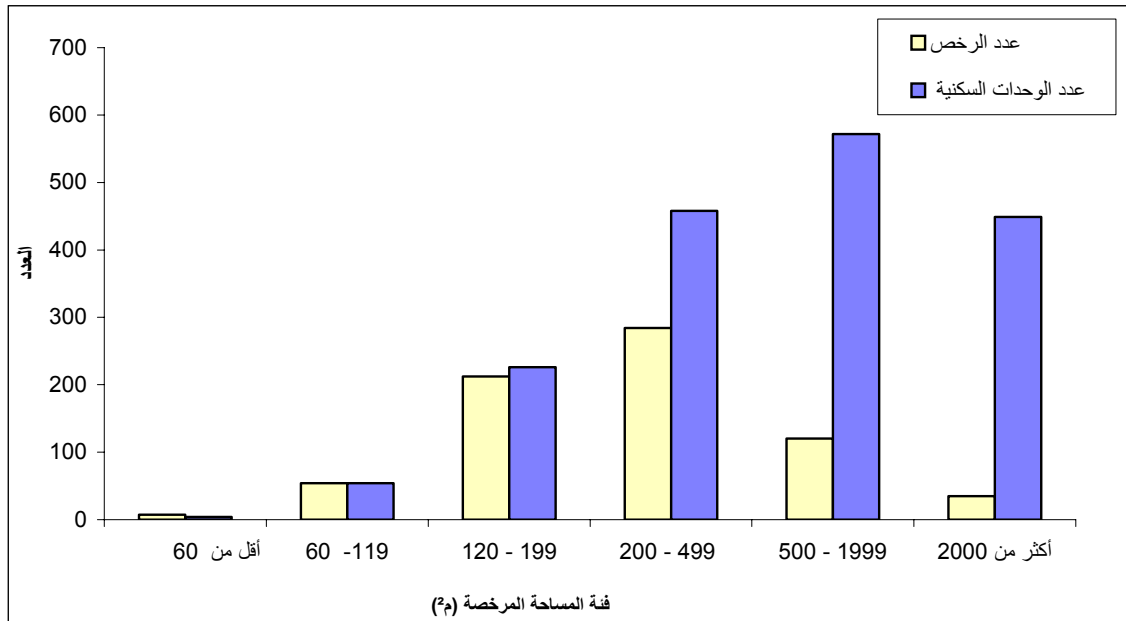

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Preface

Construction is considered as one of the important economic activities in the Palestinian economy. It contributes substantially to the Gross Domestic Product, recruits a large share of employees, and directly influences several other economic activities. Building construction, in particular, represents one of the major construction activities.

It has been necessary for PCBS to establish a statistical database that covers several aspects of construction activities in order to accommodate the different needs of users. The annual economic surveys series conducted by PCBS as of 1994 includes a survey for construction contractors. PCBS has also conducted the Annual Existing Buildings Survey starting from the reference year 1996.

PCBS is pleased to present this report of Building Licenses Statistics, which provides statistical data on the size and characteristics of licensed buildings in the West Bank for the fourth quarter 2010.

Statistical data is currently collected through filling the designated form from the administrative records of the different official licenses issuing authorities. This has been initiated on a quarterly basis since the first quarter of 1996.

PCBS strives to further develop the building licenses statistics to serve the different segments of users. PCBS hopes that sources of such data shall be developed in a manner that would reduce the cost and time needed for preparing these statistics.

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Executive Summary

This report covers data of the West Bank for the fourth quarter 2010.

The main findings of this quarter are as follows:

1. Number of licenses:

The number of building licenses issued in the fourth quarter 2010 totaled 1,518 and was distributed as follows:

- 843 licenses for new buildings.
- 291 licenses for new additions to licensed existing buildings.
- 63 licenses for new additions and existing parts.
- 287 licenses for existing buildings.
- 34 licenses for existing extensions.

2. Licensed areas:

The total area of licensed buildings (residential & non residential) amounted to 693.5 thousand m² distributed as follows:

- The areas of new buildings amounted to 573.1 thousand m² of which 422.0 thousand m² are residential and 151.1 thousand m² are non-residential.
- The areas of existing buildings amounted to 120.4 thousand m² of which 101.3 thousand m² are residential and 19.1 thousand m² are non-residential.

3. Licensed boundary walls:

61 licenses were issued for walls with total length of 5.7 thousand meters.

4. Number and area of licensed dwellings:

- New dwellings: 2,127 units with a total area of 357.1 thousand m².
- Existing dwellings 643 units with a total area of 89.9 thousand m².

There was an increase by 4.8% in the total number of issued buildings licenses for the fourth quarter of 2010 compared with the third quarter of 2010. In addition, there was an increase by 2.0% in the total number of issued buildings licenses for the fourth quarter of 2010 compared with the fourth quarter of 2009.

The number of new dwellings in the fourth quarter 2010 increased by 27.5% compared with the same quarter of 2009. There was also an increase by 10.7% in the number of new dwellings in the fourth quarter of 2010 in comparison with the third quarter of 2010.

Chapter One

Introduction

Construction is considered an important economic activity, particularly in countries undergoing substantial economic development. This activity plays a vital role in the Palestinian economy and is significantly interrelated to other economic activities. PCBS is committed to compiling statistical data on all aspects of construction activities in order to measure the main relevant variables.

Statistics based on administrative record pertaining to buildings shed light on the size and type of building licenses issued by the designated authorities. Building licenses statistics are compiled by most countries. In addition to its own importance, statistics on buildings licenses constitute the sampling frame for other surveys that aim to identify the actual buildings constructed with issued licenses, estimation of construction costs and obtaining data on the technical characteristics of these buildings.

1.1 Objectives:

This type of statistics provides information on the number of building licenses, licensed buildings areas, number and area of licensed dwellings and stores considering the following variables:

- Issuing authorities.
- Geographic location.
- Status of the buildings to be licensed (new, existing, new or existing additions, etc.).
- Building ownership (private, governmental, local authorities, cooperative, etc.).
- Utilization of the building (residential, non-residential: industrial, commercial, educational, etc.).
- Major external construction material (stone, concrete, block, etc.).

Chapter Two

Concepts And Definitions

Statistical Unit:

The license issued by any designated authority. The issuing authorities are the reporting units for these administrative records statistics.

Building Ownership:

1. Private.
2. Governmental.
3. Local Authority.
4. Cooperative.
5. Charitable Organization.
6. Other, e.g., religious groups, UNRWA, etc.

Status of the building to be licensed:

1. New, when the building site is entirely vacant.
2. Addition to an already existing licensed building - either a vertical or horizontal addition.
3. Addition to non-licensed existing building (or part of a building) that needs licensing.
4. Existing building.
5. Existing extension.

Building Utilization:

1. Residential: The building is considered residential if more than half of its total area is prepared for residential purposes. The building could consist of:
 - Complete dwellings.
 - Rooms added to the dwellings.
 - Extension of other facilities, e.g., kitchen, bathroom, cesspool, garage.
2. Non-Residential: industrial, commercial, educational, etc.
3. The wall around the building: In cases where the wall undergoes separate licensing. If the building license includes the wall, then it is not included here.

Dwelling:

A building or part of a building constructed for one household only, with one or more independent entrance leading to public road without passing through another housing unit.

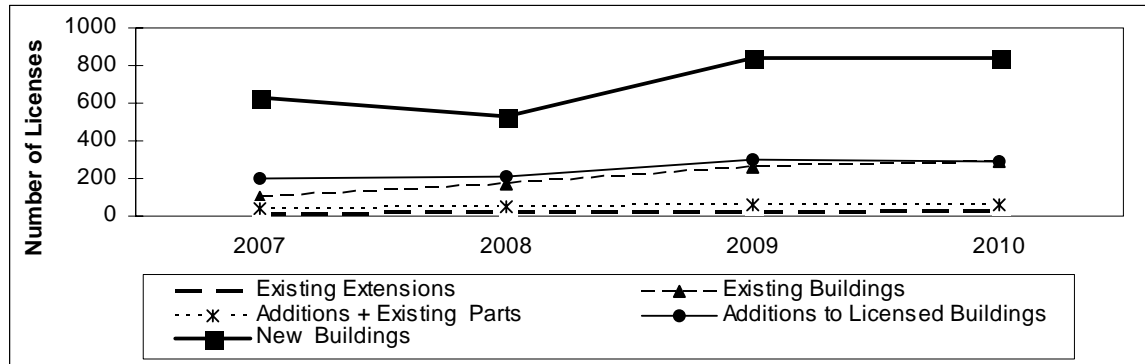

There was a 4.8% increase in the total number of issued building licenses in the fourth quarter 2010 as compared with the third quarter 2010. The total number of issued building licenses increased by 2.0% in the fourth quarter of 2010 when compared to the fourth quarter of 2009.

3.2 Number of licenses by governorate:

Nablus recorded the highest number of building licenses issued for residential and non-residential buildings which amounted to 302 and 67 licenses respectively, during the fourth quarter of 2010. Hebron governorate came second where the number of licenses amounted to 294 licenses for residential buildings and 34 licenses for non-residential buildings. In addition, Hebron governorate recorded the highest number of licenses issued for new buildings in the West Bank by 162 licenses during the fourth quarter of 2010 compared to 151 licenses in the prior quarter.

The following table shows the change in the number of building licenses issued in the West Bank in the fourth quarter of 2010 compared to the third quarter of 2010:

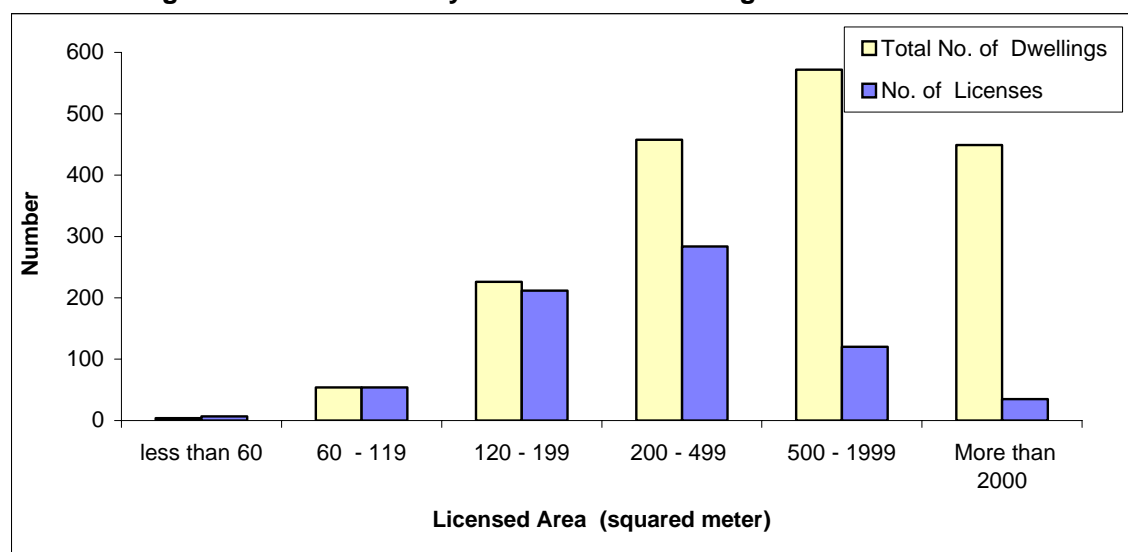

Data Quality

4.1 Accuracy of the Data

Statistical Errors

The survey was implemented on the basis of a comprehensive census for all studied statistical units (Licenses); therefore this survey was free of statistical (sampling) errors.

Non-Statistical Errors

Non-statistical errors are probable in all stages of the project, during data collection or processing. In this survey non-statistical errors are mostly referred to as data entry errors. To avoid errors and reduce their effects, great efforts were made to train data entry staff on the data entry program that was tested before starting the actual data entry process. The data entry program was prepared before data collection to check its readiness. A set of validation rules was applied to the program for checking consistency of data. Periodic data files were received by project management for checking accuracy and consistency of data.

4.2 Comparison of the Data

Comparison exercises were done with surveys of Building Licenses for the same quarter in previous years, and the results reveal fluctuation with previous survey data.

4.3 Technical Notes

There are important technical notes, which should be taken into consideration when reviewing this report:

- Tables exclude building licenses for those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967, where as (J2) includes the remaining parts of the governorate.
- It may be noticed that the details of the value of some indicators may not add up to their total, due to rounding calculations.
- Data were not available for Gaza Strip.
