
















Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Salfit Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2005-2010





Map 2: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Salfit Governorate, the West Bank by Sex and Labour Force Components, 2010.








Figure 6: Number of Schools in Salfit Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2009/2010





Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households in Salfit Governorate by Housing Density, 2010






Figure 10: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Quarter,2010





Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Type of Area and Quarter, 2010



#### **Executive Summary**

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Salfit governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Salfit governorate totaled 64,614 person at mid 2011 including 32,824 males and 31,790 females.
- About 8.3% of the total population of Salfit governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2010 in Salfit governorate totaled 758. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 106.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Salfit governorate totaled 1,869 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 184.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Salfit Governorate was 1 hospital. Number of hospital beds totaled 50 with bed occupancy rate of 0.8 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (Aged 15 Years and Above) in 2010 in Salfit governorate was 47.0% from the total manpower in Salfit governorate, in 2010, Unemployed persons constitute about 15.2% of those participating in labor force.
- 14.2% of the individuals are poor in Salfit governorate in 2010.
- There were 63 schools and 24 kindergartens in Salfit governorate in 2009/2010.
- The area of lands in Salfit governorate in 2010 was 204 square kilometers.
- Number of Agricultural Holdings in Salfit governorate reached 4,638 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Salfit governorate in 2010 totaled 318 license for an area of 82.6 thousand square meters.
- Water network are main source of water for 19 localities in Salfit governorate compared with 1 locality without water network. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 19 localities.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Salfit governorate was 178 vehicle.
- The value of imports increased in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 516.1 million US\$.
- The value of Exports decrease in Nablus & Salfit governorate in 2009, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 90.7 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus & Salfit governorate in 2009 totaling 425.4 million US\$.
