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
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
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

Figure 2: Number of Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah Courts in Bethlehem Governorate, 1999-2010




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





Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Year and Above) in Bethlehem Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2005-2010



Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Year and Above) in Bethlehem Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2010







Map 2: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Bethlehem Governorate and West Bank by Sex and Labor Force Components, 2010







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
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Figure 8: Number of Agricultural Holdings in Bethlehem Governorate by Type of Holding, 2009/2010




Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households in Bethlehem Governorate by Type of Housing Unit, 2010




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

Figure 11: Licensed Area for Building in Bethlehem Governorate by Area Type and Quarter, 2010





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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Bethlehem governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Bethlehem governorate totaled 194,095 person at mid 2011 including 98,794 males and 95,301 females. About 28.4% of the total population of Bethlehem governorate are refugees at end year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at shariah and church courts during 2010 in Bethlehem governorate totaled 969. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 158.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Bethlehem governorate totaled 5,287 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 499.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Bethlehem governorate was 8 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 567 with bed occupancy rate of 3.0 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Bethlehem governorate was 46.6% from total of human power. Unemployed persons constitute about 21.2% of those participating in labor force.
- 21.3% of the individuals are poor in Bethlehem governorate in 2010.
- There were 165 schools and 64 kindergartens in Bethlehem governorate in 2010/2011.
- The area of lands in Bethlehem governorate in 2010 was 659 square kilometers.
- Number of agricultural holdings in Bethlehem governorate reached 7,142 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Bethlehem governorate in 2010 totaled 410 license for an area of 212.7 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 45 localities in Bethlehem governorate. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 43 localities.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Bethlehem governorate was 11,642 vehicle.
- The values of imports increased in Bethlehem governorate in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 307.9 million US\$.
- Exports in Bethlehem governorate in 2009 increased, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 74.1 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Bethlehem governorate in 2009 totaling 233.8 million US\$.

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
