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




Estimated Population in Palestine End Year by Governorate, 2023

Estimated Population in Palestine by Region and Sex, End Year 2023





Population Pyramid in Palestine, End Year 2023




Average Household Size in Palestine by Region, 2022


Number of Registered Marriages in Palestine by Governorate, 2022

Crude Rate (Per 1000 population) for Registered Marriage and Divorce Cases at Shari'a Courts and Churches in Palestine by Governorate, 2022







Revised Unemployment Rate of Individuals (15 Years and Above) in Palestine by Governorate, 2022


Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2022



Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Economic Activity, 2020-2022











Percentage of Individuals (18 Years and above) in Palestine who are Current Smokers of Various Smoked Tobacco Products, by Region and Governorate, 2021





Top Ten Causes of Deaths Recorded in the West Bank, 2022




Top Ten Causes of Deaths Recorded in the Gaza Strip, 2022


















Percentage Distribution of the Imported Electricity in Palestine by Region, 2022
