








Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and above) in the West Bank by Age Groups, 2025



Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and above) in the West Bank by Economic Activity, 2021-2025




Percentage Distribution of Per Capita Expenditure in the West Bank on Commodities and Services Groups, 2023


Percentage Distribution of Per Capita Expenditure in Gaza Strip on Commodities and Services Groups, (Q1 – Q3, 2023)





Poverty and Deep Poverty Rates among Individuals in Gaza Strip According to Monthly Consumption Patterns (2009-2011, 2017, 2023)




Poverty Percentages among Individuals in the West Bank According to Monthly Consumption Patterns (2009-2011, 2017, 2023)






Physicians and Beds per 1000 Population in Palestine, 2012-2024*
















