Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics:

Palestinian Consumer Price Index declines 0.29% in April 2007

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 1996 base year (1996=100) reached 152.71 in April 2007, a 0.29% decrease relative to March 2007.

Analysis of consumer price developments for April indicates **declines in** the following major expenditure groups:

-	Recreational, Cultural Goods and Services:	- 1.34 %
-	Housing:	- 1.26 %
-	Transport and Communications:	- 0.50 %
-	Textiles, Clothing and Footwear:	- 0.30 %
-	Food:	- 0.20 %
-	Medical Care:	- 0.20 %
-	Furniture, Household Goods and Services:	- 0.16 %

At the same time, there were **increases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Education:	+ 0.21 %
-	Miscellaneous Goods and Services:	+ 0.16 %
-	Beverages and Tobacco:	+ 0.02 %

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Remaining West Bank:	- 0.79%
-	Gaza Strip:	- 0.50%
_	Jerusalem:	- 0.18%
