Palestinian Consumer Price Index Decrease by 0.21% in April 2009

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 122.55 in April 2009, a 0.21% decrease compared with March 2009, and increased by 1.74% compared with April 2008.

Analysis of consumer price developments for February indicates **declines in** the following major expenditure groups:

-	Housing	- 0.76%
-	Food and soft drinks	- 0.69%
-	Medical care	- 0.34%
_	Furniture, household goods	- 0.17%

At the same time, there were **increases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Transportation	+ 1.19%
-	Al Coholic Beverages and tobacco	+ 0.52%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.42%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.27%
-	Restaurants and cafes	+ 0.21%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 0.04%
-	Education	+ 0.04%
_	Communications	+ 0.02%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Remaining West Bank:	- 0.68%
-	Gaza Strip:	- 0.05%
_	Jerusalem J1:	+ 0.03%
