Palestinian Consumer Price Index, November 2010

Marginal increase in the CPI

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 131.50 in November 2010, it increased by 0.1% compared with October 2010, and increased by 3.53% compared with November 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for November indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	1.44%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	1.16%
-	Transportation	0.71%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	0.57%
-	Housing	0.52%
-	Recreational, cultural goods and services	0.38%
-	Medical care	0.27%
-	Furniture, household goods	0.20%

At the same time, there was a **decrease** in the following major expenditure group:

- Food and soft drinks 0.44%

Palestinian Territory experienced different overall CPI developments by region as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1*:	+ 0.22%
-	West Bank:	+ 0.19%
-	Gaza Strip:	+ 0.07%

^{*} Jerusalem J1: those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967
