Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increased by 0.58% in December 2009

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 127.75 in December 2009, it increased by 0.58% compared with November 2009, and increased by 4.34% compared with December 2008.

Analysis of consumer price developments for December indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Food and soft drinks	+ 1.13%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.99%
-	Education	+ 0.99%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.67%
-	Housing	+ 0.45%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 0.40%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 0.40%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	- 0.84%
-	Transportation	- 0.61%
-	Communications	- 0.04%
-	Medical care	- 0.38%
-	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	- 0.02%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1**:	+ 0.98%
-	Gaza Strip:	+ 0.54%
_	West Bank*:	+ 0.44%

^{*} West Bank: Excluding those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967.
