Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Palestinian Consumer Price Index Indicate Stability in May 2010

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 127.60 in May 2010, it increased by 0.07% compared with April 2010, and increased by 3.69% compared with May 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for May indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Medical care	+ 0.90%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 0.78%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 0.73%
-	Transportation	+ 0.30%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 0.30%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	+ 0.28%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 0.27%
-	Communications	+ 0.06%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Food and soft drinks	- 0.20%
-	Housing	- 0.20%
-	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	- 0.06%

Palestinian Territory regions experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1**:	+ 0.28%
-	West Bank*:	- 0.16%
_	Gaza Strip:	- 0.24%
