Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS):

Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increased by 2.75% in 2009

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 124.34 in 2009, it increased by 2.75% relative to 2008, and increased by 4.34% in December 2009 compared with December 2008.

Analysis of consumer price developments for 2009 indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Alcoholic Beverages and tobacco	+ 9.93%
-	Furniture, household goods	+ 7.21%
-	Restaurants, cafes and hotels	+ 4.73%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	+ 4.46%
-	Education	+ 4.42%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	+ 3.76%
-	Food and soft drinks	+ 3.60%
-	Recreational, cultural goods & services	+ 2.19%

At the same time, there were **decreases** in other major expenditure groups including:

-	Transportation	- 2.64%
-	Communications	- 0.90%
-	Housing	- 0.73%
_	Medical care	- 0.35%

Palestinian Territory **regions** experienced different overall CPI developments as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1**:	+ 3.54%
-	Gaza Strip:	+ 4.42%
_	West Bank*:	+ 0.57%
