# Palestinian Consumer Price Index, for 2010

#### **Increase in the CPI**

The Overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory with its 2004 base year (2004=100) reached 129.0 in 2010, it increased by 3.75% compared with 2009, and increased by 2.83% in December 2010 compared with December 2009, while it indicate stability in December 2010 compared with November 2009.

Analysis of consumer price developments for year 2010 indicates **increases** in the following major expenditure groups:

-	Al choholic Beverages and Tobacco	12.13%
-	Education	6.0%
-	Miscellaneous goods and services	5.2%
-	Food and soft drinks	3.4%
-	Textiles, clothing and footwear	3.92%
-	Transportation	2.64%

At the same time, there was a **decrease** in the following major expenditure group:

- Communications 2.04%

Palestinian Territory experienced different overall CPI developments by region as follows:

-	Jerusalem J1*:	5.25%
-	West Bank:	4.24%
_	Gaza Strip:	1.72%
