Palestinian Registered* External Trade in Goods of October, 2011.

Exports:

Exports increased in October, 2011 by 9.0 percent compared to September, 2011 and reached US\$ 63.0 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in October 2011 by 3.5 percent compared to September, 2011.

Also, exports to other countries increased by 62.6 percent during the same period compared to September, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 86.0 percent of total exports in October, 2011.


Imports:

Imports decreased in October, 2011 by 6.6 percent compared to September of the same year and reached US\$ 327.5 Million.

Imports from Israel decreased by 17.1 percent in October, 2011 compared to September, 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 63.8 percent of total imports in October, 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries increased by 20.0 percent compared to September, 2011.



Net Trade Balance on Registered Goods:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed a decrease in trade deficit by 9.7 percent compared to September, 2011 and reached US\$ 264.5 Million.
