**Survey on the Perceptions of the Owners/Managers of the
Industrial Establishments Towards the Economic
Conditions, February 2007**

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Notice to users of this report

PCBS would like to indicate to users of this press release that the data presented was based on a sample of 482 establishments, taking in the consideration that the size of the sample for the previous rounds (January 2006 -July 2006) was 346 establishments, that resulted in small discrepancies for the percentage distribution of the opinions in Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip as a total and in both regions separately.

Its worthy to mention that the increases in the sample improve the data quality and to insure more comprehensive representation of the sample for economic activities that were not covered in the previous sample.

The Main findings of the of the Perceptions of the Owners/Managers of
Industries with respect to the Economic Situation
February 2007**

The following shows the basic findings of round 24 of the trends of the owners/ managers survey of industrial establishments, concerning the economic situation for February 2006. The round was conducting during the period of February 3-23, 2007, taking into consideration January, 2007 as reference month. The aim of the survey is to observe and monitor the trends of the opinions of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments. The sample size is 482 industrial establishments (344 in the Remaining West Bank and 138 in Gaza Strip). A purposive two stages sample was designed for this survey; In the first stage the industrial survey 2004 was used as a sampling frame for the survey, while in the second stage: All the industrial establishments that constituted approximately 70% of the total industrial production were selected, establishments that employed less than 20 employees were excluded.

1. Performance of industrial establishments in February 2007

According to 22.7% of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments, the performance of their establishments during February 2007 had become worse than in January 2007; meanwhile, 28.8% refers that their production situation become worse.

On the other hand, 18.8% of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments refer that transporting finished goods to markets was worse during February 2007 compared with January 2007, while 12.5% refer that obtaining needed raw materials and inputs encountered worse situation during February 2007.

As for sales, 33.7% of the managers refer that the sales during February encountered problems, while 20.1% refer that employees productivity was worse.

According to results, 22.4% of the owners/ managers refer that their establishments financial situation was worse, while 7.6% refers that the banks credits was worse during February 2007.

2. Challenges

2-1 Drop in sales level

The expectations of 40.8% of the owners/managers of industrial establishments revealed that the main reason for an expected drawback or steady sales level is the plunge in the purchasing power of the consumers (52.4% in Gaza Strip and 37.2% in Remaining West Bank), 14.5% believe that the falling or steady sales level is due to closure of the border crossings as well as security reasons and roadblocks (14.8% in Remaining West Bank and 13.6% in Gaza Strip), while 16.5% refers that differentiating seasons were the main reason (20.1% in Remaining West Bank, 5.1% in Gaza Strip).

2-2 Local and external competition

In the remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip, 91.6% of the owners of the industrial establishments indicated that the main product of their establishments faced local or external competition, (89.6% for the Remaining West Bank and 96.3% for Gaza Strip).

According to 78.2% of the owners of the industrial establishments in the Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip, the main product faced local competition (97.6% for Gaza Strip and 69.6% for the Remaining West Bank); on the other hand, 21.8% of the owners of the

industrial establishments indicated that their main product faced external competition (30.4% for the Remaining West Bank and 2.4% for Gaza Strip).

2-3 Employment

According to 10.8% of the owners of the industrial establishments in the remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip, their establishments laid off workers in February 2007 (11.5% for Remaining West Bank and 8.9% for Gaza Strip); however, 82.4% (84.6% for Gaza Strip and 81.5% for Remaining West Bank) of the owners of the industrial establishments stated that there had not been any change to the number of workers.

3. Expectations

3-1 Short term

The expectations of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments in the short term, i.e. after one month of the reference month (February 2007); show that 40.3% expected improvement in their production in general in Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip (38.0% in remaining West Bank and 45.8% in Gaza Strip).

The expectations in the Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip concerning employment for March 2007 indicate pessimism since 14.9% only (12.5% in the Remaining West Bank and 20.5% in Gaza Strip) expected increases during March 2007.

The results showed that 40.2% of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments in the remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip expected sales to increase during March 2007 (37.8% in the Remaining West Bank and 46.3% in Gaza Strip) .

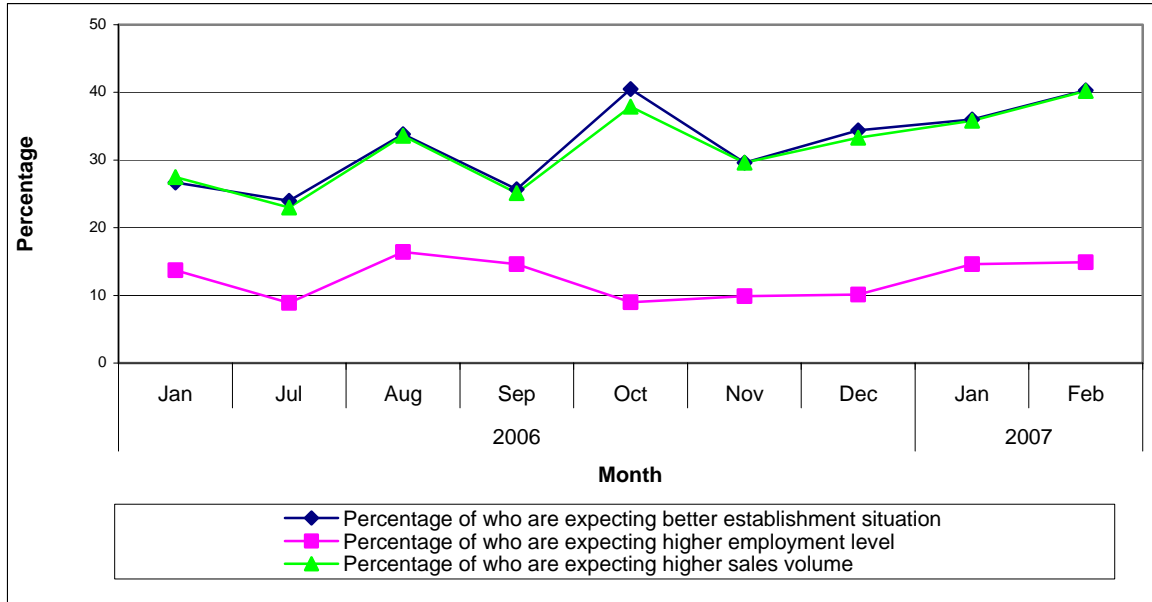
3-2 Medium term

The expectations of the owners/ managers of the industrial establishments in the medium term (in the next six months) 69.8% expected improvement in production in the next six months in Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip (72.4% in Remaining West Bank and 63.5% in Gaza Strip).

According to expectations concerning employment in the Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip, 30.9% expect increase in employment (28.8% in Remaining West Bank and 36.0% in Gaza Strip).

Sales during the next six months will rise, according to the expectations of 70.1% of the owners and managers of the industrial establishments in the remaining West Bank and in Gaza Strip (72.5% in Remaining West Bank and 64.0% in Gaza Strip).
