

Palestinian Registered* External Trade on Goods of May, 2011.

Exports:

Exports increased in May 2011 by 9.8 percent compared to April 2011 and reached US\$ 67.7 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in May 2011 by 8.8 percent compared to April, 2011.

On the other hand, exports to other countries increased by 23.5 percent during the same period compared to April, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 92.5 percent of total exports in May 2011.


Imports:

Imports decreased in May 2011 by 2.9 percent compared to April of the same year and reached US\$ 396.4 Million.

Imports from Israel decreased by 14.5 percent in May 2011 compared to April 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 67 percent of total imports in May 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries increased by 33 percent compared to April 2011.



Trade Balance:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed a decrease in trade deficit by 5.1 percent compared to April 2011 and reached US\$ 328.7 Million.
