



**Palestinian Registered*
External Trade on Goods of
July, 2011.**

Exports:

Exports decreased in July, 2011 by 26.1 percent compared to June, 2011 and reached about US\$ 53.9 Million.

Exports to Israel decreased in July 2011 by 26.1 percent compared to June, 2011.

On the other hand, exports to other countries decreased by 26.0 percent during the same period compared to June, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 90.3 percent of total exports in July, 2011.

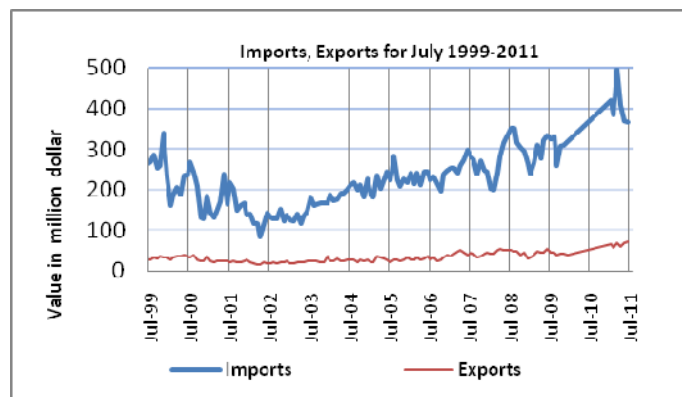
Imports:

Imports decreased in July, 2011 by 6.0 percent compared to June of the same year and reached US\$ 344.7 Million.

Imports from Israel decreased by 13.4 percent in July 2011 compared to June 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 60.0 percent of total imports in July, 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries increased by 8.0 percent compared to June, 2011.



Trade Balance:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed a decrease in trade deficit by 1.0 percent compared to June, 2011 and reached US\$ 290.8 Million.
