



## Palestinian Producer Price Index, September 2011

The overall Producer Price<sup>1</sup> Index (PPI) in the Palestinian Territory with its base month (January 2011=100) reached 98.31 in September 2011, which indicates an increase by 0.62% compared to August 2011.

Producer Price Index for exported products (January 2011=100) reached 100.33 in September 2011, which indicates an increase by 2.18% compared to August 2011.

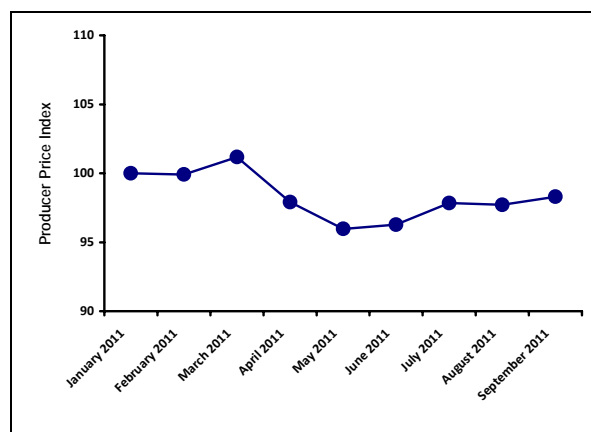
Producer Price Index for local consumed products (January 2011=100) reached 98.11 in September 2011, which indicates an increase by 0.46% compared to August 2011.

The changes of Producer Price Index for September is traced back to changes in prices of following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	%Change
Agriculture goods:	- 0.42 %
Fishing:	- 2.01 %
Mining and quarrying:	+ 2.96 %
Manufacturing group:	+ 1.12 %

<sup>1</sup> The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
