of Statistics 0.84% decrease in the Industrial Production Index for Remaining West Bank and Gaza Strip During the Second Quarter 2007

The overall Industrial Production Index (IPI) reached 99.00 in the second quarter 2007, 0.84% decreases related to the first quarter 2007 in the **Remaining West Bank** and Gaza Strip¹.

The results indicate that there was a decrease in the industrial production index for the second quarter with its 2006 base year compared with the first quarter 2007 as follow:

Analysis of Industrial Production Index developments for this quarter indicates **decreases** in the following major groups:

-	Manufacture of coke, refined petroleum products:	- 32.01 %
-	Manufacture of textiles:	- 21.05 %
-	Manufacture of rubber and plastic:	- 14.22 %
-	Manufacturing Group:	- 0.09%

Analysis of Industrial Production Index developments for this quarter indicates **increases** in the following major groups:

-	Water Supply:	+ 23.73%
-	Manufacture of other transport equipment:	+ 13.33 %
-	Electricity:	+ 8.80%
-	Mining and quarrying:	+ 4.68 %

Note: The weights for the year 2005 were used in computing the IPI till having the weights of 2006.

¹ Remaining West Bank: means Remaining West Bank, which includes all of the West Bank except for those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed after 1967 occupied by Israel.
