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## **Important Notes**

Statistics presented in this report is at constant prices, using 1997 as the base year for the period 1999-2003, while 2004 as the base year for the period 2004-2011.

Data related to the first quarter of the year 2011 is preliminary estimates based on the available short-term indicators, taking into consideration that the final version of the Quarterly National Accounts will be issued after completing the necessary indicators.

Also, it's worth mentioning that unemployment rate in the Palestinian territory for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of the year 2011 reached 21.7 percent, whereas it reached 23.4 percent during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010 and 22.0 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010. The unemployment rate for the year 2010 was 23.7 percent, 24.5 percent for the year 2009, while it was 26.0 percent for the year 2008.

The unemployment rate in the West Bank for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of the year 2011 reached 17.4 percent, whereas it reached 16.9 percent during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010 and 16.5 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010. The unemployment rate in Gaza Strip for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of year 2011 reached 30.8 percent, whereas it reached 37.4 percent during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010 and 33.9 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.

The data related to Government (Education, Health in addition to the Public Administration and Defense) was valued using the Accrual Bases based on the recommendations of the System of National Accounts issued by the UN. Also, it's worth mentioning that the wages and salaries are obtained from the monthly report of the Ministry of Finance to estimate government's activities, taking into consideration that data pertaining to expenditures in the public budget was reclassified based on revised classifications using the latest revision of the Government Finance Statistics Manual 2001.



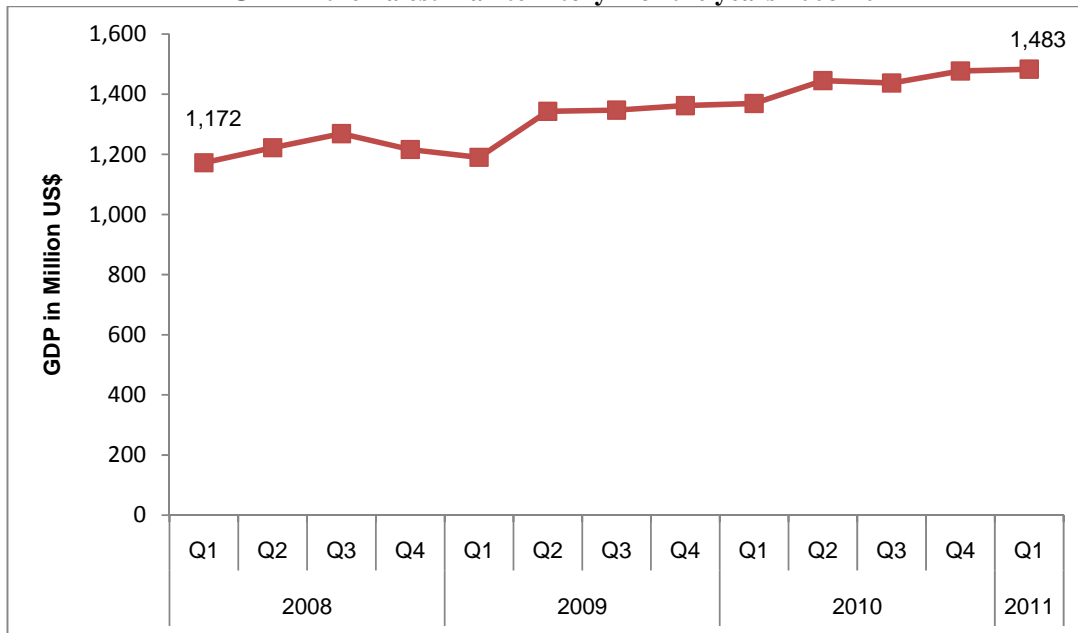
**An increase in the Value Added of Industrial Activities by 11.3 percent.**

By comparing the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2011 to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2010, the Value Added of the Industrial activities increased by 11.3 percent in the Palestinian territory\*, while it decreased for Transport, Storage and Communications by 10.1 percent.

**An increase in the GDP in the Palestinian territory\* during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010**

The preliminary estimates at constant prices showed an increase of 0.4 percent in the GDP in the Palestinian territory\* during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010, whereas the estimates showed an increase of 8.3 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010 at constant prices (the base year is 2004). As for the West Bank\*, the GDP decreased by 4.9 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010. As for Gaza Strip, the GDP increased by 17.9 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2010. GDP for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 at constant prices in the Palestinian territory\* was US\$ 1,483 million of which US\$ 1,082 million for the West Bank\* and US\$ 401 million for Gaza Strip.

**Gross Domestic Product Per Capita**

The Gross Domestic Product per Capita for the Palestinian territory\* during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 was US\$ 382 with a decrease by 0.4 percent compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010; while it showed an increase by 5.1 percent compared with the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.

## **Performance of Main Economic Activities during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 in the Palestinian territory.**

**First:** An increase in gross value added for the following economic activities:

- The gross value added for **Mining, Manufacturing, Water and Electricity** activities increased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010 by 11.3 percent, while it decreased by 2.5 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Construction** activities increased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010 by 6.6 percent, and it increased by 45.1 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Real Estate, Renting and Business Services** activities increased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010 by 4.7 percent, and it increased by 7.0 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Public Administration and Defense** activities increased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010 by 12.7 percent, and it increased by 15.0 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Education** activities increased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010 by 1.1 percent, and it increased by 4.5 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.

**Second:** A decrease in gross value added for the following economic activities:

- The gross value added for **Agriculture and Fishing** activity decreased by 3.4 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010, while it increased by 7.5 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Wholesale and Retail Trade** activity decreased by 8.4 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010, while it increased by 5.0 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.
- The gross value added for **Transport, Storage and Communications** activities decreased by 10.1 percent during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2011 compared to the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the year 2010, while it increased by 2.7 percent compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2010.

## Concepts and Definitions

### Statistical Unit

The United Nations System of National Accounts SNA 1993 defines two main types of statistical units:

#### - Institutional Unit-Enterprise

An institutional unit is an economic entity that is capable, in its own right, of owning assets, incurring liabilities and engaging in economic activities and in transactions with other entities.

#### - Establishment

An establishment is an enterprise, or part of an enterprise, which produces only a single group of goods (with the possibility of production from secondary activities) in which the principal productive activity accounts for most of the value added.

Breaking down institutional units into establishments serves to create more consistent statistical units in the productive sense.

### Economic Activity

Is an activity, carried out under the responsibility, control and management of an institutional unit that uses inputs of labour, capital, goods and services to produce outputs.

### Output

Value of goods and services, including own-account goods, produced during a specific period.

### Value added

Value added is a central concept of production and refers to the generated value of any unit that carries out any productive activity. Gross value added is defined as the value of gross production less the value of intermediate consumption. The net value added is defined as the gross value less the value of fixed capital consumption. The net value added reflects the performance of the economy in a better way; however, since it is difficult to measure the fixed capital consumption accurately, the concept of gross value added is more frequently used.

Value added at producers' price is the difference between output at basic prices and the value of the intermediate consumption at purchase price plus taxes (less subsidies) on production. However, if taxes and subsidies are excluded, value added will be obtained in basic prices.

### Gross Domestic Product (GDP)

Gross Domestic Product or GDP is the summary measure of the output or production during a certain period in time. Estimate of GDP, like the output and the value added, can vary according to taxes and subsidies taken into consideration that GDP is usually estimated at market prices, producers' prices, or basic prices.

### Deflating

Changing all data at current prices to constant prices by choosing the suitable indices by which the effect of prices on the data will be isolated, and choosing suitable base year in order to do this.



**Short-term indicators**

All indicators that have a periodicity of less than a year, usually a month or quarter.

**Industrial Production Index**

A statistical tool used for measuring the change in volume of output of industrial activities during a certain period of time. The index uses the change in volume of production for the largest establishments in each industry.

**Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM)**

It refers to the total of property income payable to financial institution less the gross value of payable interests on these institutions excluding property income receivable by investment of money of the same institutions.
