First ever primary results of the Quarterly National Accounts by Expenditure side at current and constant prices for the first and second quarter 2011.

The primary results shows the Gross Domestic Product in the Palestinian territory during the second quarter 2011 at current prices amounted to US \$ 2,281 million; it recorded an increase by 12 percent compared to the first quarter 2011.

For the Palestinian Territory at Constant Prices:

The primary results shows the Gross Domestic Product during the second quarter 2011 at constant prices amounted to US \$ 1,598 million; it recorded an increase by 7 percent compared to the first quarter 2011.

- Final consumption:

The primary results shows the Final consumption amounted to US \$ 1,825 million during the second quarter 2011; it recorded a decrease by 2 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the Household Final Consumption amounted to US \$ 1,400 million, which showed about 77 percent of the Gross Final Consumption; and it recorded a decrease by 6 percent compared to the first quarter 2011.

- Gross Capital Formation:

Gross Capital Formation amounted to US \$ 313 million during the second quarter 2011; it recorded an increase by 19 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the Capital Formation of the

buildings amounted to 82 percent during the second quarter 2011.

- Imports:

The Gross Imports of the goods and services during the second quarter 2011 decreased by 11 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the imports of goods decreased by 14 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the imports of goods increased by 16 percent compared to the first quarter 2011.

- Exports:

The Gross Exports of the goods and services during the second quarter 2011 increased by 3 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the Exports of goods increased by 3 percent compared to the first quarter 2011, whereas the imports of goods increased by 3.3% compared to the first quarter 2011.

- Trade Balance:

The Trade Balance which equal the difference between the exports and imports of the goods and services, it amounted to US \$ 540 million during the second quarter 2011, where the deficit decreased by 14 percent compared to the first quarter 2011.

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The Data excludes those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967.
