Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics (PCBS):

Road Cost Index (RCI) Increases by 0.74% in the West Bank* in July 2009 Compared with the Previous Month

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 105.37 in July 2009 with an increase of 0.74% compared with the previous month, (December 2008=100).

Analysis of Road Cost developments for July indicates an **increase** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Iron and steel	+ 6.35%
-	Plastic products	+ 0.83%
-	Road Paints	+ 0.78%
-	Asphalt & bitumen mixture & its products	+ 0.72%

On the other hand, there was a **decrease** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Cement products	- 0.60%
-	Quarries and quarrying products	- 0.57%
-	Cement	- 0.37%
