Road Cost Index (RCI) Increased by 0.11% in the West Bank* in October 2009 Compared with the Previous Month

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 104.86 in October 2009 with an increase of 0.11% compared with the previous month. (December 2008=100).

Analysis of Road Cost developments for October indicates an **increase** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Asphalt & bitumen mixture & its products	+ 1.55%
-	Plastic products	+ 1.86%
-	Quarries and quarrying products	+ 1.13%

On the other hand, there was a **decrease** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Iron and steel	- 3.92%
-	Road Paints	- 1.21%
-	Other metals	- 0.85%
-	Cement	+ 0.20%
