



Palestinian Registered* External Trade on Goods of April 2011, and Preliminary Results of 2010

Exports of April 2011:

Exports decreased in April 2011 by 9.7 percent compared to March 2011 and reached US\$ 61.6 Million.

Exports to Israel decreased in April 2011 by 9.1 percent compared to March, 2011.

On the other hand, exports to other countries decreased by 16.8 percent during the same period of April 2011 compared to March, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 93.3 percent of total exports in April 2011.

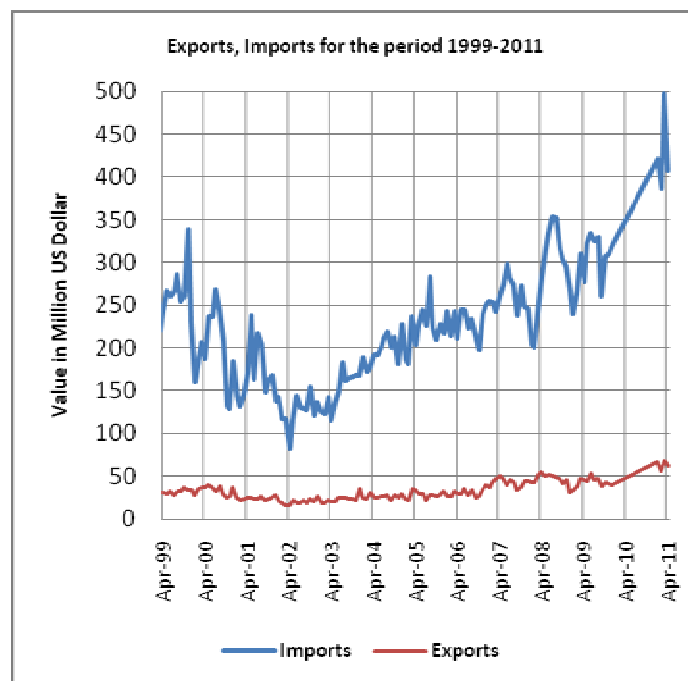
Imports of April 2011:

Imports decreased in April 2011 by 18 percent compared to March of the same year and reached US\$ 408.1 Million.

Imports from Israel decreased by 14.1 percent in April 2011 compared to March 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 76 percent of total imports in April 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries decreased by 28.2 percent compared to March 2011.



Trade Balance of April 2011:

The trade balance (difference between exports and imports) showed a decrease in trade deficit by 19.3 percent compared to March 2011 and reached US\$ 346.5 Million.

Exports and Imports 2010:

The external trade preliminary results for 2010 indicated an increase in both imports and exports compared to 2009.

Imports reached US\$ 4,385.3 Million with an increase by 21.8 percent compared to 2009. Exports also increased by 8.6 percent compared to 2009 and reached US\$ 563.2 Million.
