# The Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics 

Press Release<br>For the Hotel survey, Third Quarter 2005<br>$\mathbf{3 5 , 3 3 7}$ guests spent $\mathbf{9 1 , 8 5 9}$ nights

The Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics is pleased to release the main findings of the Hotel Survey for the Third quarter 2005. Similarly to the previous times we have published data, this release aims at giving the public an overall idea of the most important indicators in Hotel Survey, mainly the number of guests, average number of workers, occupancy rates, and other main indicators.

The number of hotels operating in the Palestinian Territory at the end of third quarter was 76 hotels, comprising a total of 3,431 rooms with a total of 7,408 available beds, of which 18 hotels including 866 rooms comprising 1,972 beds in Jerusalem area, and the results show that the number of workers in the Palestinian hotels was 1,246 of which $12.1 \%$ from these workers are females.

During the third quarter 2005, the total number of guests to the Palestinian Territory reached 35,337 persons, of which $34.2 \%$ of them were Palestinian guests, and $23.6 \%$ were from the European Union countries, while the total number of guest nights was 91,859 nights, of which $25.3 \%$ were Palestinian guests, and $28.6 \%$ were guests from the European Union countries.

Since September 2000, there has been a dramatic drop in the main indicators of hotel activity, because of the Israeli measures against the Palestinian foundations. By comparing with same quarter of the year 2000, we found that the percentage occupancy of rooms declined by $60.5 \%$, while the number of guests declined by $69.9 \%$ and the number of nights declined by $72.6 \%$, on the other hand, this reduction considered the lowest in the previous three years, which reflect the improvement of this indicators during this period, as explained in table below, which reflects the percentage change in the main indicators during the third quarter of each year comparing with the third quarter 2000:
