## Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS) Releases a Statistical Report about the Hotel Activities Survey, third Quarter 2009

Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics is pleased to release the main findings of the Hotel Activities Survey for the third quarter 2009, which aims at giving the public an overall idea of the most important indicators of the Hotel Activities, mainly the number of guests, average number of workers, occupancy rates, and other main indicators.

The number of operating hotels in the Palestinian Territory at the end of the third quarter was 89 operating hotels in September 2009, offering 4,666 rooms with total available beds of 10,238 of which 30 hotels including 1,503 rooms comprising 3,343 beds were in the Jerusalem region. The results show that the number of workers in the Palestinian hotels was 1,523 of which 227 are females.

During the third quarter 2009, the total number of guests to the Palestinian Territory reached 135,939 persons, of which $15 \%$ were Palestinian guests, and $34 \%$ were from the European Union countries. $50 \%$ of the guest total were in Jerusalem hotels, whereas the percentage reached $21 \%$ in hotels in Middle of the West Bank, $26 \%$ in hotels in South of the West Bank, $2 \%$ in hotels in North of the West Bank, and the percent 1\% in Gaza Strip hotels.

While the total number of guest nights reached 310,643 nights, $16 \%$ of these nights were occupied by Palestinian guests, $37 \%$ by guests who arrived from European Union countries, and $11 \%$ by the guests who arrived from the United States of America and Canada.

Most of the guests nights were in Jerusalem and South of the West Bank, representing $50 \%$ and $31 \%$ of the total guests respectively, and $1 \%$ of nights in Gaza Strip hotels.

The table below presents the main results of the third quarter of 2009, and explains the changes that occurred in the main indicators for the Palestinian hotels activities, compared with the previous quarter, and with the results of the third quarter of 2008.
