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Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (July- September, 2008) Round

The highest unemployment rate is concentrated among youth 15-29 years old

This report is based on the labour force quarterly survey. Data was collected during 6/07/2008 to 2/10/2008, representing the 3rd quarter 2008.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census sampling frame (Updated on 2003), 7,529 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 6,424 questionnaires were completed.

Economically Active:

• According to the ILO standards, the labour force participation rate remains at the same level (41.6%) in the 3rd quarter 2008 and the 2nd quarter 2008, while it decreased compared with the 3rd quarter 2007 at 42.7%. The participation rate of women decreased from 16.0% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 15.2% in the 3rd quarter 2008, with a change rate of 5%.

Unemployed Persons

- According to the relaxed definition of unemployment, the percentage of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, increased from 31.5% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 32.7% in the 3rd quarter 2008, compared with 29.1% in the 3rd quarter 2007
- According to the ILO standards, the percentage of persons who don't work, but seeking job increased from 25.8% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 27.5% in the 3rd quarter 2008, compared with 23.2% in the 3rd quarter 2007. The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank increased from 16.3% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 20.7% in the 3rd quarter 2008, while it decreased in Gaza Strip from 45.5% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 41.9% in the 3rd quarter 2008.
- Qalqilia governorate registered the highest unemployment rate among the West Bank governorates at 31.5% followed by Tulkarem (30.3%) then Hebron governorate (24.5%). While Jericho and AL Aghwar and Jerusalem registered the lowest percentages of unemployment (13.0% and 14.2% respectively). While in Gaza Strip, Khan Younis governorate registered the highest percentage of unemployment (50.2%) followed by North Gaza governorate (48.0%), while the lowest unemployment rate was registered at Deir ALbalah governorate (32.9%)
- The results showed that the highest percentage of unemployment was concentrated among youth aged 15-29; The highest rate was among those aged 20-24; it reached 43.8%, thereof 35.1% in the West Bank and 59.8% in Gaza Strip, followed by 15-19 age group it reached 38.7%, thereof 30.5% in the West Bank and 62.1% in Gaza Strip, then 25-29 group, it reached 32.8%, thereof 25.2% in the West Bank and 46.6% in Gaza Strip.
- The results showed that unemployment rate among females who did not complete any years of schooling was 4.8%. Whereas, the percentage reached 41.8% for females completed 13 years of schooling and over compared with 20.2% among males. While the highest rate was among males who completed 1-6 years at 34.4%.

Employed Persons

• At economic activity¹ level the results showed that the percentage of those who are working in agriculture sector in the West Bank decreased from 17.1% to 14.9% between 2nd quarter and 3rd quarter 2008, while the percentage of those who are working in construction sector increased from 9.0% to 9.7%, and the percentage of those who are working in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector increased from 20.4% to 21.3%.

While in Gaza Strip the results showed that all activities was affected from the closure imposed by Israeli military authority, for that there was a decrease of those who are working in agriculture sector from 12.3% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 10.6% in the 3rd quarter 2008, while the percentage of employed persons in commerce, restaurants and hotels sector increased from 17.0% in 2nd quarter to 18.3% in the 3rd quarter 2008.

- On the other hand, the results showed that the percentage of employed persons at services and other branches sector reached 32.9% in the West Bank and 60.7% in Gaza Strip in the 3rd quarter 2008.
- The results in the West Bank showed an increase of the percentage of wage employees, it increased from 60.4% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 62.2% in the 3rd quarter 2008, while the percentage of self employed decreased from 24.1% to 22.8% and unpaid family members decreased from 11.2% to 10.5% at the same period.
- While in Gaza Strip the percentage of wage employees increased from 71.3% to 73.3%, whereas the percentage of self employed decreased from 16.9% to 15.7% and the percentage of unpaid family members decreased from 8.5% to 6.4% at the same period.
- The employment from the West Bank in Israel and Israeli settlements increased from 14.2% in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 16.3% in the 3rd quarter 2008, whereas in Gaza Strip there was no access for workers to enter Israeli settlements.
- The results showed that the public sector employed one fifth (22.8%) of total employed, 14.0% in the West Bank and 48.8% in Gaza Strip.

Wages and Work Hours

- The average value of the nominal daily net wage of employees in the West Bank decreased from 86.9 NIS in 2nd quarter 2008 to 82.2 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2008, compared with 77.1 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2007. Also in Gaza Strip the nominal daily net wage of employees decreased from 61.5 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2008 and 57.2 NIS in 3rd quarter 2008, compared with 64.1 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2007. Also the nominal daily net wage for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements decreased from 143.3 NIS in the 2nd quarter 2008 to 138.0 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2008, compared with 131.9 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2007.
- The average weekly work hours in the West Bank increased from 42.7 work hour in 2nd quarter 2008 to 42.8 work hour in the 3rd quarter 2008, and increased in Gaza Strip from 40.0 work hour to 43.4 work hour, while it decreased for those working in Israel and Israeli settlements from 44.3 work hour to 42.5 work hour at the same period.

Concepts and Definitions

Man power

All persons in the West Bank and Gaza Strip aged 15 years and over.

Reference week:

The week ending on Friday preceding the interviewer's visit to the household.

Employed:

All persons are 15 years and over who were working at a paid job or business for at least one hour during the reference week, or who did not work, but held a job or owned business from which they were temporarily absent (because of illness, vacation, temporarily stoppage, or any other reason) during the reference week. Employed persons are classified according to employment status as follows:

- 1. Employer
- 2. Self-employed
- 3. Employee
- 4. Unpaid family member

Unemployed (According to the ILO Standards):

Unemployed persons are those individuals 15 years and over who did not work at all during the reference week, who were not absent from a job and were available for work and actively seeking a job during the reference week. Persons who work in Israel and were absent from work due to closure are considered unemployed, and also those persons never work and not looking for work but waiting to return back to their works in Israel and Settlements.

Unemployed (According to the Relaxed Definition):

The number of unemployed persons was calculated under the relaxed definition by adding to unemployed persons according to the ILO Standards, those persons outside labour force because they were frustrated

Labour force:

The economically active population (Labour Force) consists of all persons 15 years and over who are either employed or unemployed as defined above at the time of survey.

Underemployment:

Underemployment exists when a person's employment is inadequate in relation to alternative employment, account being taken of his/her occupational skills.

Persons outside labour force:

The population not economically active comprises all persons 15 years and over, who were neither employed nor unemployed accordingly to the definitions above.
