Press Conference on the Labour Force Survey Results

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Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (October– December, 2004) Round Unemployment rate decreased by 2.0% between 3rd and 4th quarter 2004

This report is based on the Labour Force quarterly Survey. Data was collected for the 4th round from 4/10/2004 to 30/12/2004, representing the 4th quarter 2004.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census, 7,563 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 6,278 questionnaires were completed.

Economically Active:

• According to the ILO standards, the percentage of participants in labour force increased by 1.5% between the 3rd quarter 2004 and the 4th quarter 2004, where it increased from 40.5% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 41.1% in the 4th quarter 2004, compared with 43.5% in the 3rd quarter 2000.

Unemployed Persons:

- The percentage of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, decreased from 32.6% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 31.2% in the 4th quarter 2004, compared with 20.2% in the 3rd quarter 2000, according to the relaxed definition of unemployment.
- The percentage of persons who don't work, but seeking job decreased from 26.8% in the 3rd quarter to 25.7% in the 4th quarter 2004 according to the ILO standards, compared with 10.0% in the 3rd quarter 2000 (before the beginning of Al-Aqsa Intifada). The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank decreased from 22.3% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 21.4% in the 4th quarter 2004, also it decreased in Gaza Strip from 36.8% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 35.2% in the 4th quarter 2004, despite of that unemployment rate in Gaza Strip still high.

Employed Persons:

- The results showed an increase in the percentage of employment¹ for those who are working in agriculture in the West Bank (16.3% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 22.7% in the 4th quarter 2004). Also in Gaza Strip the percentage increased from 12.3% in 3rd quarter 2004 to 14.0% in the 4th quarter. On the other hand the results showed that employment in construction decreased slightly in West Bank from 10.2% in the 3rd quarter to 10.0% in the 4th quarter 2004, while it is increased slightly in Gaza Strip from 6.9% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 7.9% in the 4th quarter 2004.
- The results showed an increase in the percentage of unpaid family members in the West Bank (from 11.7% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 13.9% in the 4th quarter 2004), also it was increased slightly in Gaza Strip from 8.7% to 8.9% during the same period.
- The results showed that the percentage for self employed increased slightly increased in Gaza Strip from 21.8% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 22.6% in the 4th quarter 2004. also it increased slightly in the West Bank from 27.4% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 27.6% in the 4th quarter 2004, also the results showed that wage employees decreased in the 4th quarter 2004 in the Palestinian Territory to reached to 57.3% compared with 58.9% in the 3rd quarter 2004, the percentage decreased in Gaza Strip from 67.5% in the 3rd quarter to 66.7% in the 4th quarter 2004. Also it decreased in the West Bank from 55.8% in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 53.8% in the 4th quarter 2004.
- The percentage of employees from the West Bank working in Israel and Israeli settlements reached to 10.9% in the 4th quarter 2004 compared to 12.5% in the 3rd quarter

2004, while the percentage in Gaza strip remains at the same level during the same period.

Wages:

The average value of the nominal daily net wage of the employees in the West Bank decreased from 72.1 NIS in 3rd quarter 2004 to 71.7 NIS in the 4th quarter 2004, compared with 70.3 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000. While the nominal daily net wage of the employees in Gaza Strip increased from 58.1 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 59.5 NIS in the 4th quarter 2004, compared with 50.4 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000. Also the Average daily net wage for those working in Israel and settlements decreased from 125.3 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2004 to 123.2 NIS in the 4th quarter 2004, compared with 110.8 NIS in the 3rd quarter 2000.

Dependency Ratio and Poverty:

- The economic dependency ratio² increased in the Palestinian Territory from 4.8 in the 3rd quarter 2000 to 6.0 in the 4th quarter 2004 (the change rate is 25.0%). Whereas, it increased in the West Bank from 4.3 to 5.2 (the change rate is 20.9%) and in Gaza Strip increased from 5.9 to 8.2 (the change rate is 39.0%). The ratio in the West Bank reached 5.4 compared with 8.5 in Gaza Strip in the 3rd quarter 2004.
- The percentage of employees whose monthly wages below poverty line³ increased from 43.5% in the 3rd quarter 2000 to 56.8% in the 4th quarter 2004 (the change rate is 30.6%).

² The economic dependency ratio: Number of population *divided by* Number of employed persons.

³ The poverty line equivalent for the year 2000 (1622 NIS, for reference household composed of two adults and 4 children) was used for the 3rd quarter 2000. The poverty line equivalent for the 3rd quarter 2004 (1800 NIS, for reference household composed of two adults and 4 children) was used for the 4th quarter 2004 results.

Concepts and Definitions

Man power

All persons in the West Bank and Gaza Strip aged 15 years and over.

Reference week:

The week ending on Friday preceding the interviewer's visit to the household.

Employed:

All persons are 15 years and over who were working at a paid job or business for at least one hour during the reference week, or who did not work, but held a job or owned business from which they were temporarily absent (because of illness, vacation, temporarily stoppage, or any other reason) during the reference week. Employed persons are classified according to employment status as follows:

- 1. Employer
- 2. Own-account worker (self-employed)
- 3. Employee
- 4. Unpaid family member

Unemployed (According to the ILO Standards):

Unemployed persons are those individuals 15 years and over who did not work at all during the reference week, who were not absent from a job and were available for work and actively seeking a job during the reference week. Persons who work in Israel and were absent from work due to closure are considered unemployed, and also those persons never work and not looking for work but waiting to return back to their works in Israel and Settlements.

Unemployed (According to the Relaxed Definition):

The Number Of Unemployed Persons was calculated under the definition by adding to unemployed Persons according to the ILO Standards, those Persons outside labour force because they were frustrated

Labour force:

The economically active population (Labour Force) consists of all persons 15 years and over who are either employed or unemployed as defined above at the time of survey.

Underemployment:

Underemployment exists when a person's employment is inadequate in relation to alternative employment, account being taken of his/her occupational skills. The underemployed persons are classified into two groups:

- 1. Visible underemployment
- 2. Invisible underemployment

Persons outside labour force:

The population not economically active comprises all persons 15 years and over, who were neither employed nor unemployed accordingly to the definitions above.
