# Press Release on Labour Force Survey Results (January– March, 2004) Round 287,000 Unemployed persons during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004

This report is based on the Labour Force quarterly Survey. Data was collected for the 32<sup>nd</sup> round from 3/1/2004 to 1/4/2004, representing the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2004.

The survey sample of this round is based on the 1997 census, 7,563 households were selected to represent the Palestinian society of which 6,201 questionnaires were completed.

#### **Economically Active:**

• According to the ILO standards, the number of participants in labour force increased by one thousand between the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 and the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, where it increased from 815 thousand in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 816 thousand in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, compared with 735 thousand in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000.

#### **Unemployed Persons:**

- Number of persons who don't work nevertheless seeking or not seeking job, increased from 274 thousand in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 287 thousand in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, compared with 170 thousand in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000. This represents 32.3% of the total labour force, according to the relaxed definition of unemployment.
- While those who don't work, but seeking job, in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 reached 215 thousand which represent 26.3% of the total labour force according to the ILO standards, compared with 24.3% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 and 10.0% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000 (before the beginning of Al-Aqsa Intifada). The results showed that unemployment rate in the West Bank reached 24.6% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 compared with 20.7% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003, whereas it decreased in Gaza Strip from 32.1% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 29.8% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004.
- Unemployment rate by educational attainment, data showed that the rate decreased between the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 and the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, from 21.8% to 20.7% among those completed intermediate college and above.

#### **Employed Persons:**

- The results showed a decrease in the percentage of employment for those who are working in agriculture in the West Bank (16.4% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 15.6% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004), while it was 11.3% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000. In Gaza Strip the percentage decreased from 15.9% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 14.8% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004. Also the results showed that employment in construction decreased in the West Bank from 11.3% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 8.5% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004. also it decreased in Gaza Strip from 9.5% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 9.3% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004.
- The results showed a decrease in the percentage of unpaid family members in the Palestinian Territory (from 11.3% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 9.9% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004).
- The results showed that the percentage for self employed increased in the West Bank from 28.1% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 29.3% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, while it decrease in Gaza Strip from 24.9% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 21.7% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004. The results showed that wage employees increased in the Palestinian Territory reached 59.2% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 compared with 57.4% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003, the percentage increased in Gaza Strip from 62.9% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter to 66.6% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004. also it increased slightly in the West Bank from 55.2% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 55.9% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004.

• Employees from the West Bank working in Israel and Israeli settlements decreased during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 compared with the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003, they reached 50 thousand compared with 54 thousand in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003, while the number increased in Gaza strip from 4 thousand in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 6 thousand in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004.

#### Wages:

• The average value of the nominal daily net wage of the employees in the West Bank remains the same as in 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 (72.5 NIS), compared with 70.3 NIS in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000. While the nominal daily net wage of the employees in Gaza Strip increased slightly from 55.3 NIS in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 55.6 NIS in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, compared with 50.4 NIS in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000. Also the Average daily net wage for those working in Israel and settlements decreased from 131.8 NIS in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003 to 127.5 NIS in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004, compared with 110.8 NIS in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000.

#### **Dependency Ratio and Poverty:**

- The economic dependency ratio<sup>2</sup> increased in the Palestinian Territory from 4.8 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2000 to 6.3 in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 (the change rate is 31.3%). Whereas, it increased in the West Bank from 4.3 to 5.7 (the change rate is 32.5%) and in Gaza Strip increased from 5.9 to 7.5 (the change rate is 27.1%). The ratio in the West Bank reached 5.4 compared with 7.7 in Gaza Strip in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2003.
- The percentage of employees whose monthly wages below poverty line<sup>3</sup> increased from 43.5% in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2000 to 59.4% in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2004 (the change rate is 36.6%).
