Palestinian Registered* External Trade in Goods of September, 2011.

Exports:

Exports decreased in September, 2011 by 8.8 percent compared to August, 2011 and reached about US\$ 57.8 Million.

Exports to Israel decreased in September 2011 by 7.5 percent compared to September, 2011.

Also, exports to other countries decreased by 19.7 percent during the same period compared to August, 2011.

Exports to Israel represented 90.6 percent of total exports in September, 2011.


Imports:

Imports increased in September, 2011 by 1.9 percent compared to August of the same year and reached US\$ 350.7 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 14.8 percent in September 2011 compared to August 2011.

Imports from Israel represented 71.8 percent of total imports in September, 2011.

On the other hand, imports from other countries decreased by 20.9 percent compared to August, 2011.



Trade Balance:

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed an increase in trade deficit by 4.3 percent compared to August, 2011 and reached US\$ 292.9 Million.
