



Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics (PCBS):

Road Cost Index (RCI) Decrease by 0.35% in the Remaining West Bank* in March 2009 Compared with the Previous Month

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 100.63 in March 2009 with a decrease of 0.35% compared with the previous month, (December 2008=100).

Analysis of Road Cost developments for March indicate a **decrease** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Iron and steel	-3.63%
-	Electric wires and cables	-3.27%
-	Foundry products	-2.17%
-	Quarries and quarrying products	-0.89%

On the other hand, there was an **increase** in the cost of the following major groups:

- C	Other metals	+2.10%
- A	Asphalt & bitumen mixture & its products	+0.55%
- C	Cement	+0.48%
