Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics (PCBS):

Road Cost Index (RCI) Increases by 0.91% in the Remaining West Bank* in May 2009 Compared with the Previous Month

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 102.42 in May 2009 with an increase of 0.91% compared with the previous month, (December 2008=100).

Analysis of Road Cost developments for May indicates an **increase** in the cost of the following major groups:

- Iron and steel	+6.31%
- Asphalt & bitumen mixture & its products	+ 2.09%
- Foundry products	+1.96%
- Plastic products	+ 0.39%
- Road Paints	+0.15%

On the other hand, there was a **decrease** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Electric wires and cables	- 2.80%
-	Other metals	- 0.77%
-	Cement	- 0.24%
-	Cement products	- 0.10%

* Remaining West Bank: West bank except those parts of Jerusalem which were annexed by Israel in 1967.
