Palestinian Central Bureau Of Statistics (PCBS):

Road Cost Index (RCI) Increase by 0.64% in the Remaining West Bank* in February 2009 Compared with the Previous Month

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 100.98 in February 2009 with an increase of 0.64% compared with the previous month, (December 2008=100).

Analysis of Road Cost developments for February indicate an **increase** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Quarries and quarrying products	+ 2.12 %
-	Iron and steel	+ 1.38 %
-	Asphalt & bitumen mixture & its products	+ 1.34%
-	Rental of equipment	+ 1.19 %
-	Operating costs of equipment & maintenance	+ 0.87 %

On the other hand, there was a **decrease** in the cost of the following major groups:

-	Electric wires and cables	- 3.87 %
-	Transportation fees	- 2.13 %
-	Labor cost and wages	- 0.64 %
-	Cement	- 0.14 %
