Construction Cost Index (CCI), Road Cost Index (RCI), Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) and Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) in the West Bank During 2012

The Overall Construction Cost Index (CCI) for the West Bank with its base month (December 2007=100) reached 113.40 in 2012 with an increase of 0.88% compared to 2011.

The Overall Road Cost Index (RCI) for the West Bank with its base month (December 2008=100) reached 114.55 in 2012 with an increase of 3.43% compared to 2011.

The Overall Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) for the West Bank with its base month (January 2010=100) reached 109.25 in 2012 with an increase of 2.36% compared to 2011.

The Overall Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) for the West Bank with its base month (January 2010=100) reached 104.86 in 2012 with an increase of 1.26% compared to 2011.

Increase in Construction Cost Index (CCI)

The overall Construction Cost Index (CCI) reached 113.31 with an increase of 0.07% in the West Bank during December compared to November 2012 (base month December 2007=100).

The changes in the Construction Cost Index for December 2012 is traced back to the changes in the cost of the following major construction inputs compared to the previous month:

Increase in Road Cost Index (RCI)

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 116.21 with an increase of 0.08% in the West Bank during December compared to November 2012 (base month December 2008=100).

The changes in the Road Cost Index for December 2012 is traced back to the changes in the cost of the following major road inputs compared to the previous month:

Increase in Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI)

The overall Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) reached 110.14 with an increase of 0.13% in the West Bank during December compared to November 2012 (base month January 2010=100).

The changes in the Water Networks Cost Index for December 2012 is traced back to the changes in the cost of the following major water networks inputs compared to the previous month:

Increase in Sewage Networks Cost Index

The overall Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) reached 106.12 with an increase of 0.28% in the West Bank during December compared to November 2012 (base month January 2010=100).

The changes in the Sewage Networks Cost Index for December 2012 is traced back to the changes in the cost of the following major sewage networks inputs compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	%Change
Deface Materials	+ 1.13%
Excavations	+ 0.22%
Plastic and cement pipes	+ 0.10%
Fountains	0.00%
Asphalt, bitumen mixture & its products	- 0.87%
