### Consumer Price Index (CPI) during January, 01/2026

#### Increase in the consumer price index in Palestine as a result of the increase in the prices of Cigarettes, fresh vegetable and fruit, and Potatoes during January 2026

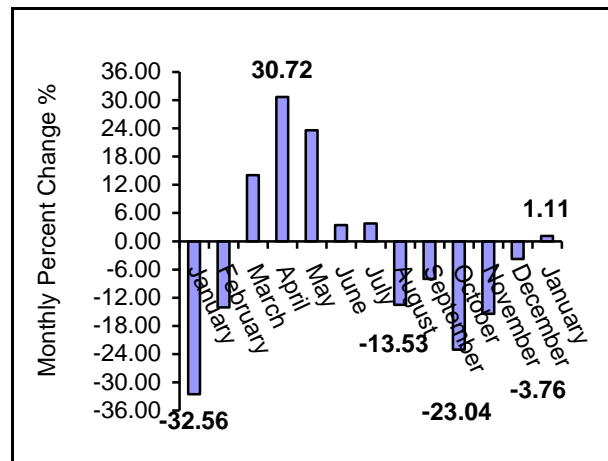
The overall Consumer Price Index CPI for Palestine during January 2026 **recorded an increase by 1.11%** compared with December 2025 (1.42% in Gaza Strip, by 1.04% in the West Bank\*\*, and by 0.59% in Jerusalem J1\*).

The changes in Palestinian CPI during January 2026 were traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Sub Groups	%Change
Imported Cigarettes	+ 15.73%
Fresh Vegetables	+ 10.15%
Fresh Fruit	+ 8.55%
Potatoes and Other Tubers	+ 8.12%
Rice	+ 4.90%
Dried Vegetables	+ 3.20%
Gas	+ 2.30%
Bread - kmaj	+ 2.05%

The Palestinian CPI during January 2026 decreased by 14.39% compared with January 2025 (36.49% in Gaza Strip, while it increased by 2.95% in Jerusalem J1\*, and by 1.75% in the West Bank\*\*).
