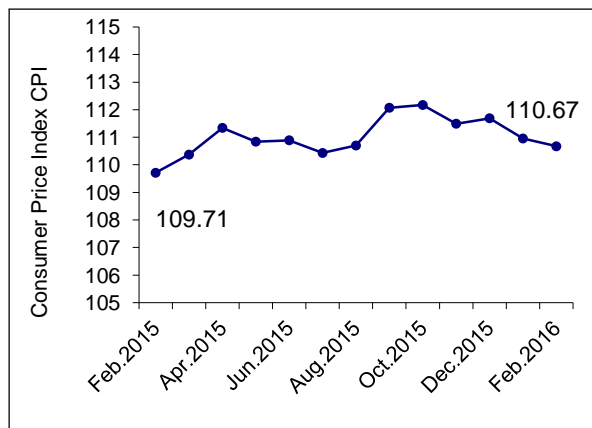

**The consumer price index in Palestine for  
February 2015 – February 2016  
(Base Year 2010=100)**

**Decrease in the Consumer Price Index  
during February,02/2016**



The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Palestine during February 2016 decreased by 0.26% compared with January 2016 (by 0.56% in the West Bank\*\*, by 0.51% in Jerusalem J1\*, and with a slight decreased by 0.04% in Gaza Strip).

The CPI during February 2016 increased by 0.88% compared with February 2015 (by 1.58% in the West Bank\*\*, by 0.51% in Gaza Strip, while it decreased by 1.59% in Jerusalem J1\*).

The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Palestine for February 2016 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

**Notes:**

- Jerusalem J1\*: Includes that part of Jerusalem which was annexed forcefully by Israel following its occupation of the West Bank in 1967.
- The data of West Bank\*\* doesn't include that part of Jerusalem which was annexed forcefully by Israel following its occupation of the West Bank in 1967.
