



Consumer Price Index (CPI) during February, 02/2026

Consumer goods prices return to increase in Gaza Strip during February 2026 as a result of market instability in Gaza Strip


The overall Consumer Price Index CPI for Palestine during February 2026 recorded an increase by **12.02%** compared with January 2026 (**37.92%** in Gaza Strip, by **0.39%** in Jerusalem J1*, and with a slight increase by **0.02%** in the West Bank**).

The changes in Palestinian CPI during February 2026 were traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Sub Groups	%Change
Imported Cigarettes	+ 161.75%
Fresh Chicken	+ 9.51%
Eggs	+ 7.59%
Fresh Meat	+ 4.13%
Rice	+ 4.01%

The Palestinian CPI during February 2026 increased by 11.61% compared with February 2025 (31.32% in Gaza Strip, by 2.84% in Jerusalem J1*, and by 1.71% in the West Bank**).
