Palestinian Consumer Price Index September, 09/2015

Sharp Increase in the CPI during September, 09/2015 compared with previous month

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Palestine during September 2015 increased by 1.24% compared with August 2015 (by 1.39% in the West Bank, and by 1.28% in Gaza Strip, while it decreased by 0.30% in Jerusalem J1*).

The CPI during September 2015 increased by 1.50% compared with September 2014 (by 2.39% in the West Bank, 1.13% in Gaza Strip, and by 0.17% in Jerusalem J1*).


The CPI during the first nine months of 2015 increased by 1.40% compared with the same period of the previous year (by 1.70% in Gaza Strip, 1.03% in the West Bank, and by 0.32% in Jerusalem J1*).

The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Palestine for September 2015 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Dried Vegetables	+ 24.14%
Potatoes and other Tubers	+ 12.34%
Eggs	+ 10.06%

Fresh Meat	+ 2.38%
Medical Care	+ 1.22%
Textiles, Clothing and Footwear	+ 1.20%
Milk Products	+ 1.12%
Liquid Fuel for Cars	- 3.87%
Liquid Fuel for House	- 2.31%
Electricity Tariff	-1.32%
Fresh Fish	-1.19%
Fresh Poultry	-1.15%
