
Palestinian Consumer Price Index Increase in the CPI During 2012

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Palestinian Territory during 2012 increased by 2.78% compared with 2011 (4.08% in the West Bank, 3.23% in Jerusalem J1*, 0.48% in Gaza Strip).

The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2012 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared to the previous year:

| Sub Groups | %Change |
|-------------------------|----------|
| Fresh vegetables | + 15.03% |
| Fresh poultry | + 8.91% |
| Cigarettes | + 7.42% |
| Fuel for transportation | + 5.81% |
| Education | + 5.47% |
| Fuel and electricity | + 3.67% |
| Medical care | + 3.06% |
| Fresh fruit | + 2.17% |
