



Palestinian Consumer Price Index during 2014

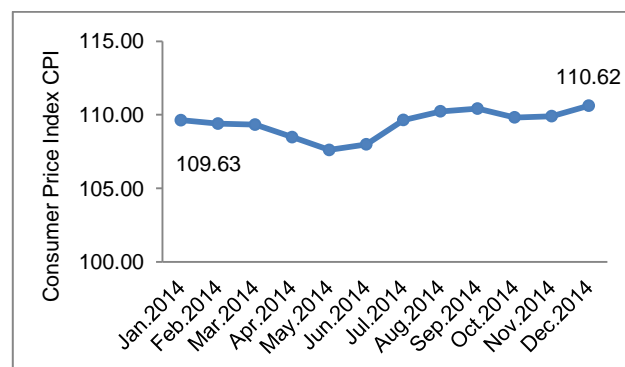
Increase in the CPI during 2014 compared with the previous year

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Palestine during 2014 increased by 1.73% compared with 2013 (increased by 3.84% in Jerusalem J1*, 2.85% in Gaza Strip, and by 1.20% in the West Bank).

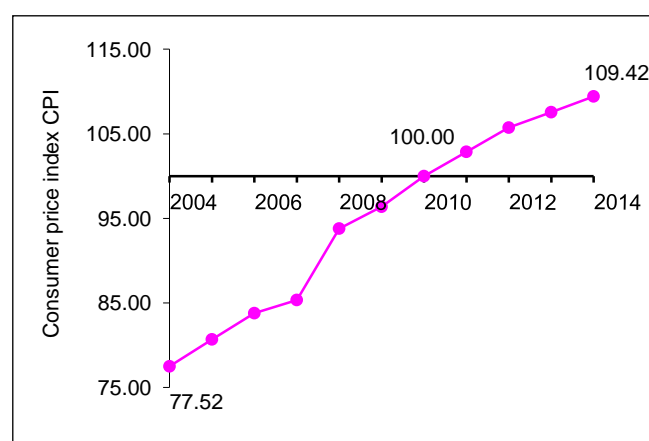
The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2014 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared to the previous year:

Sub Groups	%Change
Cigarettes	+ 10.72%
Fresh Fruit	+ 5.96%
Fresh Vegetables	+ 4.44%
Eggs	+ 4.15%
Liquid Fuel for House	+ 2.08%
Potatoes and other Tubers	- 20.35%
Dried Vegetables	- 19.14%
Fresh Meat	- 6.28%
Flour	- 5.20%
Fresh Poultry	- 1.21%
