



## Palestinian Consumer Price Index

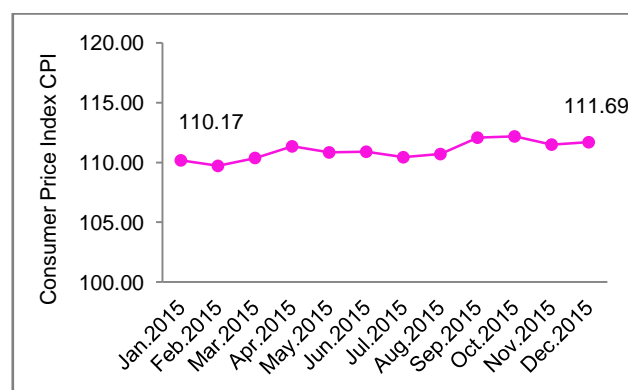
### Increase in the CPI during 2015 compared with the previous year

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Palestine during 2015 increased by 1.43% compared with 2014 (increased by 1.77% in Gaza Strip, 1.29% in the West Bank, and by 0.33% in Jerusalem J1\*).

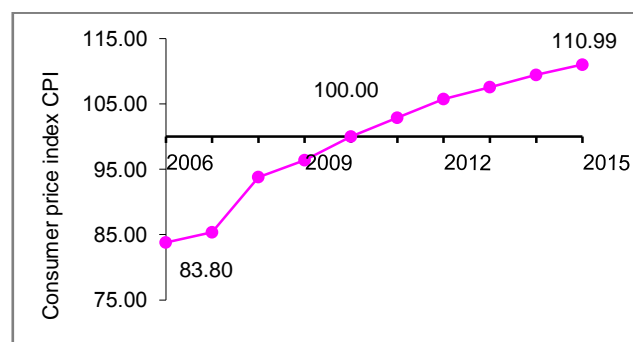
The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2015 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with the previous year:

<b>Medical Care</b>	<b>+1.05%</b>
<b>Housing Services</b>	<b>-5.64%</b>
Liquid Fuel for House	-15.73%
Gas	-14.44%
<b>Transportation</b>	<b>-1.00%</b>
Liquid Fuel for Car	-14.38%
