



**Palestinian Producer Price Index,
January,01/2015**

Decrease in the PPI during January,01/ 2015

The overall Producer Price¹ Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2011=100) reached 105.34 in January 2015, as it decreased by 0.14% compared to December 2014.

Producer Price Index for exported products (2011=100) reached 102.49 in January 2015, which indicates a decrease by 0.36% compared to December 2014.

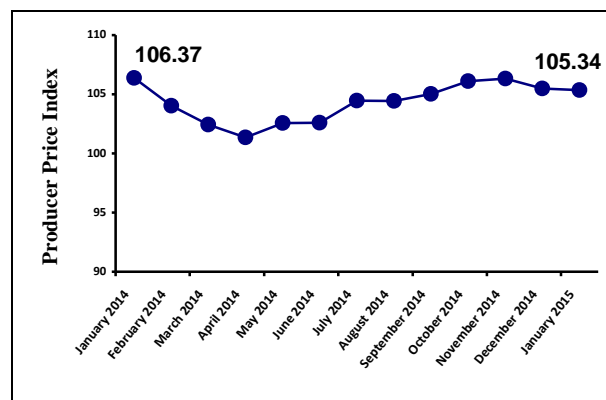
Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2011=100) reached 105.62 in January 2015, which indicates a decrease by 0.11% compared to December 2014.

The changes of Producer Price Index for January 2015 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Groups	Change
Agriculture goods:	- 0.82%
Mining and quarrying:	- 0.40%
Fishing:	+ 11.93%
Manufacturing group:	+ 0.26%

¹ The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
