**Palestinian Producer Price Index  
February, 02/2023**

**Increase in the Producer Price<sup>1</sup> Index  
(PPI) during February 2023**

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2019 = 100) reached 108.45 in February 2023, as it increased by 2.47% compared to January 2023.

**PPI for locally consumed products during  
February 2023**

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2019 = 100) reached 108.33 in February 2023, which indicates an increase of 2.63% compared to January 2023.

**PPI for local exported products during  
February 2023**

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2019 = 100) reached 109.55 in February 2023, which indicates an increase of 1.03% compared to January 2023.

The changes of PPI for February 2023 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

<b>Major Activities</b>	<b>% Change</b>
Agriculture, forestry and fishing	+ 7.62%
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	+ 3.74%
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+ 2.13%
Mining and quarrying	+ 0.55%
Manufacturing	+ 0.11%

1 The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
