



**Palestinian Producer Price Index,  
Decrease in the PPI during April, 04/ 2014**

The overall Producer Price<sup>1</sup> Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2011=100) reached 101.35 in April 2014, as it decreased by 1.05% compared to March 2014.

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2011=100) reached 101.22 in April 2014, which indicates a decrease by 1.11% compared to March 2014.

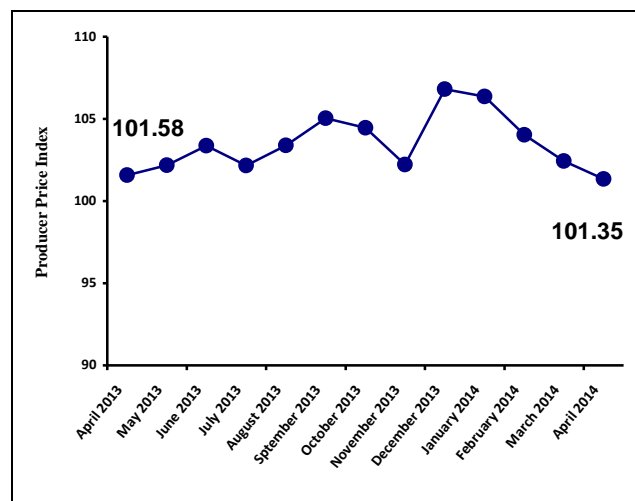
Producer Price Index for exported products (2011=100) reached 102.59 in April 2014, which indicates a decrease by 0.49% compared to March 2014.

The changes of Producer Price Index for April 2014 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

<b>Major Groups</b>	<b>Change</b>
Agriculture goods:	- 2.74%
Fishing:	- 2.06%
Manufacturing group:	- 0.14%
Mining and quarrying:	0.00%

<sup>1</sup> The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
