Decrease in the Producer¹ Price Index (PPI) during June, 06/2022

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2019 = 100) reached 103.04 in June 2022, as it decreased by 0.72% compared to May 2022.

PPI for locally consumed products

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2019 = 100) reached 102.48 in June 2022, which indicates a decrease of 0.75% compared to May 2022.

PPI for local exported products

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2019 = 100) reached 108.24 in June 2022, which indicates a decrease of 0.42% compared to May 2022.

The changes of PPI for June 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Activities	% Change
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	- 4.77%
Agriculture, forestry and fishing	- 3.18%
Mining and quarrying	+ 0.38%
Manufacturing	+ 0.34%
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+ 0.31%

¹ The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
